**Subject: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE MUNICIPALITY OF BARAS, AND THE NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY REGARDING THE RELOCATION AND RESETTLEMENT OF FIFTY (50) INFORMAL SETTLERS (ISFs) FROM THE CITY OF BACOOR TO BARAS, RIZAL. The above-captioned legislative measure was formally introduced and duly submitted on First Reading before the Honorable City Council on December 1, 2025, in accordance with the established legislative procedures of the City Government. The agreement aims to promote public interest, support local development initiatives, and ensure that the donated property is utilized for lawful and beneficial purposes.




