Subject: *A resolution on mandatory compliance of Tuberculosis patients to the prescribed treatment and reporting to authorities in case of transfer of residency.*

The above-mentioned subject matter underwent first reading on February 19, 2024 during the 79th Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said subject matter was referred by the Presiding Officer, Bacoor City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Health and Sanitation.

The Committee on Health and Sanitation sent out invitations to the resource persons and conducted a committee hearing on February 29, 2024 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall at 9:00 a.m.

FINDINGS:

During the meeting of the City Health Board held last February 15, 2024, it was reported that the prevalence of Drug Resistant Tuberculosis is increasing in the City of Bacoor, wherein the Drug Resistant Tuberculosis was the result of the non-adherence of patients to treatment.

According to the Office of City Health Services data, the cure rate for tuberculosis is only 62.59% and one of the reasons identified is the transfer of residence of patients without informing medical authorities which may endanger public health for tuberculosis is a contagious disease.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review of all the circumstances and statements from the resource persons, the Committee respectfully recommends that the Sangguniang Panlungsod approve the above subject matter.

By the motion of Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica duly seconded by all the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the above subject matter was **APPROVED** during its 81st Regular Session.

A committee hearing on the above-subject matter was conducted last February 29, 2024, 9:10 a.m. at the Sangguniang Panlungsod presided by Committee Chairman Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica.

- The Presiding Officer, City Councilor Hon. Reynaldo Palabrica read the above-subject matter and the committee hearing was called to order.
- The Presiding Officer then proceeded with the introduction of the members of the Honorable Committee and City Councilors present in the committee hearing.
- The Presiding Officer asked the resource persons to introduce themselves before the Honorable Committee.
- The Presiding Officer asked the City Health Services Head, Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza to give before the Honorable Committee her comments and suggestions regarding the proposed resolution.




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- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza narrated that during the meeting of the City Health Board conducted last February 15, 2024, it was reported that the prevalence of the drug resistant tuberculosis is increasing in the City of Bacoor. She further explained that it was the result of the non-adherence of the patient to treatment due to some personal reasons, work or even transfer of residency.
- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza also stated that Tuberculosis Nurses handling TB cases in the City also reported the cure rate for the ailment is only 62.59% and one of the reasons identified is the transfer of residence of tuberculosis patients without informing medical authorities resulting to the non-adherence of patients to treatment.
- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza mentioned that the present situation may endanger public health for tuberculosis is a contagious disease.
- The Presiding Officer manifested that the proposed ordinance is needed to regulate and control the present situation of tuberculosis cases in the city and for the safety of the general public.
- The Presiding Officer asked comments/suggestions from the members of the Honorable Committee.
- City Councilor Hon. Alde Pagulayan saw no reason not to approve the proposed resolution and proceeded with the motion of approving the same, duly seconded by all the members of the Honorable Committee.
- The Presiding Officer solicited a motion for the adjournment of the committee hearing.
- City Councilor Hon. Alde Pagulayan moved for the adjournment of the committee hearing duly seconded by all the members of the Honorable Committee present.
- The committee hearing ended at 9:15 a.m.
