Subject: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO PURSUE LEGAL MEASURES CONCERNING THE UNAUTHORIZED "CITY OF BACOR 2.0" FACEBOOK (META) GROUP. (PCR 271-2025 dated 17 November 2025).

Acting on the referral, the Committee conducted a committee hearing on November 17, 2025 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod relative to the above-stated subject matter. The hearing was presided over by Hon. Miguel N. Bautista, Chairperson of the Committee on Ethics, Appointments and Government Reorganization.

Honorable members of the committee were in attendance as well as the representative from the Office of the City Legal Services (OCLS). Attached as an integral part of this Committee Report is the Attendance Sheet of the said hearing.

FINDINGS:

- It has come to the attention of the Office of the City Mayor that a Facebook group identified as "City of Bacoor 2.0" has been circulating online and is misrepresenting itself as an official communication platform of the City Government of Bacoor, including unauthorized use of the city seal and other official insignia. This poses a serious risk of public misinformation, reputational damage to the City Government, and potential violations of existing laws on cybercrime, falsification, illegal use of symbols, and related offenses.
- The said authority is being requested to ensure that the City Government may respond swiftly and properly to prevent further public confusion, protect official information channels, and uphold the integrity of the City of Bacoor's official communication.
- A review of the aforementioned request from the Honorable City Mayor revealed that the allegations mentioned above are well-founded.





RECOMMENDATION:

The Committee recommends to the Sangguniang Panlungsod **TO PASS** a resolution authorizing the City Mayor to pursue legal measures concerning the unauthorized "City of Bacoor 2.0 Facebook (meta) group in order to protect the integrity of the City Government.

During the hearing, Committee Chair Hon. Bautista informed the body that it has come to the attention of the Office of the City Mayor that a Facebook group was recently created and named as "City of Bacoor 2.0". The said group is unauthorized and not affiliated with the City of Bacoor. It currently has thirty (30) members and appears to be using the official city name, official seal of the city, and branding, which potentially misleads the public into believing that the said Facebook group represents the local government.

The Committee Chair also added that the City Mayor sought the assistance of different government agencies to investigate pertaining to the creation, administration, and continued use of the Facebook group, which unlawfully bears the name and visual identifiers of the City Government of Bacoor.

There being no other matters to be discussed, the hearing was adjourned at around 12:57 PM.

WHEREAS, on 12 November 2025, Mayor Strike B. Revilla formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass a Resolution authorizing him to "undertake all appropriate legal, administrative, and cybercrime actions necessary to protect the integrity of the City Government".

WHEREAS, the said request stemmed from the creation of a Facebook group identifying itself as "City of Bacor 2.0". The said group, according to Mayor Revilla, "is misrepresenting itself as an official communication platform of the City Government of Bacor, including unauthorized use of the city seal and other official insignia."

WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor further alleged that the said Facebook group "poses a serious risk of public misinformation, reputational damage to the City Government, and potential violations of existing laws on cybercrime, falsification, illegal use of symbols, and related offenses."

WHEREAS, among the corporate powers granted under Section 3 of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Bacor") to the City Government is to sue and to be sued.

WHEREAS, Section 8, paragraph (b), sub-paragraph (2) of the RA No. 10160 empowered the City Mayor to "enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the

City and in the exercise of its appropriate corporate powers" which includes the power to sue.

WHEREAS, a review of the aforementioned request from the Honorable City Mayor revealed that the allegations mentioned above are well-founded.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Councilor Miguel N. Bautista, unanimously seconded by the City Council, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite in regular session duly assembled to authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Strike B. Revilla, to undertake all appropriate legal actions necessary to protect the integrity of the City Government which shall include, but shall not be limited to, the authority to file any legal action in the proper venue against the administrators of the Facebook group identifying itself as "City of Bacoor 2.0".

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Honorable City Mayor, the Office of the City Legal Services, and all other government offices concerned with copies of this Resolution.
