Subject: *A resolution approving the CDRRMC Resolution No. 08 Series of 2024 entitled "A resolution requesting the Sangguniang Panlungsod to declare the existence of a state of calamity in Sitio Wawa, Barangay Zapote 3 which sustained massive property damages when a fire broke out in the early morning of 07 August 2024.*

(Date referred: August 13, 2024)

The above-mentioned proposed resolution underwent its first reading on August 13, 2024 during the 103rd Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed ordinance was referred by the Presiding Officer, City Vice-Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances.

FINDINGS:

A fire broke out in a residential unit at Sitio Wawa Longos in Barangay Zapote 3 in the early morning of 07 August 2024, that rapidly spread to adjacent residential units which were mostly made from light materials thereby affecting around 600 families whose houses were destroyed.

The affected families were relocated and stayed at various covered courts which served as the evacuation centers.

There was a need to extend immediate assistance to the fire victims like hot meals, clothings and dry good and financial assistance for their temporary shelters.





RECOMMENDATION:

By the motion of Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica duly seconded by all the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the above subject matter was **APPROVED** during its 103rd Regular Session.

“A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SANGGUNIANG PANGLUNGSOD TO DECLARE THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF CALAMITY IN SITIO WAWA, BARANGAY ZAPOTE 3 WHICH SUSTAINED MASSIVE PROPERTY DAMAGES WHEN A FIRE INCIDENT BROKE OUT IN THE EARLY MORNING OF 07 AUGUST 2024.”

WHEREAS, in the early morning of 07 August 2024, a fire broke out in a residential unit Sitio Wawa, Barangay Zapote 3, City of Bacoor, Cavite, that rapidly spread to adjacent residential units which were mostly made from light materials;

WHEREAS, initial damage and needs assessment in Sitio Wawa, Barangay Zapote 3 showed that there were around 600 families affected by the fire incident;

WHEREAS, the affected families were relocated and presently staying at various covered courts which serves as the evacuation centers;

WHEREAS, there is a need to extend immediate assistance to the fire victims i.e., hot meals and dry goods, financial assistance for their temporary shelters;

ENCLOSURE: RESOLUTION NO. 08 s. 2024 of BACOOR CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL.

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NOW, THEREFORE, on the motion of Ms. Emiliana D.R. Ugalde, City Social Welfare and Development Officer, and unanimously seconded by all the members present, **BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved to request the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass a resolution declaring the existence of a state of calamity in Sitio Wawa, Barangay Zapote 3 and to authorize City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, City DRRM Council Chairperson, to disburse the amount of Fifteen Million Pesos (P15,000,000.00) from the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund to be used as quick response fund for relief goods and other incidental expenses related to relief and rehabilitation operations.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod for its appropriate action.

Morales, Ground Commander, it was then raised to Second Alarm at 0121H by F/SInsp. Precious V. Petalio, Ground Commander. It was declared Fire Under Control at 0250H and Fire Out at 0355H by F/SInsp. Precious V. Petalio, Ground Commander. The immediate response from our local BFP and Fire Volunteers, ensured the containment of the incident. There were standby EMS personnel on scene to ensure the safety of the responders and the community. Initial information showed that was more or less six hundred (600) residential units affected occupied by more or less six hundred (600) families. There was one (1) casualty involved in the incident.
