Subject: **ENDORSEMENT OF BACOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY, INC. RESOLUTIONS RECOMMENDING THE REVIEW OF CITY ORDINANCES: STRENGTHENING OF LOCAL MOTORCYCLE-RELATED ORDINANCES TO IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY, PROPER PARKING, DRIVER DISCIPLINE AND LAWFUL OPERATIONS. - PCO 2026-105** dated May 4, 2026

Referred to the Joint Committee on the 41st Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

In giving due course, the subject matter requires legislative action to amend the existing CITY ORDINANCE NOS. 2013-2, 2013-047, 11-2019, and the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) in relation therefrom, all of which are entitled "**REVISED TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOR**".

At the onset, the Traffic Code of Bacoor City is now the subject of review and revision under Proposed City Ordinance (PCO) No. 2026 -083 which is still pending with the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City Government of Bacoor.

INFORMATION:

The above-subject matter emanates from the endorsement of the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc. pertaining to Resolution No. 6 adopted by the said Chamber during its Bacoor Business Summit held on April 22, 2026, and presented as follows, we copy:

RESOLUTION NO. 2
On Improved Traffic Management to Support Business Growth

WHEREAS, traffic congestion and poor traffic flow negatively affect customer access, delivery schedules, workforce mobility, and investment attractiveness;

WHEREAS, efficient mobility is essential to economic growth and commercial competitiveness;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, to recommend enhanced traffic management strategies, synchronized road planning, loading/unloading zones, parking discipline, and coordinated enforcement in key business districts of Bacoor.

ADOPTED THIS 22nd DAY OF APRIL 2026
During the Bacoor Business Summit, held at Strike Gymnasium

SUMMARY OF ISSUES AND THE RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Bacoor Chamber of Commerce expressed their concerns on traffic congestion issues that affect the daily business operations, economic growth and commercial competitiveness in Bacoor City, with emphasis on busy business areas, as follows:

- customer access on business
- delivery delays
- workforce mobility
- investment attractiveness

Hence, suggested/recommended the following measures:

- Synchronized road planning and time-based lane allocations during peak business hours.
- Strictly enforce the designated loading/unloading zones on high-traffic business areas.

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- Strictly enforce discipline on business parking permits and anti-obstruction measures on high-traffic business areas.
- Strengthen the coordinated enforcement by providing traffic personnel with body cams and to utilize a real-time violation database.
- Restore the 4,500 kg gross vehicle weight limit to accommodate delivery trucks while ensuring road safety.

FINDINGS/ACTION TAKEN:

The Joint Committee during its hearing held on May 22, 2026, requires the following:

1. The Joint Committee advised the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce to prepare a formal petition/request citing the specific provision that requires enhancement and/or amendment, and to coordinate the same with the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) for study and appropriate action, incorporation in the "Revised Traffic Code of Bacoor City", and proper endorsement prior to any legislative action by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.
2. The Joint Committee instructed the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) to study and prioritize the concerns of the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce in relation to the issues on motorcycle rider discipline, enhanced traffic management strategies, synchronized road planning, loading/unloading zones, parking discipline, and coordinated enforcement in key business districts of Bacoor.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Honorable Members of the Joint Committee hereby recommend **TO TEMPORARY ARCHIVE** the legislative measure pertaining to the issues/concerns raised by the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce in relation to the amendment of CITY ORDINANCE NOS. 2013-2, 2013-047, 11-2019, and the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) in relation therefrom, all of which are entitled "**REVISED TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOR**", due to the following reasons:

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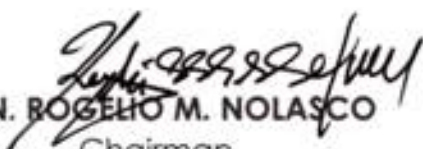


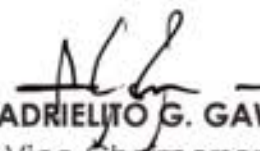
1. Lack of a formal petition as the basis of action from the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc., citing therein the proposed remedies on specific provisions of the "Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor" in which the Chamber sought to be reviewed and amended, and to be subjected further to a thorough study by the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) and recommendation, prior to any legislative action.
2. The amendment based on the concerns of the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc. will take longer time as the same is subject to review, study, consideration, possible inclusion with the ongoing revision of the "Traffic Code", and endorsement by the Executive Department.

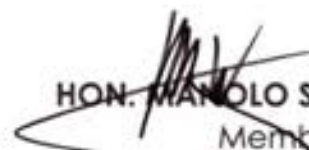
