Subject: A resolution adopting Republic Act No. 11332 or "Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act"

(Date referred: March 31, 2025)

The above-mentioned proposed resolution underwent its first reading on March 31, 2025 during the 134th Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed resolution was referred by the Presiding Officer, City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Health and Sanitation.

FINDINGS:

Republic Act No. 11332 was signed into law on August 22, 2018 and mandates the establishment of a system for the mandatory reporting of notifiable diseases and health events of public health concern, including the imposition of penalties for non-compliance.

The objective of this act is to strengthen the national health surveillance system, improve the detection and monitoring of public health threats, and allow for timely, coordinated responses to public health emergencies, including the prevention and control of infectious diseases and other health events of public concern.

The City Health Board of Bacoor recognizes the importance of a robust public health response system and the need for continuous improvement in the management of notifiable diseases and health events that could affect the health and safety of the residents of the City of Bacoor.



(Date referred: March 31, 2025)

The 134th Regular Session was held last March 31, 2025 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panglungsod. City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola presided the Regular Session and was called to order at exactly 10:00 a.m.

Khalid Atega, Jr., Secretary of the Sangguniang Panlungsod proceeded with the roll call, the approval of the Journal and minutes of the 133rd Regular Session, and the reading of the referrals to committees of proposed Ordinances, Resolutions, Messages, Communications, Petitions and Memorials.

RESOLUTION NO. 13 - 2024

RESOLUTION REQUESTING SANGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD FOR CITY HEALTH BOARD RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPUBLIC ACT 11332 OR THE "MANDATORY REPORTING OF NOTIFIABLE DISEASES AND HEALTH EVENTS OF PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERN ACT" /

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11332, also known as the "Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act", was signed into law on August 22, 2018, and mandates the establishment of a system for the mandatory reporting of notifiable diseases and health events of public health concern, including the imposition of penalties for non-compliance.

WHEREAS, the objective of Republic Act No. 11332 is to strengthen the national health surveillance system, improve the detection and monitoring of public health threats, and allow for timely, coordinated responses to public health emergencies, including the prevention and control of infectious diseases and other health events of public concern;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) has issued guidelines for the implementation of the provisions of RA 11332, and local health authorities are tasked with ensuring that the law is strictly implemented at the local level;

WHEREAS, the City Health Board of Bacoor recognizes the importance of a robust public health response system and the need for continuous improvement in the management of notifiable diseases and health events that could affect the health and safety of the residents of the City of Bacoor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the City Health Board of Bacoor, in session duly assembled, that:

- Adoption of RA 11332: The provisions of Republic Act No. 11332, particularly the mandatory reporting of notifiable diseases and health events of public health concern, are hereby adopted for implementation within the jurisdiction of the City of Baccor.
- Coordination with Relevant Authorities: The City Health Office, in coordination with the Department of Health (DOH) and other relevant agencies, is directed to establish and implement an effective and efficient system for the reporting,

monitoring, and management of notifiable diseases and health events of public health concern.

- Public Awareness and Education: The City Health Office shall take proactive measures to ensure public awareness regarding the provisions of RA 11332, including informing residents, health care providers, and other stakeholders of their obligations under the law.
- Training and Capacity Building: The City Health Office is tasked with providing training programs for health workers, government officials, and relevant personnel to ensure proper understanding and effective implementation of the provisions of RA 11332.
- Imposition of Penalties: In accordance with the law, penalties for noncompliance with the mandatory reporting requirements of RA 11332, as specified in the implementing rules and regulations (IRR), shall be enforced within the jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor.
- Monitoring and Evaluation: The City Health Board shall ensure the establishment of a monitoring and evaluation system to track the implementation of the law and its impact on improving public health response in the city.
- Effectivity: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


