Subject: *An ordinance mandating the installation of transparency and accountability markers in all buildings, monuments, edifices, and thoroughfares in the City of Bacoor, Cavite that were constructed with the use of public funds and providing administrative penalties for violations hereof.*

*(Date referred: February 02, 2026)*

The above-mentioned proposed ordinance underwent its first reading on February 02, 2026 during the 28<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the 6<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed ordinance was referred by the Presiding Officer, City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances.

The Committee on Rules, Privileges, Laws and Ordinances sent out invitations to the resource persons and conducted a committee hearing on February 26, 2026 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

After due consultation and deliberation hereby report back to this August Body the findings, information gathered, and recommendation on the above-subject matter. Attached hereto are the attendance sheet and photos taken during the said hearing.

**FINDINGS:**

A letter from the Office of the City Mayor dated January 29, 2026 was received by the Sangguniang Panlungsod requesting the latter to enact an



ordinance mandating the installation of transparency and accountability markers in all building, monuments, edifices, and thoroughfares in the City of Bacoor, Cavite that were constructed with the use of public funds, and providing administrative penalties for violations.

This ordinance is proposed in line with the principles of transparency and accountability in the utilization of public funds. The installation of transparency and accountability markers will allow the public to be properly informed of project details, funding sources, implementing offices, and timeliness, thereby reinforcing trust in local governance and ensuring that public infrastructure projects remain open to public scrutiny.

The installation of permanent markers on all buildings, edifices, monuments and various thoroughfares constructed with the use of public funds within the City of Bacoor, Cavite shall serve as an indelible commitment on the part of the City Government to uphold the principles of transparency and accountability.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

After a thorough review of all the circumstances and statements from the resource persons, and the provisions of the proposed ordinance, the Committee respectfully recommends that the Sangguniang Panlungsod **approve** the above subject matter on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading during its next regular session.
