Subject: *A resolution authorizing the office of the City Legal Service to initiate and file cases against Riza Dona Villa.*

(Date referred: October 13, 2025)

The above-mentioned proposed resolution underwent its first reading on October 13, 2025 during the 15th Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed resolution was referred by the Presiding Officer, City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances.

The Committee on Rules and Privileges sent out invitations to the resource persons and conducted a committee hearing on January 22, 2026 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

After due consultation and deliberation hereby report back to this August Body the findings, information gathered, and recommendation on the above-subject matter. Attached hereto are the attendance sheet and photos taken during the said hearing.

FINDINGS:

A letter dated December 08, 2025 from the Office of the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla was received by the Sangguniang Panlungsod requesting for a resolution authorizing the Office of the City Legal Service to initiate and file cases against Riza Dona Villa.





During the conducted committee hearing, the representative of the City Legal Services explained before the Honorable Committee the nature of the proposed resolution.

After the explanation was made and the comments given by the members of the Honorable Committee to the above-subject matter, the Presiding Officer concluded that the case to be filed against a certain Riza Dona Villa will be moot and academic for the following reasons.

1. The Avenida Wet and Dry Market which is owned and operated by a certain Riza Dona Villa was already been closed by the Business Permit and Licensing Department (BPLD) sometime in October 2023.
2. The prescription period for violation of City Ordinances committed by the Avenida Wet and Dry Market in 2023 in two (2) months only.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review of all the circumstances and statements from the resource persons, City Councilor Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica moved to **PERMANENTLY ARCHIVE** the above subject matter. The motion was unanimously seconded by the members of the City Council.
