Subject: *LETTER FROM THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE: REQUEST TO REVIEW ON BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO. 001-2025 SERIES OF 2025, FROM BARANGAY BAYANAN ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE SEGREGATION AY SOURCE OF ALL INSTITUTIONAL, HOUSEHOLD, AGRICULTURAL, AND COMMERCIAL WASTE INTO WET OR BIODEGRADABLE AND DRY OR NON-BIODEGRADABLE WASTE, REQUIRING THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF. (PNOA 891-2025 dated April 14, 2025).*

The committee held a committee hearing on May 7, 2025, at 9:42 am. It was presided over by the Chairperson of the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, Hon. Levy M. Tela. The attendance sheets during the said hearing are attached hereto and shall be made integral parts of this Report

FINDINGS:

In section 10 of R.A. No. 9003 (also known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) provides that the "LGU's shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this ACT within their respective jurisdictions. Segregation and collection of solid wastes shall be conducted in the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes: provided that the collection of non-recyclable material and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the city".

In Section 21 of R.A 9003 further provides that LGUs shall evaluate alternative roles for the public and private sectors in providing collection services, type of collection system, or combination of systems, that best meet their needs: Provided, that segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources.





With the growing population of the Barangay, now producing more solid waste than ever before necessitating the immediate and mandatory segregation of wastes from its source in order to promote public health and protect the general welfare of the Bacooreños.

Hon. Tela: Good morning, everyone we will start now our committee hearing for the record, we acknowledge the presence of our Honorable City Councilor Adriel Gawaran.

Hon. Gawaran: Good morning, Mr. Chair, Councilor Levy Tela. Good morning, Department Heads. Good morning, Barangay Captain Alfie Gawaran and Kanyang mga kagawad, guests, ladies and gentlemen. Mabuhay po tayo lahat.

Hon. Tela: And also, for the record, please state your name and your position to our resource person present.

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- Atty. Sumira: Good morning, po. Your Honor. Mr. Chair
- Hon. Tela: Good morning to Barangay Captain Gawaran.
- BP Gawaran: Good morning to our Honorable Distinguished, our, from Legal Office and from Mr. Chair, Councilor Levy Tela and Coun Adriel Gawaran and Department Heads. I'm with my Barangay Secretary. Russell Tolentino, and Pepito Miranda Barangay Admin.
- Ms. Calo: Magandang umaga po sa inyong lahat. Ako po si Teresa, Environmental Consultant ng CESD. And EIA-Registered Preparer. Thank you.
- Hon. Tela: This committee hearing is regarding to PNOA 891-2025. Letter from the City Administrator's Office: Request to review on Barangay Ordinance No. 001-2025 Series of 2025, from Barangay Bayanan entitled: An ordinance mandating the segregation ay source of all institutional, household, agricultural, and commercial waste into wet or biodegradable and dry or non-biodegradable waste, requiring the proper disposal of solid wastes, and providing penalties for violations hereof is now called to order. We have also approved City Ordinance regarding this Ordinance. Ang nakta lang po naming dito Kagalang galang Kapitan Gawaran, yung inyo pong penalties ay hindi po na aangkop sa barangay kasi ang dapat lang po is less than 1,000 pesos for the 3rd offense kaya po yun lang po ang aking masasabi at the same time kung ibig nyo pong I adopt may mga dapat po tayong ayusin po. Pwede ko pong marinig ang comment ng representative ng CESD.
- Ms. Calo: Marami pong salamat honorable chairman uh with regards to dito sa inyong barangay ordinance na tungkol sa segregation ito po ay ito po ay sariling ordinance ng barangay hindi po siya adaption so pero nakapattern po siya doon sa ating city ordinance 005 series of 2014. Now, my question is ito pong ordinance na to once na napasa siya papano niyo po siya I-implement number one when it comes sa education papano niyo ituturo ito sa inyong mga constituents ano ano yung mga aspect o yung mga bagay na ituturo niyo sa kanila pagdating dito sa ordinance na ito pangalawa ready na po ba ang barangay implemente ito halimbawa sa isang residente na nagsasegregate pero wala siyang lalagyan ng nabubulok o at yung kanyang mga recyclables no pwede siyang is segregate ready na po ba yung barangay sa mga infrastruktur ng tinatawag papano niyo itatayo yung ins or infrastruktur nito yung engineering design no so may sisidlan kayo ng inyong engineering design no so may sisidlan kayo ng inyong infrastruktur yung ating bang mouting you niyo going you very speak if you have information about what the other

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structures in the city etc. Why is this illegal? Ang nagubulok at meron kayong storage facility for recyclables. So, paano ituturo? Paano itatayo? Pangatlo, paano ipatutupad? Meron po kayong ordinansa. Paano nyo po ito ipatutupad sa inyong constituents? Number one, yung pong pagnahuli po ninyo. Anong ticket ang gagamitin po ninyo? Ang aming tanggapan ay nagbibigay ng technical assistance pagdating sa inyong enforcement sa mga barangay. Nagbibigay po kami ng training. Meron po kami ng requirement para kayo po ay magkaroon ng panikit para po ito ay maipatupad ninyo. Kailangan yung inyong mga barangay tanod or sino man ang gusto nyo i-designate na manghuhuli, no? I-de-deputize po ninyo. Dapat mag-undergo po siya ng training ng environmental police. So, una, paano ituturo? Pangalawa, paano itatayo? Pangatlo, paano ipatutupad? At dapat po, number four, masustain nyo po ito. Ngayon po, base po dito sa nakita po namin, mataas po talaga yung kanyang penalty. 2,000, 2,500, 3,000. So, minumungkahi ko po, Mr. Chairman, na sana po ito po ay mababaan ng barangay since barangay level po sila. So, yun lamang po yung aking masasabi, yung proper implementation nitong batas na to. Ito po ay napakaganda kasi isa to sa mga requirements sa Manila Bay, no? Maganda po ito. Sarili nyong ordinansa. Pero po, ang pagpapatupad po nito ay mas buti po. Kailangan po nito partner po ng at barangay officials. Continuous po ang education po nito sa ating barangay. So, yun lamang po yung gusto kong malaman sa barangay kung paano yung mga implementation na gagawin po nila dito. Makakatulong po kami sa aming tanggapan sa inyong barangay para po technical assistance po dito sa inyong ordinansa. Once ito ay napasa na po. So, yun lamang po yung aking concern po, honorable chairman.

Hon. Tela: Thank you, ma'am. Councilor Gawaran?

Hon. Gawaran: Saglit lang. kay Ms. Tere, tama yung kay Ms. Tere, ang itatanung ko sa ating barangay captain sa kanya mga kasama. Sir, Kap. Alfie, concern lang ang ako. Yung penalty nyo, first, second offense. Third offense. 2,000, 2,500 ba yun? 3,000 ba yun? Ang tanong ko lang po, kasi yun, yung ating ordinans nyo sa barangay. Bilang din tayong lingkod bayan, naglilingkod kayo sa barangay. yung bang presyo nyo sa mga penalty ganyan, Is it human or inhuman doon sa mga penalty, can afford ba ng ating mga kabarangay? Kasi alam ko naman, okay lang yan pag may kaya. Ang mahirap lang natin, pag inimplementan natin yan, naprobahan natin yung ordinance na yan. Baka hindi naman makaya naman po yung ganoon. Tama si Ms. Tere, pwedeng babaan natin pa. Kasi alam ko naman yan eh, ang pera naman yan, mapapasok din sa barangay, walang problema ko yan. Kaya lang, ang inaalala ko lang, yung effect ng





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mga ganyang, yung tinatawag na repercussion, ano yan, ano natin yan, outcry ng ating mga kabarangay. Baka maapektohan naman kayo, at lalo kami, sa dito, kay mayor, at sa city ng Bacoor. Kaya, pag-isipan din nyo rin, mayige, para naman tayo, ang win-win situation dyan dapat, ganyan, 2003 ganoon, at ganyan-gano, ilagay natin doon sa tama lang ganoon. Mag-coordinate na lang kayo, at kay Ms. Tere, at sa aming ganyan, siguro naman po, magaganda naman yung ating pag-uusapan. Yan lang po, gusto kong madinig yung opinion nyo ngayon.

Ms. Calo:

Mr. Chair, meron lang din po akong napansin. Dito po sa Section 7, Penalty for Non-Segregation of Solid Waste, meron po dito ang nakalagay na 1,000. Ito po ay, pagka nagkaroon ng violation, ang head ng isang household, or sa isang subdivision, yung presidente, 1,000 po ang inibigay po sa kanyang violation. Katulad din po ito ng ating city ordinance, na kapag ka nagkaroon ng violation ang kanyang eco-aid, ang papatawan ng parusa o magpe-penalty ay yung head, yung presidente. So, dito po, 1,000. Kung maaari po, babaan din po natin ito, Kap, kasi medyo rin malaki. Dito po, 1,000. Kasi yung dito sa 2,000, 2,500, 3,000, ito ay para sa institutional, commercial, sa ka-agricultural establishment. Napansin ko rin yung sa 1,000. Sana mababaan din po.

Hon. Tela:

Itatanong natin sa legal department kung ano dapat dito. Kasi talaga naman sa mga pinakamatas ay 1,000. Pero yung sinasabing nga nila sa mga commercial, institutional, agricultural, eh meron silang ganito. Applicable ba ito, Atty.?

Atty. Sumira:

Patungkol po dito sa barangay ordinance ng barangay Bayanan. Ang local ordinance, ay dapat ma-comply natin yung mga susunod sa standard requirements. So, yung penalty po patungkol dun sa 2,000, 2,500, 3,000 for owners of institutional, commercial, and agricultural establishment, hindi na po kagad nga na-satisfy yung una. Does not contravene the Constitution or any statute kasi under the LGU nga po, 1,000 po yung maximum. If I may suggest po na ilipat po nila yung ngayon nakalagay po siya ng Prohibition 2, Section 7 na first paragraph, yung for each instance of day or day establishment of violation of this ordinance, ilipat po nila yung dito kay owners of institutional, commercial, and agricultural establishments. Para kung papasok po na every violation, or every time na mahuhuli sila 1,000 ng 1,000, or pwede rin po, just to suggest, pero subject to your consideration pa rin po, i- base nyo po ito dun sa hindi lang po dun sa huli, kungdi dun sa amount or weight yung makukuha. I'm not sure kung ano po provision sa 2014-005 natin, kung hindi ba sila magkakasundo duon kung mag pe per weight po sila

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Yung 2014-005 na sina site nyo po kanina maam, may provision tungkol po dun sa pag penalize ng base on the weight wala pong ganun. Kung walang ganun di rin po pwedeng implement ng barangay

Ms. Calo: Attorney, kasi po, sa ating ordinance na 005-2014, ang pag nahuli yung isang violator, matik po yun. Wala pong warning yun.

Atty. Sumira: Yes, ma'am. Ang ano po anong basis? Per huli? O pwede ba nilang I sirconvent na per timbang? I mean, walang ganong provision. Basta kung walang provision po na ganon, wala po tayong ano...

Ms. Calo: Pag-unsegregated po siya, base po doon sa Section 7 ng barangay. Pag ito ay unsegregated, at nahuli nung enforcer po nila na unsegregated, may violation po sila doon.

Atty. Sumira: So hindi na natin ibabase sa weight sa ano?

Ms. Tere: Hindi po. Kung unsegregated po siya, yun yung basehan po nila.

Atty. Sumira: Kung ganoon po, hindi rin po tayo pwede sa barangay na mag-per weight, Mr. Chair.

Ms. Calo: Opo.

Atty. Sumira: Yun lang po sa part po ng the city legal.

PB Gawaran: Actually, alam naman po natin regarding on this, nung itong aming ginawa na to. Actually, ako din talaga namang nalakihan din ako. Pero ito naman ay proposed lang sana namin. Pero willing po kami talaga na baguhin ito. And then, alam ko po na suntok sa buwan, itong ordinansang ito. Dahil even the CENRO, hindi talaga natin ganoon kadalang kayang pasunurin yung mga tao when it comes sa segregation. Sa totoo lang po. So ito, kaya naman po namin ito talaga gusto ipatupad sa amin. Not only for na magawa namin itong matagal namin ang gusto. Una-una po yung sa facilities namin. Alam naman din po ninyo sa ngayon, yung holding area ay pinapagamit lang din po sa amin talaga. So we're trying our best na maayayos namin yung sa waste segregation namin. And at the same time, nag-iisip din po kami ng mga part naming kung paano yung magiging collection ng basura namin sa mga bahay. Yung per day na itong araw na to, ay ang kukuni lang namin is yung recyclable. And then itong araw na to, yung mga non-recyclable. Yun po yung sagutin ko lang yung inanin nyo kanina. So yun po isa yung plan namin. And then yung implementation, talaga pong tinitingnan pa rin po naming kung sa namin kukunin yung

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pagsisimula para mabigyan namin una knowledge dun sa mga tao. Which is ginagawa naman po natin together with your office po, yung pagbibigay paliwanag sa mga residente natin. Kaya lang, itong now in a days, nagkaroon kami ng kaso, if you remember po yung sa kapitbahay nga po, na even sa office nyo, naitanong ko po kung ano po ba yung pwede namin gawing way para makuha namin yung basura sa loob ng bakuran niya. Which is, nagpunta na kami sa health, ang nangyayari lang, natitikitan lang po natin ang nakititikitan yung person po. So, nagiging problema namin, yung isang yun naging challenge sa amin. Kaya sabi ko, sige siguro, gumawa tayo ng ordinance para kahit papano makita natin kung papano natin sisimulan. Siguro dahil nga po, we'll try lang ito. May pagkakamali din kami dito sa amounting na nilagay. And then, syempre yung implementation, yung pagbibigay education sa mga tao, hindi talaga rin na, ganun kadali. Pero, we will try our best na para masimulan po talaga naming since binigyan din po kami ni Mr. Joey Gawaran ng right dun sa pwesto ng aming holding ngayon. So, makakapagsimulan din po kami, makapag-ayos nung segregation ng aming mga nasabi nga basura. And then, yung concern po rito sa mga amount, may mali. Siguro na over ano lang namin, na-overthinking namin, na-overthink namin yung ina-adapt namin sa city na baka sakaling mas maging responsible tong mga tao pagka ganito na. Kasi isisipin nila pag ganitong presyo lang, okay lang yan, mura lang yan, ganun. Yun yung naging thinking lang din namin, which is, di rin namin siguro totoong na review na tama po yung sinabi ni Honorable Adriel Gawaran na talaga magiging impact din sa barangay and then as well kay Mayor sa, yun naman po, yun naman po yung nakita namin, na enlight naman ako dun sa mga paliwanag ni Ma'am Tere at saka na, and even the legal counsel natin.

Hon. Gawaran: Ah, Kap Alfie saka Ms. Tere, may meron ako konting sigurong ano lang, parang idea. Yung sa, kapag ako nung sa nagbabakasyon sa Amerika, total pag-uusapan natin ng cleanliness ng mga basura. Tama, tatlong segregation, tatlo yun eh, isang nabubulok, isang plastic, isa kayo isa, bali tatlong yun, tatlong bagay yun na ano eh. Eh yun, provided yan ng government o city o kaya sa barangay nyo. Ewan ko, sangkay ko, wala ng pondo, wala dito. Ngayon, para malinis ang ating barangay, merong oras, pag, pick up ng basura, ilalabas yung tatlong galon na segregation na, na basura na nalagyanan. Halimbawa, may oras, may araw, may time. Halimbawa, every Friday, o kaya every sa, kaya ano, twice a week or thrice a week para malinis yung doon eh. Alam ko, malinis eh. Pag sinabing ganoon, may time, alas otso, malinis lahat yung ano, hindi kayo pwede maglagay ng basura sa mga karsada, daanan yun, kasi pangit eh, nagtapo ng basura. Kayo, kayo mong barangay ang

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mag-ano yan, maggagawa ng ordinance resolution yan. Ngayon, pag ganoon, pag hindi oras ng pick up ng basura, wala maglalabas ng tatlong, ano yan, sinasabi kong segregate na basura yon. Ngayon, pag sinabi, may oras, alas otso, may oras ah, dadaan ng basurero yung magpi-pick up, lalabas ngayon ang mga may bahay na may bahay natin doon sa tapat-tapat yon, lalabas yun doon, tatlo, tatlo, dadaan na ng basurero yon. Parang may sirena pa yon, kasi warning, alam nila pag, ano yon, tumulog ang parang bumbero, ibig sabihin yon, andito na yung basurero, ilabas nyo na lahat ng mga bagay na dadamputen. Ngayon, ganoon yun yan. Walang nakablak niya, walang nakaparking, walang kinislato yan, basta, kasi malalaking truck eh. Pag ganoon yan, pag hindi nyo na may parking at hindi nakadaan doon, titikitan yung mga ano-ano. Kaya, disiplinang palagi ang dapat pinairal natin sa barangay. Ganon po yun. Nakita ko yung linis pag kuha ng basura sa ganon, ganong bagay. Kaya, dapat ina-implement rin natin. Kaya ganoon yun yan. May ordinance yun. Na ano rin, kayo magaganoon. May oras, may time, kung kailan dadamputen, may ano. Kaya, ang linis lahat ng ating ganoon sila. Ngayon, pag may nakita ang basura na may time na nilabas na ganoon, penalty.

Hon. Tela:

Thank you, thank you, Coun. Gawaran. Ako naman kasi, sa lahat na ginagawa po natin, Ako po yung naging barangay Captain din, talagang napakahirap po talagang sumunod ang mga tao. Kaya talaga, ginagawa po natin ng city government, kaya meron tayong city ordinance regarding non-segregation. Kaya lang, bilang requirements po talaga sa mga barangay, na meron kayo sariling ordinance, na dapat ipatupad talaga kung medyo matitigas ang ulo nating mga ano, hindi natin, kaya nga sabi, you cannot please everybody. Talagang sakripisyo po at tayong lahat sa barangay. Kaya po, ang inaano natin, para may pangil din ang barangay, kaya po kayo gumagawa ng sariling ordinance, pero nasa batas na yung ating penalty, medyo I lessen din po natin, kahit na naka-prepared po tayo. Kaya yun po ang ating inaano dito sa inyong ordinance, mapababa lang po yung konting penalty na hindi po tayo, anong sinasabi ni attorney, ilagay lang po sa tama, eh, aprobahan po natin to. At the same time, with the support ng CESD, meron din tayo siyempre sa city government regarding sa ganyan. Tama po siyang sabi ni Coun. Adriel, siyempre sa ibang bansa, mga disiplinado ang mga tao. Tayo po eh, kahit po nasa discipline po natin yan, minsan na po politika tayo dahil sa ginagawa natin para sa kalinisan, di ba? Kaya, yun po po, ayusin lang po natin yung ating regarding penalty na sumunod tayo. sa batas at the same, andito na po ang CESD na handa naman sumoporta regarding sa cleanliness and desegregation ng waste materials po natin.





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Ms. Tere:

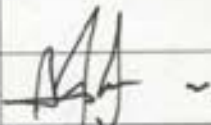
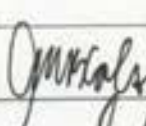
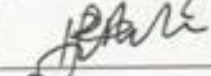

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE SEGREGATION AT SOURCE OF ALL INSTITUTIONAL, HOUSEHOLD, AGRICULTURAL, AND COMMERCIAL WASTE INTO WET OR BIODEGRADABLE AND DRY OR NON-BIODEGRADABLE WASTE, REQUIRING THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the fundamental law of the Constitution of the Philippines provide specifically Article II on the declaration of the principles and state policies section 16, that, the state shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balance and a healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of RA 9003 further provides that "LGUS shall evaluate alternative roles for the public and private sectors in providing collection services, type of collection system, or combination of systems, that best meet their needs: Provided, that segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources.

WHEREAS, the growing population of the Barangay Bayanan is now producing more solid waste than ever before necessitating the immediate and mandatory segregation of all household, commercial and agricultural waste from its source so as to promote public health and the general welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, Upon motion of Barangay Councilor SERAPIO S. ADVINCULA, unaimously approved by all the barangay councilors present, **BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Barangay in regular session assembled that:

Section 1. Title.-This Ordinance shall also be known as the "2025 Garbage Segregation Ordinance of the Barangay Bayanan".

Section 2. Mandatory Segregation of Solid Wastes and Proper Disposal and Collection of Garbage. - Barangay Bayanan hereby requires the mandatory segregation at the source of all institutional, household, commercial and agricultural wastes into wet or biodegradable garbage and dry or nonbiodegradable garbage as well as the proper disposal and collection of the same.

Section 3. Definition of Terms.- The following terms, as used in this Ordinance, shall mean:

a) Agricultural waste shall refer to waste generated from planting or harvesting of crops, trimming or pruning of plants and wastes or run-off materials from farms or fields:

b) Biodegradable waste or wet waste shall refer to post consumer materials that would undergo decomposition and/or can be transformed into some other form of raw material with beneficial use such as soil fertilizers;

(c) Collection shall refer to the act of removing solid waste from the source or from a communal storage point:

(d) Commercial wastes shall refer to solid waste, whether wet or dry, generated by commercial establishments such as restaurants, stores, malls, and public/private markets:

(e) Domestic or household waste refers to solid waste, whether wet or dry, emanating from private residences:

(f) Institutional waste refers to solid waste, whether wet or dry, emanating from an educational, medical, or religious institution;

(g) Non-biodegradable or dry waste refers to post-consumer materials that do not decompose or those that do not transform into some other form of raw materials that is beneficial to the environment.

(h) Segregation shall refer to a solid waste management practice of separating different materials found in solid waste in order to promote recycling and re-use of resources and to reduce the volume of waste for collection and disposal;

(i) Segregation at source shall refer to a solid waste management practice of separating, at the point of origin, different materials found in solid waste in order to promote recycling and re-use of resources and to reduce the volume of waste for collection and disposal;

(j) Solid waste shall refer to all discarded household, commercial waste, non-hazardous institutional and industrial waste, street sweepings, construction debris, agricultural waste, and other non-hazardous/non-toxic solid waste.

Section 4. Segregation at source.-- All household, institutional, and agricultural waste shall be put in separate receptacles or containers properly marked as either "wet" for biodegradable waste or "dry" for non-biodegradable waste. Such receptacles or containers shall be sealed and protected from animals and insects.

Section 5. Garbage Collection and Disposal. Garbage intended for collection and disposal by city garbage trucks or by barangay eco-workers shall follow the following conditions.

a. There shall be a scheduled collection of trash and no person shall bring such trash outside his establishment or residence on the day that has no schedule of the collection.

b. Wastes must be separated into non-biodegradable and biodegradable. Non-biodegradable such as papers, plastics, bottles, scraps and biodegradable such as leftover foods and other decomposing and degradable matters shall be placed inside sealed receptacles or containers. These bags or containers shall be brought out in front of the gates of the residential houses and business establishments thirty (30) minutes before the collection schedule. Households in areas that cannot be reached by garbage collectors should deposit their wastes along the main streets accessible to barangay garbage trucks not earlier than thirty (30) minutes before the collection schedule.

c. Trees, shrubs and grass cuttings should not be mixed with the above-cited wastes. They should be placed inside a separate plastic bag or sack and should follow the disposal process as stated above.

d. All collectors and other personnel directly dealing with collection of solid waste shall be equipped with personal protective equipment to protect them from the hazards of handling solid waste.

e. Garbage collectors or ecoworkers shall be issued identification cards and uniforms by the barangay; and

f. Collection of solid waste shall be done in a manner that prevents damage to the container and spillage or scattering of solid waste within the collection vicinity.

Section 6. Power of Garbage Collectors, To Inspect Waste, to Refuse Collection, and to Issue Ordinance Violation Tickets.-- Garbage collectors, sanitary who have undergone the necessary training in relation to the implementation of this Ordinance, shall be empowered (a) to inspect all waste containers or receptacles to determine if its contents have been properly segregated, (b) to refuse to collect unsegregated waste, and (c) to issue Ordinance Violation Tickets to any person or establishment who violates this Ordinance.

Section 7. Penalty for Non-Segregation of Solid Wastes. - Unsegregated solid wastes generated by household, institutional, commercial and agricultural sources shall not be collected. For failing to cause the segregation of their solid wastes, the head of every household and the managers or supervisors of institutional, commercial and agricultural establishments with unsegregated solid waste shall also be personally fined **Three Hundred Pesos (PhP 300.00)** for each instance that they, or their establishment, have violated this Ordinance.

In addition, the owners of institutional, commercial, or agricultural establishments that violate this Ordinance shall be penalized as public nuisance and shall be fined as follows:

First offense	Fine of ₱ 500.00
Second offense	Fine of ₱ 700.00
Third offense	Fine of ₱ 1,000.00

Section 8. Dumping and Throwing of Wastes; Penalty. Dumping or throwing or placing of waste in areas not designated by the Barangay Solid Waste Management Committee for such purpose is strictly prohibited. Persons who shall violate this provision shall be fined **Three Hundred Pesos (PhP 300.00)**.

Section 9. Composting. - Composting of agricultural wastes and other compostable materials including but not limited to garden wastes, shall be encouraged.

Section 10. Separability Clause. - If, for any reason or reasons, any part of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 11. Repealing Clause. - All Ordinances, resolutions, Circulars, Memorandums or Rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision of this Code are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.

Section 12. Implementing Rules. - The Barangay Chairperson is hereby empowered to direct the formulation of the implementing rules and guidelines of this Ordinance. Provided: that the said rules and guidelines should not be contrary to the provisions hereof.

Section 13. Effectivity Clause. - This Code shall take effect immediately upon its posting in at least 14 conspicuous places within the barangay.

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE SEGREGATION AT SOURCE OF ALL INSTITUTIONAL, HOUSEHOLD, AGRICULTURAL, AND COMMERCIAL WASTE INTO WET OR BIODEGRADABLE AND DRY OR NON-BIODEGRADABLE WASTE, REQUIRING THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the fundamental law of the Constitution of the Philippines provide specifically Article II on the declaration of the principles and state policies section 15, that, the state shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balance and a healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of RA 9003 further provides that "LGUS shall evaluate alternative roles for the public and private sectors in providing collection services, type of collection system, or combination of systems, that best meet their needs: Provided, that segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources.

WHEREAS, the growing population of the Barangay Bayanan is now producing more solid waste than ever before necessitating the immediate and mandatory segregation of all household, commercial and agricultural waste from its source so as to promote public health and the general welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, Upon motion of Barangay Councilor SERAPIO S. ADVINCULA, unanimously approved by all the barangay councilors present, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Barangay in regular session assembled that:

Section 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall also be known as the "2025 Garbage Segregation Ordinance of the Barangay Bayanan".

Section 2. Mandatory Segregation of Solid Wastes and Proper Disposal and Collection of Garbage. - Barangay Bayanan hereby requires the mandatory segregation at the source of all institutional, household, commercial and agricultural wastes into wet or biodegradable garbage and dry or nonbiodegradable garbage as well as the proper disposal and collection of the same.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. - The following terms, as used in this Ordinance, shall mean:

- Agricultural waste shall refer to waste generated from planting or harvesting of crops, trimming or pruning of plants and wastes or run-off materials from farms or fields;
- Biodegradable waste or wet waste shall refer to post consumer materials that would undergo decomposition and/or can be transformed into some other form of raw material with beneficial use such as soil fertilizers;
- Collection shall refer to the act of removing solid waste from the source or from a communal storage point;
- Commercial wastes shall refer to solid waste, whether wet or dry, generated by commercial establishments such as restaurants, stores, malls, and public/private markets;
- Domestic or household waste refers to solid waste, whether wet or dry, emanating from private residences.

(f) Institutional waste refers to solid waste, whether wet or dry, emanating from an educational, medical, or religious institution;

(g) Non-biodegradable or dry waste refers to post-consumer materials that do not decompose or those that do not transform into some other form of raw materials that is beneficial to the environment;

(h) Segregation shall refer to a solid waste management practice of separating different materials found in solid waste in order to promote recycling and re-use of resources and to reduce the volume of waste for collection and disposal;

(i) Segregation at source shall refer to a solid waste management practice of separating, at the point of origin, different materials found in solid waste in order to promote recycling and re-use of resources and to reduce the volume of waste for collection and disposal;

(j) Solid waste shall refer to all discarded household, commercial waste, non-hazardous institutional and industrial waste, street sweepings, construction debris, agricultural waste, and other non-hazardous/non-toxic solid waste.

Section 4. Segregation at source.— All household, institutional, and agricultural waste shall be put in separate receptacles or containers properly marked as either "wet" for biodegradable waste or "dry" for non-biodegradable waste. Such receptacles or containers shall be sealed and protected from animals and insects.

Section 5. Garbage Collection and Disposal. Garbage intended for collection and disposal by city garbage trucks or by barangay eco-workers shall follow the following conditions:

- There shall be a scheduled collection of trash and no person shall bring such trash outside his establishment or residence on the day that has no schedule of the collection.
- Wastes must be separated into non-biodegradable and biodegradable. Non-biodegradable such as papers, plastics, bottles, scrap and biodegradable such as leftover foods and other decomposing and degradable matters shall be placed inside sealed receptacles or containers. These bags or containers shall be brought out in front of the gates of the residential houses and business establishments thirty (30) minutes before the collection schedule. Households in areas that cannot be reached by garbage collectors should deposit their wastes along the main streets accessible to barangay garbage trucks not earlier than thirty (30) minutes before the collection schedule.
- Trees, shrubs and grass cuttings should not be mixed with the above-cited wastes. They should be placed inside a separate plastic bag or sack and should follow the disposal process as stated above.
- All collectors and other personnel directly dealing with collection of solid waste shall be equipped with personal protective equipment to protect them from the hazards of handling solid waste.
- Garbage collectors or ecoworkers shall be issued identification cards and uniforms by the barangay; and
- Collection of solid waste shall be done in a manner that prevents damage to the container and spillage or scattering of solid waste within the collection vicinity.

Section 6. Power of Garbage Collectors, To Inspect Waste, to Refuse Collection, and to Issue Ordinance Violation Tickets.— Garbage collectors, sanitary who have undergone the necessary training in relation to the implementation of this Ordinance, shall be empowered (a) to inspect all waste containers or receptacles to determine if it contents have been properly segregated, (b) to refuse to collect unsegregated waste, and (c) to issue Ordinance Violation Tickets to any person or establishment who violates this Ordinance.

Section 7. Penalty for Non-Segregation of Solid Wastes. - Unsegregated solid wastes generated by household, institutional, commercial and agricultural sources shall not be collected. For failing to cause the segregation of their solid wastes, the head of every household and the managers or supervisors of institutional, commercial and agricultural establishments with unsegregated solid waste shall also be personally fined One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) for each instance that they, or their establishment, have violated this Ordinance.

In addition, the owners of institutional, commercial, or agricultural establishments that violate this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

First offense	Fine of ₱ 2,000.00
Second offense	Fine of ₱ 2,500.00
Third offense	Fine of ₱ 3,000.00

Section 8. Dumping and Throwing of Wastes; Penalty. Dumping or throwing or placing of waste in areas not designated by the Barangay Solid Waste Management Committee for such purpose is strictly prohibited. Persons who shall violate this provision shall be fined One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00).

Section 9. Composting. - Composting of agricultural wastes and other compostable materials including but not limited to garden wastes, shall be encouraged.

Section 10. Separability Clause. - If, for any reason or reasons, any part of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 11. Repealing Clause. - All Ordinances, resolutions, Circulars, Memorandums or Rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision of this Code are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.

Section 12. Implementing Rules. - The Barangay Chairperson is hereby empowered to direct the formulation of the implementing rules and guidelines of this Ordinance. Provided: that the said rules and guidelines should not be contrary to the provisions hereof.

Section 13. Effectivity Clause. - This Code shall take effect immediately upon its posting in at least 14 conspicuous places within the barangay.
