Subject: A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD TO DECLARE THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF CALAMITY IN SITIO KANLURAN, BARANGAY ZAPOTE 3 AND TALABA 2 WHICH SUSTAINED MASSIVE PROPERTY DAMAGES WHEN A FIRE BROKE OUT IN THE MORNING OF 10 SEPTEMBER, 2024. (PCR 674 -2024 dated 11 September 2024)

Respectfully submitted to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the hereunder report on the above-mentioned subject matter. The committee reports the following:

- In the early morning of 10 September 2024, a fire broke out in a residential unit in Sitio Tabon, Barangay Zapote 3, City of Bacoor, Cavite, that rapidly spread to adjacent residential units which were mostly made from light materials:
- Initial damage and needs assessment in Sitio Kanluran, Barangay Zapote3 and Sitio Tabon, Barangays Zapote 3 and Talaba 2 showed that there were around 1,050 families affected by the fire incident;
- The affected families were relocated and presently staying at various covered courts which serves as the evacuation centers:
- There is a need to extend immediate assistance to the fire victims i.e., hot meals and dry goods, financial assistance for their temporary shelters.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view thereof, the committee respectfully recommends the APPROVAL of a resolution declaring the existence of a state of calamity in Sitio Kanluran, Barangay Zapote 3 and Sitio Tabon, Barangays Zapote 3 and Talab 2 and to authorize City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, City DRRM Council Chairperson, to disburse the amount of fifteen million pesos (PHP 15,000,000.00) from the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund to be used as quick response fund for relief goods and other incidental expenses related to relief and rehabilitation operations.

Subject: A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD TO DECLARE THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF CALAMITY IN SITIO KANLURAN, BARANGAY ZAPOTE 3 AND SITIO TABON, BARANGAYS ZAPOTE 3 AND TALABA 2 WHICH SUSTAINED MASSIVE PROPERTY DAMAGES WHEN A FIRE BROKE OUT IN THE MORNING OF 10 SEPTEMBER, 2024. (PCR 674-2024 dated 11 September 2024)

During the Council's Special Session last 11 September 2024, Hon. Alejandro Gutierrez informed the Council members regarding the fire that broke out in a residential unit in Sitio Kanluran, Barangay Zapote 3 and Sitio Tabon, Barangays Zapote3 and Talaba 2 in the early morning of 10 September 2024. He also mentioned that the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council passed Resolution No. 09-2024 recommending the utilization of fifteen million pesos (Php 15.000,000.00) from the Quick Response Fund (QRF) of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (CDRRMF) by the City Mayor for various disaster prevention, mitigation, recovery and relief operations for the benefit of Bacooreños who were affected by the aforementioned fire incident. He then moved that a resolution be passed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor declaring the existence of a state of calamity in Barangay Zapote 3 and Talaba 2. The motion met no objection and was unanimously seconded by the Council. It was deemed approved by the Chair.
