Subject: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD THROUGH COAST GUARD DISTRICT NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION - CENTRAL LUZON REGARDING THE RELOCATION OF THE COAST GUARD SUB-STATION BACOOR TO BARANGAY TALABA IV, CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE. (PCR 819-2025 dated 28 April 2025).

After a thorough review of the documents presented regarding the above-mentioned subject matter, a close coordination and consultation with all the members of the Council, the undersigned arrived at a conclusion that all the documents are in order.

Thus, the committee respectfully reports that:

- The said transfer is envisioned to enhance operational efficiency by providing improved accessibility for land mobility, enabling quicker response times in disaster situations, and strengthening maritime safety and security measures. Additionally, the suggested facility is expected to better accommodate the personnel assigned to Coast Guard Sub-Station Bacoor, thereby improving overall operational effectiveness;
- The Memorandum of Agreement seeks to establish a formal collaboration for the relocation of the Coast Guard Sub-Station Bacoor. It is believed that this partnership will significantly benefit the residents of Bacoor by promoting safety, security, and preparedness in the community;
- The Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), in coordination with the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and other appropriate government agencies, shall identify and implement a nationwide development plan for the PCG bases and other infrastructure facilities that include search and rescue, aids to navigation, maritime communications, marine pollution laboratories, medical facilities, and personnel barracks and quarters, among others so to establish strategic presence in the promotion of maritime safety, security and environmental protection.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into by and between:

HON. STRIKE B REVILLA, Mayor, City of Bacoor, Cavite, and resident of Bacoor City, Cavite and hereinafter referred to as "**FIRST PARTY**";

-and-

PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD through **COASTGUARD DISTRICT NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION - CENTRAL LUZON**, a duly established District of the Philippine Coast Guard exercising jurisdiction over the National Capital Region, Central Luzon and part of Region IV-A, with principal office address at Muelle Dela Industria, Farola Compound, Binondo Manila, Metro Manila represented herein by its Commander, **COMMO CHRISTOPHER M MENIADO PCG**, hereinafter referred to as "**SECOND PARTY**";

-WITNESSETH-

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY**, in coordination with Department of Transportation (DOTr) and other appropriate government agencies, shall Identify, and implement a nationwide development plan for the **PCG** bases and other infrastructure facilities that include search and rescue, aids to navigation, maritime communications, marine pollution laboratories, medical facilities, and personnel barracks and quarters, among others so to establish strategic presence in the promotion of maritime safety, security and environmental protection;

WHEREAS, the relocation of Coast Guard Sub-Station Bacoor to promote and strengthen the maritime safety, maritime security, maritime environmental protection, maritime law enforcement and other coast guard function of all applicable laws within the waters of Bacoor and the country's maritime jurisdiction. It may also easily apprise the local populace and stakeholders for any policies and measures of PCG to protect and safeguard the waters of Bacoor and its marine resources;

WHEREAS, FIRST PARTY, has authorized **SECOND PARTY** to occupy and maintained the office space/building located at BDRRM Office, City Operations Center Building, Brgy. Talaba IV, City of Bacoor, Cavite, Philippines.

WHEREAS, FIRST PARTY, shall provide an office space/building to the **SECOND PARTY** to be used as relocation of new Sub-Station Building within the vicinity of Brgy. Talaba IV, City of Bacoor, Cavite, Philippines.



WHEREAS, FIRST PARTY, consider it to be in the interest of public service that said office space /building of in the above-mentioned location be used exclusively by the Philippine Coast Guard Sub-Station Bacoar personnel as their billeting and office space;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual herein contained, the PARTIES agree as follows:

Article I. Duties and Responsibilities of FIRST PARTY:

1. Shall provide the **SECOND PARTY** an office space/building for office and billeting space for Coast Guard Sub-Station located at BDRRM Office, City Operations Center Building, Brgy. Talaba IV, City Bacoar, Cavite, Philippines free of charge;
2. Shall allow the **SECOND PARTY** the access to the water supply, electricity and other utilities with the assigned service providers;
3. Shall cooperate in the implementation and promotion of PCG' core function in maritime safety, marine environmental protection, maritime security, maritime search and rescue and enforcement of all applicable laws within the waters of Bacoar and the country's maritime jurisdiction;
4. Shall ensure the peaceful, uninterrupted and undisturbed occupation of the subject property by **SECOND PARTY** and Bacoar (CGSS) other entities occupying the vicinity within the said property shall be advised for that matter;
5. Shall allow the **SECOND PARTY** and Bacoar (CGSS) to construct, renovated, install and maintain at its own expense improvements and/or facilities as may be necessary and useful to its operation.

Article II. Duties and Responsibilities of SECOND PARTY:

1. Use and develop the allocated office space/building as an office and billeting space of Coast Guard Sub-Station Bacoar.
2. Maintained the duly designated area in clean and sanitary condition;
3. Be primarily responsible for actual supervision and control of its personnel/troops while within the premises of the property.

Article III. Other Provisions:

1. Either Party shall not hold each other, its officers and employees accountable for damages and free the same from any civil, administrative or criminal liability arising from any untoward incident that may arise which is directly or indirectly related to activities attributed solely to the acts, fault, omission or negligence each other's personnel.
2. This MOA embodies the entire agreement of the **Parties**. There are no terms, conditions or stipulations other than those set forth. No amendment, modification or waiver on any of the provisions of this Agreement or any consent to any departure therein, shall in any event be effective unless the same be made in writing and signed by the parties concerned.



3. Should any provision, section or part of this agreement be adjudged or declared illegal or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect not impair the remaining provisions, sections or part which shall continue to be in force and effect. The **Parties** agree to substitute the nullified provision with a valid and enforceable one.
4. This MOA is automatically renewed after the aforesaid period unless a Party shall communicate to the other Party its intention to terminate. No termination of this MOA shall be affected until written notice of the same is furnished by the party concerned to the other party at least forty-five (45) days prior to the proposed date termination. Unless for extremely justifiable reason as agreed upon by the Parties, no termination shall take effect within five (5) years from the effectivity of this MOA.
5. Should the parties agree on the termination of this MOA, the **SECOND PARTY** and its personnel shall be allowed removed any and all properties, structure, improvement, and equipment the may be removed without causing damage to the subject land and the property occupied by **SECOND PARTY**. Consequently, the **SECOND PARTY** shall be given ample time to comply with the aforesaid, and to make due notice to its stakeholders of the such removal or transfer;
6. The **Parties** hereby warrant that their respective representatives area duly authorized to enter, agree, sign, and bind them to this Agreement. This Agreement shall be valid and binding upon the parties here to and their successor-in-interest.
7. Should any dispute related to this Agreement and/or the rights and obligations of the Parties enshrined herein arise, the same shall be submitted first to mutual consultation, mediation and arbitration before going to the court-in order of application and applying the applicable Rules on Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) for Dispute Between National Government Agencies. The venue of proceeding shall be in the City of Manila;
8. In case of a court suit, the venue shall be the proper courts of the City of Manila, to the exclusion of all other courts elsewhere situated.
