SUBJECT: PCR 332A-2025- A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) REGION IV-A REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SOCIAL PENSION PROGRAM FOR INDIGENT SENIOR CITIZENS. Referred (PCR 332A-2025) dated December 15, 2025)

FINDINGS:

The main government agency tasked with creating, managing, and implementing comprehensive social welfare protection programs as well as poverty-reduction strategies is Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD). These programs and services are implemented in collaboration with or through Local Government Units (LGUs), People's Organizations (POs), Government Organizations (GOs), and other members of civic society in order to improve living conditions and empower the poor, vulnerable and disadvantaged children, youth, women, older people, people with disabilities, families, people in crisis, and communities in need of aid;

In accordance with Chapter II, Section 17(b)(2)(IV) of the Philippine Local Government Code (Republic Act no. 7160), the Municipality/City is required to provide Social Welfare Services in the form of livelihood and other pro-poor projects, nutrition services, family planning services, and community-based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile offenders, and victims of drug abuse;

A monthly stipend of at least one thousand pesos (Php1000.00) is granted to indigent senior citizens under section 2 (h) (1) of Republic Act (R.A.) no. 11916, also known as "An Act increasing the Social Pension of Indigent Senior Citizens and Appropriating Funds therefor, amending for the Purpose Republic Act No. 7432," to help with their daily subsistence and other medical needs.

The Sixty-Three Million Eight Hundred Fifty-Two thousand pesos (PHP 63,852,000.00) appropriated by the General Appropriations Act for the Fiscal Year 2026 (GAA FY 2026); will be used for the monthly stipend of one thousand pesos (PHP1,000.00) for the senior citizen beneficiaries who have been identified by the DSWD.
