Subject: (PCR 201- 2025) A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROPOSED FY 2026 DEPARMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM FOR CAVITE 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE STANDARD RIGHT-OF-WAY CERTIFICATION TEMPLATE FOR LOCAL PROJECTS. (Date referred October 20, 2025).

The joint committee hearing was executed on October 23, 2025, 4:21 pm at the Session Hall, 6th floor, Bacoor Legislative & Disaster Resilience Building, Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Brgy. Bayanan, City of Bacoor, Cavite. It was presided over by Chairman, Hon. Levy M. Tela, Committee on Public Works and Highways.

FINDINGS:

Pursuant to Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Department Order No. 71, Series of 2025, dated April 23, 2025, all projects funded under the Convergence Program (TRIP, ROLL-IT, KATUPARAN, and Farm-to-Market Roads), the Sustainable Infrastructure Projects Alleviating Gaps (SIPAG), and the Basic Infrastructure Programs (BIP) are required to submit a Standard Right-of-Way (ROW) Certification together with a Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution prior to the awarding of contracts.

This directive aims to ensure proper coordination between the Department of Public Works and Highways and the City Government, to resolve legal and administrative issues concerning affected properties ahead of project implementation, and to avoid delays in the execution of infrastructure projects thereby promoting the timely delivery of essential public works and services.

A resolution authorizing the City Mayor to sign the Standard Right-of-Way certification.





RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the committee respectfully recommends that the Sangguniang Panlungsod **APPROVE** on second reading Proposed City Resolution PCR 201- 2025 entitled: **"A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROPOSED FY 2026 DEPARMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM FOR CAVITE 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE STANDARD RIGHT-OF-WAY CERTIFICATION TEMPLATE FOR LOCAL PROJECTS."**

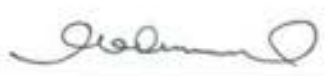

Hon. Tela: This committee regarding PCR 201- 2025 A resolution adopting the proposed FY 2026 Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) infrastructure program for Cavite 3rd District Engineering Office and authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign the standard right-of-way certification template for local projects. is now call to order.

Engr. Raymart: With due respect po meron po kaming presentation po na naka flash po sa likod para po yung aming discussion po is masundan po ng bawat isa. Bago po namin umpisahan ulit, naayos po namin magpasalamat sa bumubuo po ng Sangguniang Panglungsod sa imbitasyon po. Para ito nga, malinawan po kung ano ba talaga yung

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Proposed 2026 with this Infrastructure Project with regards po sa Convergence and Special Support Program. Nandito po kami para po ipa batid or linawin itong Department Order na naitatag sa amin Department Order 71 release po siya nung April 23, 2025 this year subject submission of standard Right-of-Way certification template for local project. Nakapaloob po dito in line with existing policies of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and to ensure uniformity and accountability in the implementation of local infrastructure-funded projects, the attached right-of-way certification template is hereby adapted for use in all local infrastructure projects funded under the Convergence Program, example po nito is TRIP, TROLE-EAT, KATU-UPARAN, and Farm-to-Market Roads. And then, secondly, yung SIPAG po, which means Sustainable Infrastructure Projects Alleviating Gaps Program, and the BIP is the Basic Infrastructure Program. This certification shall be signed by the municipal slash city mayor or provincial governor, duly authorized through Sangguniang Resolution. Kaya po kami nandito is para po dun sa Sangguniang Resolution. And then, second, the verified and endorsed by the concerned DPWH said implementing office, either the district engineer, regional director, or UPMO head. Then, for BIP, the certification may be submitted any time prior to the award of contract, and no implementation shall proceed without it. So, yun po, para may restriction po kami. So, namin pwedeng i-implement si project without the certification and the resolution. Ayan po. Then, ito po yung basis nung aming dialogo po dito sa inyo. Yung sa Department Order No. 71. Signed po ito ni former Secretary Manuel M. Bonoan. Then, ito po, mayroon po kaming template nung certification po para po dun sa per project po ito. Ito po yung nilalaman ng certification. This is to certify that the right of way for the proposed or the project name located in location is situated on an existing government-owned property or it's fully acquired through Republic Act No. 7160, Republic Act No. 10752, or other applicable laws by the name of local government unit, whether municipal, city, or provincial. As such, the right, the ROW is clear all known, man-made, and natural obstruction, encroachment, or informal settlers, and free from any legal claims or income branches. In recognition of the prevailing policies of the Department of Public Works and Highways, DPWH, covering local projects such as the Convergence Program, SIPAG, and the BIP. This LGU is the beneficiary. The beneficiary of the project affirms that the required ROW for the above-mentioned project has been secured in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations. Accordingly, DPWH shall bear no cost or responsibility for the acquisition of the right of way necessary to implement this project. For projects under the BIP, this certification may be submitted at any time prior to the award of contract, and no implementation shall proceed without the submission of this certification. Duly verified and endorsed by the concerned DPWH Implementing Office. In the event of any future or potential ROW-related dispute or claim, including those that may require legal action or court proceedings, the name of LGU shall assume full responsibility for its resolution and shall hold the DPWH free and harmless from any claims, suits, or legal action arising from such disputes. And this certificate is issued in support of the requirements of the DPWH's pursuant to Sanggunian Resolution No. and series of year passed by the Sanggunian in authorizing the undersign to sign on behalf of the name of LGU. Ayan po. Authorizing city mayor po to sign the certification. Ayun po. Ano-ano nga po ba yung mga convergence program? Yung convergence program po is, ito po, lima pong klase. Bali, number one, construction improvement of access roads leading to seaports. Kalsada tungo sa paliparan, riles at daungan program katuparan. Number two po, construction of improvement of access roads leading to railway station. Kalsada tungo sa paliparan, riles at daungan program katuparan. Number three, construction improvement of access roads leading to declared tourism destination. Tourism, road infrastructure program or the TRIP. Ang apat

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po yung construction improvement of access roads leading to trades. Industries and economic zones. Roads leveraging linkages for industry and trade infrastructure program or the ROLE-IT and the farm-to-market roads. And then yung under naman po ng special support program ng DPWH. Yung sustainable infrastructure program, projects, alleviating gaps, or the SIPAG. Ito po ang mga proyekto, mga access roads, bridges from the national roads leading to major strategic public buildings, facilities, access roads, and or bridges from the national roads connecting the indigenous people IP communities, inter-jurisdictional roads and or bridges. Roads that traverse multiple LGU jurisdiction and the coastal roads cause way for environment protection, conservation, flood mitigation. It also protects the environment, and it also protects the public. Public infrastructure facilities, then the multipurpose buildings, facilities to support social services, yun po yung mga under ng SIPAG program. Din sa BIP po, yung basic infrastructure program, yun nga po yung BIP, ito po yung access roads and bridges from the national roads leading to major strategic public buildings facilities, access roads and bridges from the national roads connecting to indigenous people, communities, inter-jurisdictional roads, and or bridges. coastal roads, causeway for environmental protection, conservation, flood mitigation structures, protecting public infrastructure facilities, and multi-purpose buildings, facilities to support social services. That is what is involved in the convergence and special support program. These are the programs of DPWH with regards to infrastructure projects. Then, sa BIP, yung under roads po, Construction of Road with Drainage Structures, Barangay Molino Dos, Bacoor City, Cavite, amounting to 10 million. Construction of Road and Drainage in Santo Nino, Barangay Niog, Bacoor City, Cavite, 15 million. Then, sa mga multi-purpose buildings naman po, ito po ay yung Construction of Multi-Purpose Building, Museo de Bacoor, Phase 5, Barangay Poblacion, formerly Tabing Dagat, Campo Santo, and Ang Bukid, Bacoor City, Cavite, amounting to 92,669,000. Then, next po, yung Construction of Multi-Purpose Building, Cavite State University, CAVSU, Barangay Molino 3, Bacoor City, Cavite, amounting to 150 million. Then, Construction of Multi-Purpose Building, Bacor City, Cavite, amounting to 150 million. Then, Construction of Multi-Purpose Building, Covered Court, Barangay Molino 3, Bacoor City, Cavite, amounting to 8 million. Construction of Multi-Purpose Building, Barangay Molino 2, Bacoor City, Cavite, 11 million. Then, lastly po, yung Construction of Multi-Purpose Building, Barangay PF Espiritu 4, Bacoor City, Cavite, amounting to 7.5 million. Then, para po mas ma-appreciate, ito po, yung... Ipapakita po namin yung location, kung saan po, yung feasible location po na itatayo si proyekto for 2026. Ito po, yung Construction of Service Road at Barangay Salinas, Bacoor City, Cavite. Ang location po niya is yung Along Salinas Road. Ito po yung completion...Completion po nung approach po. Tinatawag ko na approach road po nung tulay. Next po. Ayan, yung po, yung current condition yan. Pero ongoing na po siya. Ayan, ayan. Then, pangalawa po, yung Construction of Road and Drainage in Santo Nino, Barangay Niog. Ito po, yung sa Niog. Parallel road po siya ng Niog Road. Ayan, po. Ito po, yung mga pictures. Ito po, Mr. Chair, yung current condition po nung kalye. Ayan, po. So, meron pa po tayong gravel road doon sa looban. So, kailangan po natin i-konkreto para makompleto po. Then, yung deteriorated po, ayusin po natin. And with drainage naman din po ito. Tataas po natin ng konti yung elevation. Then, yun pong basic infrastructure program. Yung Construction of Road with Drainage Structure Brgy Molino 2, Bacoor City, Cavite Ayan, po. Ang pinaka malapit po niyang landmark is yung Magdiwang Road. Ito





po yung current condition ng kalye may gap pa po na gravel road pa siya, kokompletuhin po natin yung kalye.

Hon. Tela: May kasamang drainage?

Engr. Raymart: Opo, may kasamang drainage. Then para po sa mga multi-purpose buildings, ito po yung multi-purpose building covered court, Barangay Molino 3. Ito po ay sa loob ng Springville Central 4 of Division at yan po yung open court nila ngayon. Yan po yung iko-covered natin, Central 4 po, Springville Central 4. Next po, yung construction multi-purpose building, Barangay Molino 2. Yan po. Sa loob po siya ng Macaria.

Hon. Tela: Pero covered court ang cost nito 11 million?

Engr. Raymart: Covered court din po.

Engr. Tela: Bago yung isang over court 8M, eto 11M, bat di perehas.

Engr. Abegail: Kasi ito'y parang, yung isa kasi parang ano na lang existing na siya.

Engr. Raymart: Opo. Iko-covered lang, bububungan lang po siya. Wala na nung flooring. Ito totally. Oo. Ito po, new construction po, yung sa Molino dos. Can we proceed po, Mr. Chair? Okay na po? Multi-purpose building para PF Espiritu Yan, PF Espiritu 4 7.5 million.

Hon. Tela: Saang lugar Engineer yan?

Engr. Raymart: Mismong compound po nung Barangay Hall, Barangay Hall. Then next po, yung ating Museo de Bacoor na ongoing. Ito po yung phase 5 then yung last po yung CAVSU.

Hon. Tela: Maraming nagtatanong diyan lalo na sa mga constituents natin kung kelan matatapos yan siyempre sa konseho kami at the same time engineer. Baka kako kinapos, eto na yun ng project para may masabi kami sa mga nagtatanong.

Engr. Raymart: Opo ito na po yun. Then next po yung sa Cavite State University sa Molino 3, ongoing na rin po ito ngayon bale ito po yung pang phase 2 sa may Town and Country. Mayroon naman po tayong ginagawang drainage improvement dun land development po yung phase 1. Yan po yung location along river drive nga po and town and country road and that's all for Mr. chair thank you very much po.

Hon. Tela: Thank you po sa mga proyekto na ibibigay nyo para sa city of Bacoor for the meantime ibig kong marinig ang opinion ng ating city engineer na si Engr. Jicky Jutba kung ano ang kanyang magiging reaction and opinion.

Engr. Jutba: Dito po sa panukalang ito, unang una po malaking bagay po ito with respect naman po sa LGU yung lahat naman ng mga project natin mga location is rest assured natin na ang lahat eh nasa public po siya yung location ibig sabihin na wala tayong matatamaan na private at bago ma implement yung project makikita natin kung ano yung mga laman nung area example kung may ISF or kung kalsadang matatamaan kasi meron po tayo Mr Chair na minsan kasi na nahirapan ipa implement yung project dahil private po yung dadaanan so base po rito from this early moment po





kita na po natin yung early issue dun sa mga project bago siya ma implement. So, tungkol doon sa listahan na ibinigay nila dahil nireview ko na rin po 'yung listahan nila masasabi ko lang po na para doon sa mga ongoing projects, wala naman po tayong problema dahil nasimulan na po 'yung mga proyekto. Ang nakita ko lang po rito na dapat pang i-verify ay 'yung mga proyekto na nasa loob ng mga subdivision. Kasi gusto ko lang pong linawin, tulad nung sa Niog, sa Santo Niño hindi ko lang po sigurado dahil wala po sa opisina namin kung ito ba talaga ay na-turn over na sa lungsod, 'yung right of way nito. Gusto ko lang pong ma-verify 'to, lalo na 'yung mga proyektong gagawin pa lang nila. Kaya nga po nag-inquire ako sa barangay kung may turnover na ba talaga sa atin, para bago natin ito maipasa sa kanila at mapirmahan ng mayor kasi gusto rin po ng mayor na mapirmahan ito mabigyan din ako ng counter-signature mula sa kanya. Kaya gusto ko lang pong hilingin, Mr. Chair, sa council po, na ma-verify muna lahat ng mga dokumento bago tayo magbigay ng kaukulang resolusyon.

Hon. Palabrica: Yan ang magiging trabaho mo

Engr. Jutba: Yes po.

Hon. Tela: Monitor to submit.

Hon. Palabrica: Baka po kasi ang kalsadang gagawin public road na talaga. Kasi kung pribadong property ito, magkakaroon po tayo ng kaunting problema, 'di ba? Ngayon, yung particular area, dun sa Niog, siguro alamin natin sa zoning or from an appropriate office there, what is the classification of the road? Is it a barangay road? Is it a private road?

Engr. Jutba: Dun sa classification road po talagang tatama siya sa barangay road.

Hon. Palabrica: If it's a barangay road, walang problema kung barangay road. But anyway, kung may problema naman, dito lang kami naka alalay naman kami. Ang tanong na lang naming aaprubahan ba naming ito o hindi ikaw ang tatanungin naming ngayon. Kasi isa ka sa signatory.

Engr. Jutba: Actually, to be fair po, hinihingi ko pa po young documentation dito yung sa kalsada nga po

Hon. Palabrica: Ang pinag uusapan natin for this hearing yung subject matter, yung certification na yan sa sanggunian for the authority of the mayor to sign, ngayon kasama ka sa signatory nakita namin at sinabi mo rin. Kaya tatanungin ka naming ngayon, aprubahan ba namin ngayon.

Engr. Jutba: Tungkol po sa approval konsi pwede naman aprubahan ito.

Hon. Palabrica: Yan lang naman ang gusto naming marinig hindi kami mahirap kausap

Hon. Tela: sa dami naman nito sab inga merong mga nag start na diba ho. ON going na. Katulad po sa Salinas

Engr. Abegail: Phase 1 po yun phase 1





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Hon. Tela: Yun yung sinasabi ni Konsehal Rey may problema sa right of way yan ang aking asikasuhin. Sabi ng ni konsi na ikaw ang isa sa signatory ikaw na bahala rito dahil sabi mo aprubahan na ito.

Hon. Palabrica: Siyempre, ang proteksyon natin nasa kanya pag na go nya ibig sabihin protected ang sarili nya. Di ibigay nation sa laki ba naman ng tiwala natin kay Engr. Jicky. Mr. Chair, wala po akong tatanungin about sa mga projects iyan naman ay makakatulong lahat, hindi na siguro dapat patatagalin ito. Patatagalin pa ba natin ito nakakahiya kay Engr. Jenny my very long-time friend Assistant District Engineer, I'm very happy for you.

Hon. Tela: Una po sa requirements ang magkaroon ng committee hearing regarding sa inyo at the same time to explain to our other councilors yung project na binibigay ng DPWH para sa ikauunlad ng City of Bacoor, tama nga po. Maraming dokumentong kailangan. Kaya yan po. Bahala na po si Engr. Jicky doon.

Hon. Palabrica: Tatanong ko lang, Mr. Chair. May update ba tayo doon sa dati? May proposal tayo yung kalsada, parallel ng coastal ng Cavite. Dito sa may baybayin ng Bacoor, yung diversion road na tinatawag, Bacoor Diversion Road.

Engr. Raymart: Yung parallel po sa Cavite, yung Bacoor Diversion Extension, going to Imus din po. Under feasibility study pa po yung project. So once po na matapos si feasibility study, ito po ay isasubmit sa Central for funding na po.

Hon. Palabrica: Pero kasama na sa Regional Development Plan?

Engr. Raymart: Yes po, opo.

Hon. Palabrica: Ayun na importante, nasama sa plan. Kasi pag wala sa plan, walang budget.

Engr. Raymart: Yes po, tama kasama na po.

Hon. Palabrica: Saka napansin ko lang, okay lahat to. Pero parang may kulang eh. Wala kasi our perennial problem is flooding. So may proposal ba DPWH is about mitigation man lang?

Engr. Raymart: Yun po kasing naging direktiba nung aming secretary, bagong sa secretary po si Vince Dizon. Hold po muna yung mga flood control projects dahil nga po.

Hon. Palabrica: Tiis muna kami sa baha dito.

Engr. Raymart: Nag-focus po muna tayo sa mga multi-purpose building and construction ng roads po.

Hon. Palabrica: Dapat pala ang disaster natin mag-invest sa rubber boat. Kasi wala mga muna projects, hold muna yung flood control.

Engr. Raymart: Opo, ayun. Pagkatapos po siguro yung issue, Mr. Chair, magkakaroon na po ulit.

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Hon. Palabrica: natanong ko lang kasi syempre, perennial problem namin yung bahal talaga. Although, deeply appreciated yung effort ninyo. Para sa Bacoor, thank you very much sa inyo. Thank you, Mr. Chair.

Hon. Tela: Sa DPWH italaga naman po papasalamat ng sanggunian na ang pagparito nyo po ay napaka laking halaga at na maunawaan ng sanggunian kung ano yung mahalagang bagay para sa ikundad ng City of Bacoor. At the same time, kay Engineer Jicky, na talaga naman po, napaka, ano yan eh, action man talaga yan. Kung may problema kagad eh, nandiyan kagad yan, nakalalay, yung natatanong nga niyo, eh, kung natulog na. Sobra po yan eh, katulad ng aming butihing mayor. Talaga naman po, tinitignan ng ayos. Eh, sabi nga rin ni Konsehal Rey, talaga naman pero sa amin yung, ano, flood control. Kasi low areas nung Bacoor eh. Bagsakan ng tubig galing sa upland. Pero thank you na rin po sa mga project na may bibigay ng DPWH sa Taga Bacoor. Yan lang po. Mga ibang KOnsehal baka meron kayong ibang tanong sa DPWH.

Hon. Advincula: Thank you po, Konsehal Advincula po, palagay ko, nadadagdagan na. Ang trabaho ng ating city engineer, yung walang tulog ng 24 hours, nadadagdagan sa 72. Kaya engineer, eh, may babantayan ka kung ito ba ay ito ba standard. Ah, una po sa lahat, nagpapasalamat po ang sanggunian at eh, isa po, ang una po ang ating po mayor, isa po sa priority ng DPWH na magbigay po ng proyekto dito sa lungsod ng Bacoor. Ah, kaya po, talagang saludo po kami sa mga DPWH. Maraming maraming salamat po yun lang po. Thank you.

Hon. Ugalde: Ah, thank you, Mr. Chair, una sa lahat, nagpapasalamat tayo sa DPWH, sa mga proyekto pinakaloob sa ating mahal na siyudad. Kahit na medyo mainit ang labanan ngayon sa DP. Nandoon pa rin ang suporta sa ating mahal na siyudad. Ganoon din ang ating engineer na hindi tumitigil sa trabaho kahit na nahihirapan, tinitis ang lahat. Yan po lamang, Mr. Chair, at good afternoon muli sa inyong lahat.

Hon. Dominguez: Ah, siyempre nakikita ko naman talaga masipag, madilim pa, nasa Molino 3 na, nagbibisita, talaga hindi na natutulog.

Engr. Jenny: Sir, in behalf of DPWH Cavite Third District Engineering Office, maraming salamat your honors sa pagbibigay ng oras po ninyo sa amin at itong upong ating pagpupulong na ito ay talagang sama-sama po tayo na mapaunlad po ang Bacoor.

Engr. Jicky: Kami naman sa City Engineering Office, anytime kung si Mayor 24/7 ganun din naman kami, willing makipag-coordinate at tutulong sa lahat ng proyekto para sa kakaunlad ng ating Bacoor po. So, isa po ang hangarin nating lahat is mapaayos at hindi naman matanggal yung baha, at least makontrol natin. 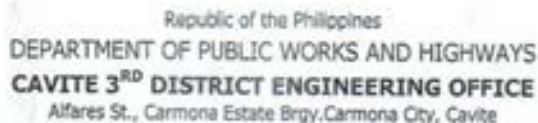

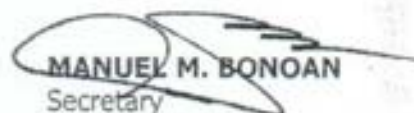

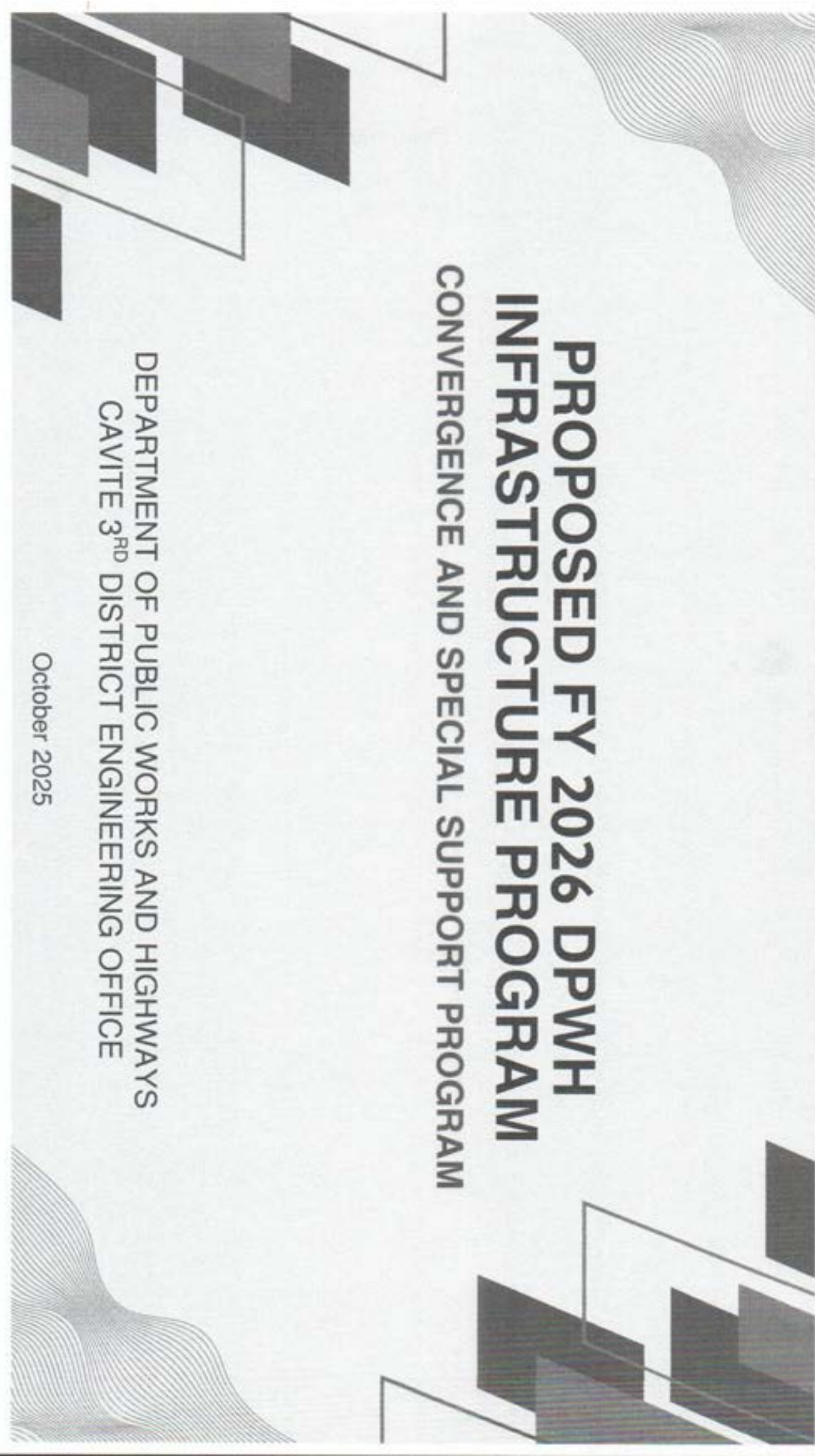

In line with existing policies of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and to ensure uniformity and accountability in the implementation of local infrastructure funded projects, the attached Right-of-Way (ROW) Certification Template is hereby adopted for use in all local infrastructure projects funded under the:

- Convergence Programs (e.g., TRIP, ROLL-IT, KATUBATAN, and Farm-to-Market Roads);
- SIPAC (Sustainable Infrastructure Projects Alleviating Gaps) Program; and
- RIP (Basic Infrastructure Program).

The Certification shall be:

1. Signed by the Municipal/City Mayor or Provincial Governor, duly authorized through a Sangguniang Resolution; and
2. Verified and endorsed by the concerned DPWH Head of Implementing Office, either the District Engineer, Regional Director, or UPHO Head.

For RIP, the Certification may be submitted any time prior to the award of contract, and no implementation shall proceed without it.

All DPWH Regional and District Engineering Offices, as well as UPHOs, are hereby directed to ensure compliance with this Department Order.

This Order shall supersede previous inconsistent issuances and shall take effect immediately.

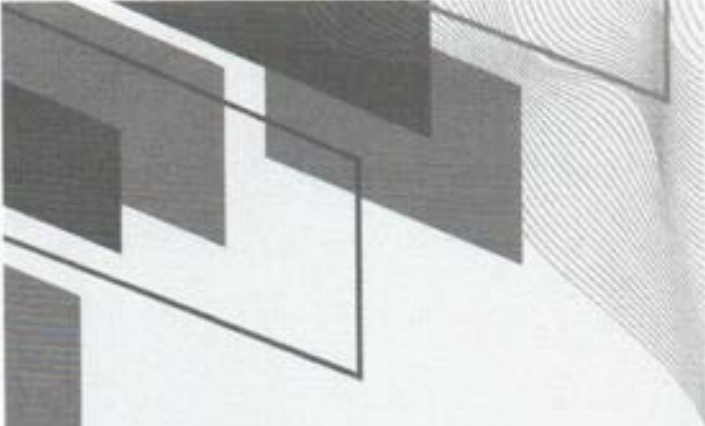
