Referred to the Joint Committee on the 48th Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod is the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

INFORMATION:

The City Mayor endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the letter request of **Mr. Roderick O. Arciaga**, President of the Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (TODA) District 2, **requesting the implementation of the applicable tricycle fare rates under the existing fare matrix provided in the City Ordinance** in view of the increase in fuel prices and the continuing inflation affecting the prices of basic commodities.

The request is anchored on the existing City Ordinance governing tricycle fare rates, wherein the corresponding tricycle fares are determined based on the prevailing gasoline price brackets provided in the existing fare matrix. According to the requesting party, the continuous increase in fuel prices and the rising prices of basic commodities have significantly affected the income and daily operations of tricycle operators and drivers, thereby prompting the request for the implementation of the applicable fare bracket under the ordinance.

FINDINGS:

During the deliberations, the Joint Committee noted that the representatives of the TODA Federation clarified that **they were not requesting the enactment of a new**

ordinance nor the approval of new fare rates, but merely the implementation of the existing fare matrix already established under the current City Ordinance.

The representatives of the TODA Federation explained that they voluntarily deferred the implementation of the authorized fare adjustment upon the request of the City Government during the period of increased fuel prices. They likewise manifested that **the continuous increase in fuel prices, inflation, the rising costs of vehicle maintenance, spare parts, and other operating expenses, including their daily boundary obligations, have substantially affected the livelihood of tricycle operators and drivers.**

The Joint Committee likewise noted that representatives of the TODA Federation acknowledged the financial assistance previously extended by the National Government and the Provincial Government. However, they emphasized that such assistance only provided temporary relief and was insufficient to offset the continuing increase in operational expenses brought about by the rising prices of fuel and other basic commodities.

The Office of the City Legal Service (OCLS) informed the Committee that the existing City Ordinance already provides a fare matrix corresponding to the prevailing gasoline price brackets and that **the applicable fare bracket may already have become applicable under the prevailing fuel prices, subject to verification by the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD).**

The Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) likewise explained the operation of the existing fare matrix and confirmed that the corresponding fares are determined based on prevailing gasoline prices. Based on the information presented during the hearing, the prevailing gasoline prices were reported to be approximately ₱72.00 to ₱74.00 per liter at Petron and around ₱68.00 per liter at Green Euro Petro Gas Station, **subject to verification by the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) in determining the applicable fare bracket under the existing ordinance.**

The Committee likewise noted the concerns raised regarding the increasing competition posed by motorcycle ride-hailing services, particularly Angkas and Move It, which provide point-to-point transportation directly from a passenger's residence to the intended destination, **thereby affecting the passenger volume and income of tricycle operators**, especially those operating within subdivisions and residential communities.

The Committee further discussed the implementation of the regular fare, special trip fare, first kilometer, and succeeding kilometer rates under the existing fare matrix, and likewise emphasized that **the statutory fare discounts granted to senior citizens, persons with disabilities (PWDs), and students shall continue to be observed in accordance with existing laws and regulations.**

During the deliberations, Hon. Rogelio M. Nolasco clarified that **Section 4 of City Ordinance No. 256-2023** already provides the applicable tricycle fare matrix based on the prevailing gasoline price brackets. He further explained that the request does not seek the approval of a new fare increase but merely the implementation of the applicable fare rates already provided known as the **"2023 Tricycle Fare Adjustment Ordinance of Bacoor,"** and does not amend or establish a new fare schedule under the existing ordinance through a Resolution of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

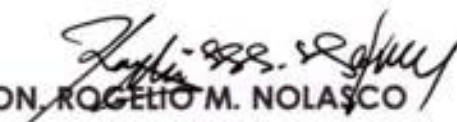
RECOMMENDATION:

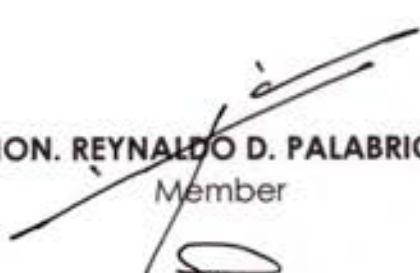

- The Chairman asked the representation from TODA to elaborate their letter.

Secretary of TODA was the one explained the letter.

- A request to implement the City Ordinance no. 256 – 2023 regarding the approved Fare Matrix.
- It was stated that in the event of gasoline increase, the approved Fare Matrix may be implemented.
- With the request of the City Mayor to stay the fare hike, the said Fare Matrix was not yet implemented.
- Stated various fuel prices that corresponds minimum fare was suppose to be implemented. And with the present fuel prices, minimum fare remains the same.
- Informed the body that the neighboring city of Imus has implemented their fare increase.
- Emphasized that basic commodities specifically the prices of rice has already increased and the prevailing fare is not anymore commensurate with high prices.
- Also stated that before the passing of the ordinance before, representation from the riding public were present and agreed with the ordinance.
- Lauded the leadership of the BTMD for always implementing the display of tariff fares in every tricycles.

BTMD

- Agrees that there is a corresponding fare to every price of fuel. What was not mentioned was the special trip.
- Agrees also that the mayor requested for the holding first the price hike.
- Stated that an amount of 5,000.00php was extended already for the tricycle drivers to defray expenses brought by the price increase in fuels.
- Also announced that an upcoming support from the provincial government is on its way. We are just waiting for the schedule for the City of Bacoor.
- Encouraged that they might want to wait for the situation to normalize. Passengers will also be affected with the fare increase and might resort to alternative mode of transportation instead of continuing their services. Like the "ANKAS" has not increased their fare. And it is seen that the fuel price trending is in the downward slope.
- Reminded that even in principle that it has been approved, the new fare matrix must first come out before implementing the fare increase. Stressed that this will still pass through the process. No fare increas to be done until final fare matrix.

ADMIN

- It noted that the said ordinance created in 2023 is in tune to the current prices of fuel during this crisis.
- Noted that the current crisis started barely three months ago and shared that as per the DOE secretary that the effects of the war will be felt upto December.

LEGAL

- Clarifies regarding the request fare price being brought up. And it was answered that they are only requesting the implementation of what is indicated in the ordinance

HON. PALABRICA

- Sees that indeed that there is no increase being requested and only wanted to implement the ordinance.
- Entered into the discussion regarding this crisis situation which was triggered by the war in the middle east. Inquired for the duration of the crisis.
- Computed the help of the "ayuda" given to the drivers on how it affected their spendings on fuel in the last three months. It showed that the help extended by the government through the "ayuda" only covered one month in the last three months. Meaning for the last two months, their spendings in their daily lives is already affected. And this is the reason why they are asking for the implementation of the said ordinance.
- Emphasized that this is the real situation that affects the lives of the tricycle drivers and it was also said that this will be felt upto December. Sees that there is basis for the request. But also taking into consideration of the riding public's welfare.
- Asked the secretary of the TODA if the ordinance will be implemented, will it suffice to their needs and at the same time protect the welfare of their passengers. Answered that it will be of big help and at the same time will be fair with passengers with regards to special trips.
- Also has put in record that the neighboring city of Imus is now implementing its rate at 15 pesos compared to the ordinance of the city of Bacoor at 14 pesos being requested.
- Asked that aside from special trips of 35 pesos and the 3 passengers of 14 pesos each, is the discount for senior citizens and students being followed. The President answered that it is specified in the ordinance that the prevelige of the senior citizens, PWD's and students is strictly to be followed.
- Expressed his personal position on the matter to implement the ordinance.

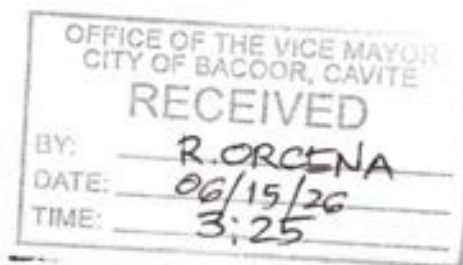

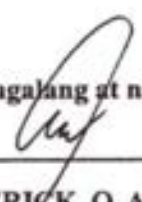

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE APPLICABLE TRICYCLE FARE RATE STATED IN SECTION 4 OF THE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 256-2023 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "2023 TRICYCLE FARE ADJUSTMENT ORDINANCE OF BACOR".

WHEREAS, on 11 June 2026, the Office of the City Mayor sent an endorsement letter to the Sangguniang Panlungsod pertaining to the request of Mr. Roderick O. Arciaga, Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (TODA) District 2 President, with regard to his proposal of increase of tricycle fare rate in response to the rising cost of fuel and continuing inflation affecting the prices of basic commodities.

WHEREAS, on 22 June 22, 2026, the aforementioned matter was referred to the Committee on Public Transportation and Traffic Management as lead committee and to the Committee on Finance and Budget Appropriations as sub-committee.

WHEREAS, on 16 January 2023, the Sangguniang Panlungsod enacted a City Ordinance No. 256-2023 entitled: *"An Ordinance Approving the Fare Matrices of Various Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODAs) in the City of Bacoor, Cavite in Compliance with City Ordinance No. CO 11-2019 (Also Known As The "Bacoor Traffic Code") and Providing Penalties for Violations Hereof"*, or the *"2023 Tricycle Fare Adjustment Ordinance of Bacoor "*.

WHEREAS, in Section 4 of the said ordinance specifically stated the tricycle fare rate based on the prevailing price of the gasoline, to wit:

P 81.00 – 90.00	P 16.00	P 13.00	P 40.00	P 32.00

Moreover, in special instances, the following are the additional fares, to wit:

- a) additional P2.00 for every succeeding kilometer on REGULAR TRIP;
- b) additional P5.00 for every succeeding kilometer on SPECIAL TRIP;
- c) 20% Discount on SENIOR CITIZENS, PWDs and STUDENTS; and
- d) additional of P 5.00 for trips occurring between 10:00 PM to 4:00 AM.

WHEREAS, the joint committees found out that the request merely seeks the implementation of the applicable fare rates and they decided to recommend the approval of the same.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Rogelio M. Nolasco unanimously seconded by the members of City Council, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the 6th

Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite in regular session assembled to implement the applicable tricycle fare rate pursuant to Section 4 of the City Ordinance No. 256-2023 or the **"2023 Tricycle Fare Adjustment Ordinance of Bacoor "**.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Bacoor Traffic Management Department , the Office of the City Mayor, Mr. Arciaga, President of TODA -District 2 and other government offices concerned with copies of this Resolution.
