FINDINGS:

1. The City of Bacoor is a consistent awardee and compliant to the necessary requirements of the Annual Child-Friendly Local Governance Audit (CFLGA) categorized on four major rights of children namely: Survival, Development, Protection and Participation plus the Governance category.

 - Founding Recognition and Protection Act (RA 11767)
 - Instituting a Policy of Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education Act (RA 11650)
 - Stronger Protection against Rape and Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (RA 11648)
 - Domestic Administrative Adoption and Alternative Child Care Act (RA 11642)
 - Anti-Child Marriage Law (RA 11596)
 - Alternative Learning System Act (RA 11510)
 - Safe Spaces Act (RA 11313)
 - Child Safety in Motor Vehicles Act (RA 11229)
