Subject: *REQUEST FROM THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR WITH ST. DOMINIC COLLEGE OF ASIA REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INTERNSHIP PROGRAM. (PCR 822-2025 dated 05 May 2025)*

The proposed resolution as above-stated subject was considered during the 139th Regular Session held on 05 May 2025. The Committee on Education, Science, and Technology, chaired by Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan reports that:

The proposed MOA seeks to establish an internship program that would enable qualified students from St. Dominic College of Asia (SDCA) to engage in practical training within the offices and departments of the City Government of Bacoor. This initiative is designed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application, promoting experiential learning through direct involvement in public service.

FINDINGS:

The Committee finds that both the City Government and SDCA have expressed willingness and readiness to formalize the partnership through the execution of the said Memorandum of Agreement (MOA).

The internship program is envisioned to:

- Provide students with pre-graduation on-the-job training to enhance their competencies in office and technical functions;
- Improve the interns' knowledge, skills, and professional attitudes in preparation for future employment;
- Instill the values of civic responsibility, leadership, and public service;
- Support the City Government's broader goals of youth empowerment and educational advancement.





RECOMMENDATION:

After due evaluation, the Committee respectfully recommends the **APPROVAL** of the proposed resolution authorizing the City Mayor to sign the Memorandum of Agreement with St. Dominic College of Asia regarding the implementation of the internship program.

This partnership is aligned with the City Government's commitment to foster education, youth development, and community engagement.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into by and between:

_____, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines, with business/office address located at _____, represented herein by its _____, **MR./MS.** _____, hereinafter referred to as "**THE COMPANY**".

- and -

ST. DOMINIC COLLEGE OF ASIA, an educational institution duly recognized and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with office located at St. Dominic Complex, E. Aguinaldo Highway, Bacoor City, Cavite, Philippines represented herein by its **President, Dr. GREGORIO A. ANDAMAN JR.**, hereinafter referred to as "**THE SCHOOL**".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, THE SCHOOL has instituted an On-the-Job Training Program wherein qualified students undergo training prior to graduation in order to adequately familiarize with actual office and/or technical operations and management to augment their formal learning;

WHEREAS, THE COMPANY, in its concern to enhance the knowledge, skills, attitude, and values of prospective business professionals, has agreed to accept selected students at the School as on-the-job trainees in various departments;

WHEREAS, all parties are cognizant of the need for cooperative endeavor and fully aware of the mutual advantages and benefits that could be mustered in undertaking a joint venture.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree on and stipulate the following:

A. THE COMPANY shall:

1. Select on-the-job trainees according to **THE COMPANY'S** recruitment process;
2. Ensure that selected on-the-job trainees undergo training related to their course, and provide the student interns with work or activities that are varied and challenging;
3. Provide students with an orientation about **THE COMPANY** rules, proper attitudes,

behavior, and work ethics inside the internship site;

4. Assign an immediate supervisor who will delegate tasks and monitor the performance of the on-the-job trainees;
5. Adhere to all regulations and labor laws, ensure a safe and conducive working environment for the on-the-job trainees and seek prior written consent from the school if on-the-job trainees will be assigned on a graveyard shift, outside office premises, or will have any out-of-town trips;
6. Provide free duty meal per shift to on-the-job trainees;
7. Provide monetary transportation allowance or it's equivalent;
8. Allow a representative of the school to have a scheduled visit within **THE COMPANY** premises;
9. Provide a certificate of completion to on-the-job trainees after finishing the required number of hours as agreed by both parties; and
10. Accomplish a student evaluation should **THE SCHOOL** require.

B. THE SCHOOL shall:

1. Endorse students for consideration of **THE COMPANY** as on-the-job trainees and in doing so, provide an endorsement letter indicating the full name of the student, course, and number of hours required to accomplish;
2. Designate a coordinator as point of contact of **THE COMPANY** on various activities or concerns regarding on-the-job trainees;
3. Together with the students, faculty, and parents concerned, renounce and waive any claim against **THE COMPANY** for any injury or loss that the on-the-job trainees may sustain or may suffer, personal or pecuniary, in the performance of their duties and functions while under training not attributable to the negligence or wilful act of any of the personnel of **THE COMPANY**; and
4. In connection with the preceding paragraph, **THE SCHOOL** hereby secures and maintains insurance, subject to its policy limits, for any accident which may occur during the entire period of the internship program.

C. TERMS AND CONDITIONS. Under this Agreement, the following terms and conditions are likewise included:

1. It is expressly understood that there will be no employer-employee relationship between **THE COMPANY** and the students of **THE SCHOOL**;
2. The on-the-job trainees will be personally responsible for any and all liabilities for damage to property or injury to third persons, which may be occasioned by their intentional or negligent acts while in the course of their training;
3. The on-the-job trainees and **THE SCHOOL** shall abide by **THE COMPANY**'s rules and regulations made known to them and comply with those imposed for the internship program;
4. It is expressly understood by **THE SCHOOL** and the on-the-job trainees that all information on technology, manufacturing process, process standards, quality assurance methodologies, quality standards, production capabilities, raw material purchasing, marketing, finance and all other related documents, manuals, and

operational or technical matters that **THE COMPANY** shall make available to them shall be used for the sole purpose of student training. All of these matters are classified as confidential in nature and proprietary to **THE COMPANY** and the on-the-job trainees hereby undertake to prevent transfer of such information by any of its members to any party outside of **THE COMPANY** without the knowledge and written consent of **THE COMPANY**;

5. During the effectivity of this Agreement, it is understood that on-the-job trainees shall follow all rules and regulations, policies and procedures duly promulgated by **THE COMPANY**;
6. **THE COMPANY** reserves the right to discontinue the On-the-Job Training of any trainee on reasonable grounds upon written notice to **THE SCHOOL**. The discontinuation shall take effect immediately upon receipt of the said notice; and
7. **THE SCHOOL** may likewise, pull-out on-the-job trainees for reasonable grounds after a written notice. The written notice shall immediately take effect upon receipt of the notice by **THE COMPANY**;
8. Both parties shall exert all efforts necessary to achieve the objectives of this joint undertaking; and
9. Neither of the parties shall be liable to any way for the failure to observe or perform any provision of this Agreement if such failure shall be caused by any law, rule regulation of any constituted public authority or shall be to any cause beyond the control of the party in default.

D. CONFIDENTIALITY

This agreement, as well as its terms and conditions herein shall be held in strict confidence and that no portion or part hereof may be reproduced or be revealed to any personnel or entity other than the signatories herein or their authorized representative.

E. EFFECTIVITY

This agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof and shall be valid for the period of **3** years thereafter, either party may terminate this agreement and anytime by serving written notice to the other party, giving thirty (30) days lead time before the intended date of termination.

It is mutually agreed upon that this agreement will not be modified except by written amendment executed by the contracting parties.
