Subject: A LETTER OF COMPLAINT FROM MS. JENNIFER M. MOJICA AGAINST BARANGAY CHAIRMAN LEVIE DIZON OF BARANGAY MALIKSI 2 FOR THE ALLEGED MISTREATMENT OF THE LATTER. (PCR 054-2025 dated 04 August 2025).

INTRODUCTION

This report pertains to the complaint of Ms. Jennifer M. Mojica against Hon. Levie Dizon, Punong Barangay of Maliksi II, Bacoor City, Cavite for the alleged mistreatment of the latter during the processing of her request for a copy of Certificate to File Action (CFA) related to barangay-level dispute with a neighbor.

The said complaint was referred to this Committee by the Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena B. Mendiola, during the 5th Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod on August 04, 2025.

Acting on the referral, the Committee conducted two (2) committee hearings on September 18, 2025 and October 2, 2025 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod relative to the above-stated subject matter. The hearing was presided over by Hon. Miguel N. Baulista, Chairperson of the Committee on Ethics, Appointments and Government Reorganization.

Present were the Honorable Members of the Committee, representatives from the Office of the City Legal Services, the complainant Ms. Jennifer Mojica, and the respondent Punong Barangay Levie Dizon, along with witnesses and other concerned parties. Attached as an integral part of this report is the Attendance Sheet of the said hearing.

FINDINGS

After careful consideration of the testimonies of both the complainant and the respondent, as well as clarifications from Committee Members, the following were established:





1. Origin of the Complaint

- o The incident arose from a personal dispute between Ms. Mojica's mother and their neighbor, Ms. Irene Lara.
- o The matter was brought before the barangay for mediation and settlement.

2. Barangay Action Taken

- o Multiple hearings were conducted before the Lupon Tagapamayapa in compliance with the Katarungang Pambarangay Law.
- o The Barangay Chairman initially withheld issuance of a CFA to encourage amicable settlement.
- o After settlement efforts failed, both parties (Mojica and Lara) were issued CFAs.

3. Complainant's Allegations

- o Ms. Mojica alleged that:
 - She experienced delay and mistreatment in securing her CFA.
 - Records of her complaint were either misplaced or tampered with at the barangay.
 - She felt her rights were not fully respected during the process.

4. Defense of the Respondent

- o Punong Barangay Dizon maintained that the issuance of CFA complied with the 45-day period required by law and was not arbitrarily delayed.
- o He clarified that the delay was due to continuing mediation efforts and unforeseen circumstances.
- o He denied any intention to mistreat the complainant.

5. Committee Observations

- o The Barangay complied with the procedural requirements in handling disputes and issuing the CFA.
- o However, lapses in recordkeeping and documentation were noted, which contributed to the complainant's perception of unfair treatment.
- o The Committee also recognized the complainant's emotional distress arising from the barangay proceedings.





RECOMMENDATION

The complaint of mistreatment is hereby considered **RESOLVED**, as the Committee finds no substantial evidence of misconduct in the performance of duties as a Punong Barangay of Hon. Levie Dizon.

In view thereof, the Committee recommends to **DISMISS** the above-mentioned subject matter since both parties have indicated willingness to settle the dispute amicably, which the Committee considers a constructive path forward.

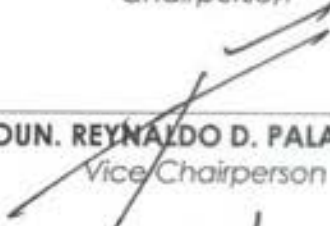

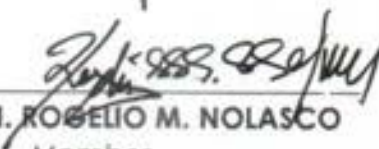

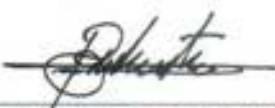

- Both parties shall cooperate with one another in preserving peace and order in their locality.

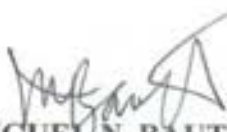

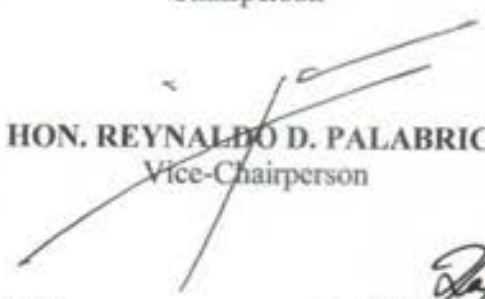

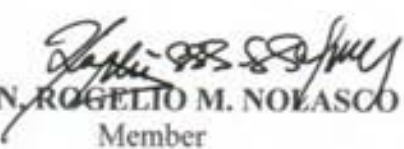

A joint committee hearing was held on September 18, 2025 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall regarding the above-mentioned subject matter with the following attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

Committee Chairperson Councilor Miguel Bautista led the prayer, gave his opening remarks and acknowledged the presence of all the members of the committee and the resource person as well.

The Presiding Officer requested each Councilor present to deliver their opening remarks. Members expressed their commitment to fairness, due process, and peaceful resolution of the complaint.

PRESENTATION OF THE COMPLAINT

- The Presiding Officer informed the body that a complaint filed by Ms. Jennifer Mojica against Punong Barangay Levie Dizon was endorsed by the Office of the City Mayor.
- It was confirmed that the complainant presented a notarized complaint before the Committee.
- The complainant was placed under oath before making her statement.

Summary of Allegations:

- Failure and delay by the barangay in issuing a Certificate to File Action (CFA), despite repeated requests.
- Verbal exchanges and statements from barangay officials allegedly constituting misconduct.
- Emotional distress caused to the complainant by the acts and disregard of barangay personnel.





CLARIFICATIONS AND DISCUSSION

1. Verification of Documents

- The Committee Secretariat was directed to verify whether a notarized complaint had already been formally filed and received.

2. Statement of the Complainant

- Ms. Mojica recounted her difficulty in securing her CFA from the barangay, which caused her inconvenience and distress.
- She expressed her grievance over alleged unfair treatment by the barangay and sought due process.

3. Response of the Committee

- The Chair reminded the complainant and the respondent that all statements were under oath.
- The Chair clarified that the respondent cannot yet answer substantively as a counter-affidavit must first be filed in accordance with due process.

4. Legal Guidance

- Atty. Salve Valenciano of the City Legal Services Office gave preliminary advice, stressing that while emotional distress is acknowledged, due process must be strictly observed.
- The Committee emphasized adherence to the ordinance governing administrative complaints against barangay officials.

FINDINGS

- A notarized complaint exists, though proper receipt and documentation must be verified by the Secretariat.
- The complainant raised allegations of misconduct and neglect of duty concerning the issuance of a CFA.
- The respondent was duly notified and will be required to submit a duly-notarized counter-affidavit in the next scheduled hearing.
- The Committee observed that while the complainant's testimony revealed emotional distress, the case must proceed under established rules to ensure fairness and due process.





RECOMMENDATION

The Committee recommends the following:

1. Require the complainant to submit complete supporting documents, including any witness affidavits, to substantiate her allegations.
2. Direct the respondent to file a counter-affidavit within the prescribed period.
3. Set a subsequent hearing for presentation of evidence and evaluation of the counter-affidavit.

There being no other matters to be discussed, the hearing was suspended at exactly 11:55am.

Proceedings:

A Joint Committee Hearing was held on October 2, 2025 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall regarding the above-captioned subject matter.

Call to Order

The hearing was called to order by the Chair at 11:40am. Committee Chairperson Councilor Miguel Bautista led the prayer, gave his opening remarks and acknowledged the presence of all the members of the committee and the resource person as well.

Dispensing of Opening Statements

- o A motion was raised to dispense with the opening statements of all Council Members to expedite the proceedings. The same was duly seconded.

Identification of Attendees

- o For the record, the following introduced themselves:
 - Hon. Council Members present
 - Punong Barangay Levy Dizon, Maliksi 2 (Respondent)
 - Mr. Robert Glenn Dizon, Ex-Officio of Maliksi 2
 - Ms. Jennifer Mojica, Barangay Maliksi 2 (Complainant)
 - Other officials and witnesses present.

Oath of Respondent

- o Although the respondent had earlier submitted a counter-affidavit, the Committee required him to take his oath and testify under affirmation.

Statement of the Respondent

- o Barangay Chairman Levy Dizon, through his statement and narration, explained:
 - The incident originated from a dispute between the complainant's mother and a neighbor, Ms. Irene Lara.





- Mediation attempts were conducted at the barangay level, but disagreements escalated.
- Multiple hearings were held before the Barangay Lupon Tagapamayapa.
- The complainant requested a Certificate to File Action (CFA), but the barangay initially deferred issuance to allow for further mediation.
- After repeated attempts at reconciliation failed, both parties were eventually issued CFAs.

Observations of Committee Members

- Clarifications were made regarding the process and timeframe of issuing a CFA, particularly the requirement of the 45-day period under the Katarungang Pambarangay Law.
- It was noted that the issuance of CFA by the Barangay was within proper procedure and justified by efforts to pursue settlement.

Statement of the Complainant

- Ms. Mojica testified that she felt mistreated by the barangay process, alleging:
 - Delays in the issuance of her CFA compared to the respondent's neighbor.
 - Loss of certain barangay records related to her complaint.
 - Emotional distress caused by perceived unequal treatment.

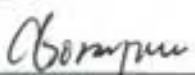
Committee Discussion

- Members emphasized that while the barangay is mandated to promote settlement, fairness and proper documentation must always be ensured.
- It was discussed that although both parties were issued CFAs, the complainant's concerns over transparency and recordkeeping should be addressed.

Adjournment

- After discussion, the Chair acknowledged all statements and adjourned the hearing at exactly 11:55am.
