

Subject: — A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND VARIOUS NATIONAL AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES FOR THE CREATION OF ZAPOTE RIVER WATERSHED MANAGEMENT COUNCIL. (PCR 808-2025 dated April 14, 2025).

Sangguniang Panlungsod members met to call the 139th executive session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod on May 5, 2025 at 10:00 am. It was presided over by Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola. And referred the above subject matter to the Chairperson of the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, Hon. Levy M. Tela.

FINDINGS:

To ensure that the creation of Watershed Management Councils adheres to the participatory, collaborative, multi-sectoral, and inter-disciplinary principle of watershed management, following existing laws, rules, and regulations, and standardizing and providing guidance.

To enhance and develop the collaboration among the various government agencies, Local Government Units (LGUs), and other relevant stakeholders in the watershed administration.

To enhance the technical and operational capabilities of the DENR, LGU, and other stakeholders involved in the Watershed Management Council.

Calls for the DENR as the primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management, protection, and sustainable development of the country's environmental and natural resources. The LGUs, who are responsible for the sustainable management and development of forest resources and watersheds within their territories, likewise, mutually commit themselves to the pursuit of these objectives under a development approach that is demand-driven and participatory, and that utilizes multiple and sustainable uses.

















ROLES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE ZAPOTE RIVER WATERSHED MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

The Zapote River Watershed Management Council shall serve as an oversight and advisory body that:

- Create a Watershed Management Planning Team (WMPT) for the preparation of an Integrated Watershed Management Plan (IWMP) to include, among others, protection, restoration and rehabilitation, water quality monitoring and delineation of buffer zone; Approve the IWMP endorsed by the WMPT;
- Participate in the formulation of policies that support inter-agency coordination, collaboration, cooperation, partnership & convergence, and complementation of natural resources benefits and cost-sharing, and resources planning and program implementation;
- Contribute to the management of the resources and development activities stipulated under the approved IWMP:
- Review existing policies governing their specific watershed and recommend appropriate revisions/amendments to concerned agencies, if necessary;
- Join in the monitoring of the activities, such as rehabilitation and protection, among others, within their particular watershed;
- Ensure enforcement of Environmental and Natural Resources (ENR) laws, rules, and regulations in coordination with DENR and concerned agencies;
- Endorse persons for deputation by the DENR;
- Facilitate the resolution of problems and conflicts that may occur within their particular watershed, in coordination with concerned agencies;
- Support and participate in activities that promote and establish awareness of watershed management and resource use;
- Develop a Manual of Operations including internal rules, regulations, guidelines, and funding mechanisms with regard to the conduct and principles for the proper functioning and guidance of the Council;
- Coordinate with existing watershed management bodies present within the watershed (Protected Area Management Board, Water Quality Management, etc.) to ensure that watershed programs, projects, and activities of the council complement those of other watershed management bodies; and
- Present to RDC the Integrated Watershed Management Plan for adoption.



WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution under Article II, Section 16 provides for the protection and advancement of the right of the Filipino people to a balanced and healthful ecology; under Article II, Section 10 provides for the promotion of social justice; Article XIII, Section 16 guarantees the right of the people and their organization to reasonable participation at all levels of social, political and economic decision making;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 known as the Local Government Code directs and authorizes local government to establish, maintain, preserve, and conserve communal forests and watersheds;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 192 mandates the DENR as the primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management, protection, and proper use and sustainable development of the country's environmental and natural resources and the LGUs, who have the responsibility for sustainable management and development of forest resources and watersheds within their territories likewise, mutually commit themselves to pursue such objectives under multiple and sustainable uses, demand-driven and participation, development approach;

WHEREAS, the DENR Offices having jurisdiction over Zapote River Watershed, namely: DENR NCR, through DENR NCR South Field Office, with office address 2nd Flr., DM Building, Aldebaran Street Zapote, Las Piñas City and DENR CALABARZON, through PENRO Office Cavite with office address at Government Center, Trece Martires, Cavite.

WHEREAS, the DPWH Offices having jurisdiction over Zapote River Watershed, namely: DPWH NCR through DPWH-NCR, Las Piñas-Muntinlupa District Engineering Office, with office address 2ND St. Port Area, Manila and DPWH CALABARZON.

WHEREAS, the DAR Offices having jurisdiction over Zapote River Watershed, namely DAR CALABARZON through the DAR Provincial Office of Cavite, with office address at 2/F Government Center Building, Provincial Capitol Compound, Trece Martitres City, Cavite 4109.

WHEREAS, the DA Offices having jurisdiction over Zapote River Watershed, namely DA CALABARZON through the DA-Agricultural Program Coordinating Office (APCO) Cavite, with office address at Brgy. Daang Amaya I, Tanza, Cavite.

WHEREAS, the role of the non-government, people's and civic organizations in local governance and administration in the area of environmental protection and management is promoted and mandated in the Local Government Code;

WHEREAS, Section 58 of Republic Act No. 8371 otherwise known as the Indigenous People's Rights Act (IPRA), states that the Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples (ICC/IPs) shall be given the responsibility to maintain, manage, and conserve ancestral domains which are found to be necessary for critical watersheds, mangroves, wildlife sanctuaries, wilderness, protected areas, forest covers, or reforestation with full and effective assistance of government agencies;

WHEREAS, the management of watersheds should achieve the following goals: (1) sustainable multiple use of natural resources within the watersheds in a manner that is environmentally sound, economically viable, and socially acceptable; and (2) the prevention of further watershed degradation and the restoration of the productive and protective function of currently degraded watersheds:

WHEREAS, effective and purposive collaboration of development initiatives among all stakeholders in a watershed, including Local Government Units, National Government Agencies, Non-Government Organizations, People's Organizations, and the Private Sector, will hasten and facilitate the achievement of these goals.

Section 1. Creation of the Watershed Management Council – To carry out the objectives outlined for managing the Zapote River Watershed, the Zapote River Watershed Management Council is hereby created.

Section 2. Composition of the Zapote River Watershed Management Council – The Zapote River Watershed Management Council shall be composed of the following or their duly authorized representatives of all parties to this agreement, to wit:

Chairperson

Regional Executive Director DENR IV-A (CALABARZON) Co-Chairperson

Governor of the Province of Cavite

Core Members

Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services DENR IV-A (CALABARZON)

PENR Officer of PENRO Cavite

City Mayors of the City of Dasmarinas and City of Bacoor City in the Province of Cavite; and City Mayors of the City of Muntinlupa and Las Pinas City in the National Capital Region

Regional Directors of DPWH IV-A and NCR, DA IV-A, DAR IV-A and NCR, DHSUD IV-A and NCR, NCIP IV-A, and NWRB

Regional Manager of NIA, Region IV-A

Each member shall appoint a permanent and alternate representative of their office/department/agency or organization through a letter addressed to the Chairperson within 15 days from the signing of this Agreement.

Section 3. Roles and Functions of the Zapote River Watershed Management Council - The Zapote River Watershed Management Council shall serve as an oversight and advisory body that:

- Create a Watershed Management Planning Team (WMPT) for the preparation of an Integrated Watershed Management Plan (IWMP) to include, among others, protection, restoration and rehabilitation, water quality monitoring and delineation of buffer zone;
- 2. Approve the IWMP endorsed by the WMPT;
- Participate in the formulation of policies that support inter-agency coordination, collaboration, cooperation, partnership & convergence, and complementation of natural resources benefits and cost-sharing, and resources planning and program implementation;
- Contribute to the management of the resources and development activities stipulated under the approved IWMP;
- Review existing policies governing their specific watershed and recommend appropriate revisions/amendments to concerned agencies, if necessary;
- Join in the monitoring of the activities, such as rehabilitation and protection, among others, within their particular watershed;
- Ensure enforcement of Environmental and Natural Resources (ENR) laws, rules, and regulations in coordination with DENR and concerned agencies;
- Endorse persons for deputation by the DENR;
- Facilitate the resolution of problems and conflicts that may occur within their particular watershed, in coordination with concerned agencies;
- Support and participate in activities that promote and establish awareness of watershed management and resource use;

- Develop a Manual of Operations including internal rules, regulations, guidelines, and funding mechanisms with regard to the conduct and principles for the proper functioning and guidance of the Council;
- 12. Coordinate with existing watershed management bodies present within the watershed (Protected Area Management Board, Water Quality Management, etc.) to ensure that watershed programs, projects, and activities of the council complement those of other watershed management bodies; and
- 13. Present to RDC the Integrated Watershed Management Plan for adoption.

Section 4. Term of Office – The Chairperson, who is the DENR IV-A Regional Executive Director, shall have a term of two (2) years. Nevertheless, the Chairpersonship of the Watershed Management Council shall remain with the DENR IV-A. In the case of elective LGU officials, whether Chairperson or members of the Council, the term of Office shall be coterminous to his/her position. Once the term of Office of the incumbent expires, the next official the new elected official of the same position shall assume the position.

Section 5. Effectivity – This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon the signing of the parties herein, agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall remain in force and effect perpetually unless sooner revoked, terminated or modified by the parties

Section 6. Funding - The DENR shall allocate funds for the creation and operationalization of the Watershed Management Council in its annual budgeting program
