Subject: A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (CDP) FOR THE YEAR 2026 TO 2031 AND THE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROGRAM (LDIP) FOR THE YEAR 2026 TO 2028 OF THE CITY OF BACOOR. **PCR 205-2025** dated October 20, 2025

Referred to the Joint Committee on the 16th Regular Session of 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod is the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

INFORMATION:

In his letter dated October 15, 2025, City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Bacoor City, the following resolution for approval, we quote:

"A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD THE ADOPTION AND APPROVAL OF THE COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN (CDP) 2028-2031 AND THE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROGRAM (LDIP) 2026-2028 OF THE CITY OF BACOOR. "

The endorsement consists of two separate requirements prior to the approval of the city government annual budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

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BRIEF SUMMARY:

THE COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN (CDP)

The comprehensive development plan (CDP) is a strategic plan that guides the growth and development of local government units (LGUs). It is the blueprint for decision-making and resource allocation which encompasses the social, economic, physical/infrastructure, environmental management, and institutional development. A development plan created with the participation of stakeholders with the inclusion of outlined vision, goals, and specific programs and projects needed for the next several years. (DILG MC No. 2007-27)

The purpose and function of CDP are as follows, we quote:

- **Guidance:** Provides a framework for decision-making and guides the use of land, infrastructure, and other resources.
- **Implementation:** Translates the local land use plan and the community's vision into an actionable, multi-year strategy.
- **Resource allocation:** Serves as a guide for allocating budgets and resources to priority projects.
- **Sustainability:** Aims to ensure that development is sustainable, equitable, and organized, addressing the needs of current residents while considering future generations.
- **Coordination:** Provides a basis for coordinating activities among different government agencies and stakeholders.

THE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PLAN (LDIP)

The Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) translates the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) to a budget allocation for specific programs and projects. It also serves as the bridge between long-term planning and annual budgeting, based on available funds and to improve the socio-cultural well-being and accelerate

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economic development of the communities. (DILG, NEDA,
DBM AND DOF JMC 1. S.2007)

The components and purpose (LDIP) are as follows, we quote:

- **Implementation tool:** The main tool for implementing the CDP which breaks down the goals into concrete and fundable projects.
- **Timeframe:** Typically covers 3-6 years period and aligning with the term of local officials.
- **Budget linkage:** Links the long-term plan to the annual budget of local government unit, and ensures that the budget operationalizes the development plan.
- **Annual component:** LDIP divides into an annual component for specific year which is known as the **Annual Investment Plan (AIP)**.
- **Stakeholder involvement:** Project prioritization through consultation with various stakeholders and constituencies to ensure local needs are addressed.

FINDINGS:

1. The proposed Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) and Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) conform and consistent with the guidelines set in the following circulars, as follows:
