Subject: *AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM (SLP) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE. (PCO 2026-087 dated March 16, 2026)*

This committee report pertains to the committee hearing conducted on March 19, 2026 relative to the above-stated subject matter. The hearing was presided over by the Chairperson of the Committee on Social Services, Hon. Horacio M. Brillantes Jr. and was held at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall situated on the 6th Floor of the BLDR Building, Bacoor Government Center, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite. The minutes, attendance sheets, and pictures taken during the said hearing are attached hereto and shall be made integral parts of this report.

FINDINGS:

After careful evaluation of the documents and deliberation during the Committee’s review, the following findings are hereby presented:

- The Sustainable Livelihood Program has been continuously implemented in the City of Bacoor since 2015 and has benefited thousands of constituents.
- The program contributes to poverty alleviation through capital assistance and capacity-building initiatives.
- The pandemic significantly affected earlier beneficiaries; however, post-pandemic implementation shows improved outcomes.

- There is a need to further strengthen monitoring, evaluation, and documentation of success rates among beneficiaries.
- Institutionalizing the program through an ordinance will ensure continuity, funding allocation, and sustainability.
- The inclusion of a monitoring mechanism is necessary to safeguard public funds and ensure program effectiveness.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Honorable Members of the Joint Committee hereby recommends the **APPROVAL** of PCO 2026-087, An Ordinance Adopting and Institutionalizing the Implementation of the Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP) of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) in the City of Bacoor, Cavite, subject to the following amendments:

1. Inclusion of a provision creating a Monitoring Team to oversee the implementation and performance of the program;
2. Incorporation of updated policy references, including DSWD Memorandum Circular No. 03, Series of 2025;
3. Submission and regular updating of beneficiary records and program performance reports to the Sangguniang Panlungsod;
4. Strengthening of mechanisms for transparency, evaluation, and impact assessment.


