

Subject: A LETTER OF COMPLAINT FROM MS/MRS. RONA I. PONTEROS AGAINST BARANGAY CHAIRMAN MICHAEL J. SAQUITAN OF BARANGAY MOLINO 2 FOR THE ALLEGED ILLEGAL REMOVAL OF THE FORMER AS BARANGAY BRIGADE. (PCR 009-2025 dated 07 July 2025).

INTRODUCTION

This report pertains to the complaint Miss Rona I. Ponteros against Hon. Michael J. Saquitan, Punong Barangay of Molino II, Bacoor City, Cavite.

The said complaint was referred to this Committee by the Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena B. Mendiola, during the 1st Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod on July 07, 2025.

Acting on the referral, series of committee hearings were conducted on July 10, 2025, July 31, 2025, August 14, 2025 and August 28, 2025 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod relative to the above-stated subject matter. The hearing was presided over by Hon. Miguel N. Bautista, Chairperson of the Committee on Ethics, Appointments and Government Reorganization.

The hearing was attended by the members of the joint committee as well as the resource persons. Attached as an integral part of this report is the Attendance Sheet of the said hearing.

FINDINGS

Ms. Rona Ponteros filed a complaint against Punong Barangay Michael J. Saquitan on the following grounds:

1. Removal from position without due process

The complainant alleged that her removal from her position was conducted improperly without following the required process. She expressed feeling disrespected and undervalued during her service.

The respondent, Punong Barangay Saquitan, testified that the complainant was initially reassigned before being relieved of her duties due to loss of trust and confidence, based on performance-related concerns. He maintained that her dismissal was not abrupt and the removal order dated August 14, 2024 was formally issued pursuant to Section 394 of Republic Act No. 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991. Complainant failed to submit sufficient evidence with her allegations that she was removed without due process, after serving as Desk Officer on June 2, 2018 until 2022 and later reassigned as Barangay Nutrition Scholar (BNS) in 2023.

Unexplained reduction in salary/honorarium

The complainant questioned the legality and due process of her salary deduction.

Due to transfer of position, the complainant's salary reportedly decreased from P8,000 to P7,000. Salary adjustments at the barangay level are generally within the discretion of the Punong Barangay and is not contrary to existing laws.

3. On the alleged unauthorized electric connection

The complainant alleged unauthorized electric connections within the barangay premises and collection of payments.

The Complainant, despite being given several opportunities to do so, failed to submit sufficient evidence and failed to present any witness. The respondent denied prior knowledge of the matter.

Mishandling of financial assistance intended for toddlers in the Barangay

The complainant alleged that funds intended for toddler beneficiaries were not properly released.

Complainant failed to submit sufficient evidence nor present any witness on the said allegation. In fact, according to the testimony of Ms. Cristina Elalto (City Nutritionist, CSWD) she confirmed that financial assistance was distributed in January 2024 at the Bacoor Coliseum, with Mayor Strike Revilla personally handing out cash grants to beneficiaries. She also stated that Barangay officials had no role in the direct distribution of cash because it was the CSWD and its social workers facilitated the process. She even denied personally turning over two hundred seventeen thousand pesos (P217,000.00) or any portion of the funds to PB Saquitan.

On alleged simultaneous employment of Barangay personnel

The complainant alleged that some Barangay personnel were also employed at the City Government of Bacoor. However, she failed to present documentary proof such as payroll or employment certifications. An identification card alone is insufficient to substantiate the claim.

6. On other allegations

The complainant reiterated allegations of salary deductions and improper termination, which were already addressed in earlier discussion.

Other claims raised by the complainant remain unsubstantiated pending submission of supporting evidence and were already addressed in earlier discussions.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the foregoing findings, the Committee recommends to DISMISS the complaint against Punong Barangay Michael J. Saquitan due to lack of merit. The respondent, Miss Rona I. Ponteros failed to present sufficient evidence nor present credible witness to satisfy the legal requirements.

A joint committee hearing was held on July 10, 2025 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall regarding the above-mentioned subject matter with the following attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

Committee Chairperson Councilor Miguel Bautista led the prayer, gave his opening remarks and acknowledged the presence of all the members of the committee and the resource person as well.

The Chairperson requested all present councillors and resource persons to introduce themselves for the record.

Councillor Palabrica emphasized adherence to due process in administrative complaints involving barangay officials. He proposed that:

- The complainant be given time to fully present her complaint;
- The respondent be afforded an opportunity to submit a counter-affidavit within 15 days.
- The committee should listen to the complaint and ensure rights of all parties are protected.

The Chairperson acknowledged this proposal and called upon the complainant, Ms. Rona Ponteros, to present her complaint.

Ms. Ponteros narrated the grounds for her complaint against Punong Barangay Michael J. Saquitan, which include:

Removal Without Due Process: She alleged that her removal from her position was conducted improperly without following the required process.

She presented a document showing a loan return receipt dated August 12, 2024, earlier than the stated deadline of August 14, 2024, which she felt was used to justify her removal unfairly.

She expressed feeling disrespected and undervalued during her service.

Salary and Honorarium Reduction: Initially appointed as a desk officer in 2018 with an increasing salary from \$\mathbb{P}\$5,000 to \$\mathbb{P}\$8,000 by 2022.

She was reassigned to Barangay Nutrition Scholar (BNS) position in 2023, with salary reduced to \$\mathbb{P}7,000\$ without her consent.

She questioned the legality and due process of this salary reduction.

She alleged that the Barangay's Code of Ethics was not properly enforced, leading to ongoing unresolved issues affecting residents.

She submitted relevant documents as evidence and expressed willingness to provide copies to the committee.

Committee Clarifications and Questions:

Councillor Palabrica sought clarification on her positions, salary changes, and timeline of events.

Ms. Ponteros clarified her initial position as desk officer (2018–2022), reassignment to BNS in 2023, and salary decrease from \$\mathbb{P}8,000 to \$\mathbb{P}7,000\$.

The term "brigade" was explained as a colloquial term for certain roles, but she clarified her official roles and duties.

Ms. Ponteros confirmed submitting a formal removal document and loan receipt.

Committee members emphasized focusing on due process and procedural correctness regarding her removal and salary adjustments.

Questions about employment practices at the barangay level and salary adjustments were raised.

The complainant confirmed her intent to submit additional documentary evidence, including logbooks and payslips.

Remarks from Resource Persons and Committee Members:

It was noted that Barangay Officials have discretion in appointing and removing their personnel.

Salary allotments and adjustments are within the appointing authority's discretion but must comply with due process.

The Committee requested formal submission of all documentary evidence to substantiate the complainant's allegations.

It was gareed to adhere strictly to the complaint's scope and due process.

COMMITTEE AGREEMENTS AND NEXT STEPS:

The complainant will submit the documentary evidence she mentioned for further study.

The respondent will be given the opportunity to respond through a counteraffidavit within the prescribed period.

The committee will study the technical and legal aspects of employment and salary adjustments in the barangay setting.

Councilor Palabrica moved that the names mentioned by the complainant be summoned by the Honorable Committee namely; Cristina Elalto of the CSWD, Veronica Rompe and Aidalyn Complitado.

Further hearings or actions will be scheduled after submission of all required documents.

The hearing was suspended at 11:10 am.

For the record, the Committee accepted the submission of the complainant's counter-affidavit for study and reference.

The Committee clarified that the respondent, Punong Barangay Saquitan, must personally present and answer the complaint.

The Committee stressed that the counter-affidavit cannot substitute for the respondent's personal appearance.

It was noted that Punong Barangay Saquitan previously submitted a counter affidavit in response to the complaint.

The Committee formally accepted the complainant's counter-affidavit to the said report, for study and evaluation.

Before suspension, the presence of Ms. Cristina Elalto from CSWD was acknowledged for the record.













A motion to suspend the committee hearing was raised and duly seconded.

There being no further matters to discuss, the Committee suspended the hearing at 10:45 am.

A joint committee hearing was conducted on August 14, 2025 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall regarding the above-mentioned subject matter and was called to order at around 10:17 am by Chairperson Councilor Miguel Bautista. Councilor Bautista recognized the presence of all the attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

The Committee resumed deliberations on the complaint of Ms. Rona Ponteros against Punong Barangay Michael Saquitan regarding her alleged dismissal as Barangay Community Brigade member, along with other allegations.

1. Oath of Respondent

- Punong Barangay Michael Saquitan was administered the oath before giving his testimony.
- He affirmed that the reassignment and eventual removal of Ms. Ponteros from her post were due to loss of trust and confidence, as well as performance issues raised by the Barangay Executive Officers. He clarified that she was not abruptly removed but was reassigned first before being eventually relieved of her duties.

2. Discussion of Allegations

Removal from position without due process

The respondent, Punong Barangay Saquitan, testified that the complainant was initially reassigned before being relieved of her duties due to loss of trust and confidence, based on performance-related concerns. He maintained that her dismissal was not abrupt and was in accordance with barangay management prerogatives. A formal removal document was presented effective August 14, 2024 and was based on Section 87 of Republic Act No. 7160 (DILG Code). Complainant failed to submit sufficient evidence with her allegations that she was removed from

her original position as Desk Officer on June 2, 2018 and served until 2022 and was reassigned as Barangay Nutrition Scholar (BNS) in 2023.

Unexplained reduction in salary/honorarium

Due to transfer of position, the complainant's salary reportedly decreased from \$8,000 to \$7,000. Salary adjustments at the barangay level are generally within the discretion of the Punong Barangay and is not contrary to existing laws.

On the alleged unauthorized electric connection:

Allegations of unauthorized connections to the barangay's electric meter and collection of payments were raised. Respondent denied prior knowledge of such activity. A sample receipt was presented but was inconclusive.

Mishandling of financial assistance intended for toddlers in the Barangay:

The complainant alleged that funds intended for toddler beneficiaries were not properly released. Respondent denied personal receipt of the funds and requested that the responsible CSWD personnel be invited to clarify the matter. The Committee agreed to summon said personnel at the next hearing.

On alleged simultaneous employment of Barangay personnel:

Ms. Ponteros raised concerns regarding alleged barangay personnel holding simultaneous employment in the City Hall. The Committee directed the complainant to provide documentary evidence such as payroll records or certification, noting that an ID alone is insufficient proof.

Other Complaints:

The complainant reiterated allegations of salary deductions and improper termination, which were already addressed in earlier discussions.

- The complainant was instructed to submit supporting documents for her allegations regarding alleged double employment and payroll irregularities.
- The Committee resolved to invite/summon the concerned CSWD personnel to clarify the issue on the toddler fund amounting to \$217,000.00
- All records, affidavits, and evidence submitted shall be consolidated for the Committee's evaluation.

On motion of Hon. Galvez, duly seconded, and with no objection, the Committee suspended the hearing at 10:45am to give way to the submission of further evidence and the appearance of CSWD representatives.

A joint committee hearing was held on August 28, 2025 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall regarding the above-mentioned subject matter with the following attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

Committee Chairperson Councilor Miguel Bautista led the prayer, gave his opening remarks and acknowledged the presence of all the members of the committee and the resource person as well.

The Chairperson requested all present councillors and resource persons to introduce themselves for the record.

The Committee Chair called the meeting to order and stated that the purpose of the hearing was to investigate the complaint of Ms. Rona Ponteros regarding her removal from the Barangay Community Brigade of Molino II, and her allegations of irregularities in the distribution of financial assistance to constituents in January 2024.

PROCEEDINGS:

Ms. Ronna Ponteros testified that Punong Barangay Michael J. Saquitan orchestrated her removal after she raised concerns on fund mishandling.

She claimed that a total of P217,000.00 was diverted from the intended beneficiaries and remitted to the Punong Barangay.

Testimony of Ms. Jamaica May Mahinay (Daughter of Complainant / Beneficiary)

- Confirmed that she was listed as a beneficiary entitled to \$\mathbb{P}\$3,000.00
- She signed the payroll and attendance sheet and received \$\mathbb{P}3,000.00 during the distribution at the Bacoor Coliseum.

personnel, reducing her actual aid to P1,500.00





- However, she was later required to return ₱1,500.00 to barangay
- She stated that other beneficiaries were likewise required to return part of their aid.

Clarification by CSWD Representative

- Ms. Cristina Elalto, City Nutritionist (CSWD), testified that the financial assistance was distributed in January 2024 at the Bacoor Coliseum, with Mayor Strike Revilla personally handing out the funds.
- She stressed that Barangay officials were NOT involved in the direct cash distribution.
- She denied turning over \$\mathbb{P}217,000.00 or any collected amount to the Punong Barangay.

Statements from Barangay Representative

- o Ms. Veronica Rompe (Barangay Nutrition Scholar) denied receiving P40,000.00 or serving as a conduit to the Punong Barangay.
- Stated that Barangay officials had no role in the direct distribution of cash; CSWD and social workers facilitated the process.
- Denied personally turning over \$217,000.00 or any portion of the funds to the Punong Barangay.

Counterstatements from Barangay Representatives

- Ms. Veronica Rompe (Barangay Staff) was placed under oath.
- Conflicting statements emerged regarding whether funds collected from beneficiaries (P40,000.00 to P60,000.00) were remitted to Barangay Officials.
- While Ms. Ponteros maintained that such amounts were collected and later turned over to barangay staff. Ms. Rompe denied receiving P40,000.00 or acting as a conduit for the Punong Barangay.

The Committee emphasized that financial assistance from the City Government is intended solely for beneficiaries and must not be tampered with, diverted, or reduced.

The hearing was adjourned at 11:30 am.
