Subject: *A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE AND THE ARTS REGARDING THE PROPOSED "BACOR MARCHING ARTS WORKSHOP". (PCR 366-2026, dated 11 February 2026)*

The above-captioned proposed resolution was referred to the Committee on Tourism, Culture, Arts, and External Linkages, chaired by Hon. Ricardo F. Ugalde during the 29<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the 6<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod held on 11 February 2026.

The Bacoor Marching Arts Workshop aims to advance and enrich the City's cultural and artistic programs by providing structured training and development opportunities in marching arts. Through this initiative, the City Government of Bacoor seeks to foster creativity, discipline, and community engagement among participants, while strengthening Bacoor's identity as a hub for music and performance excellence.

Under the proposed agreement, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) shall provide financial assistance to the City Government of Bacoor in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php250, 000.00) to support the implementation of the workshop. The said financial assistance shall cover essential program needs necessary for the successful conduct of activities promoting cultural education, artistic expression, and youth empowerment.

**FINDINGS:**

After due consideration, the Committee finds that:

- The proposed project has been evaluated and approved by the Board of Commissioners of the NCCA under Board Resolution No. 2026-069 dated 27 November 2025.
- The NCCA has recognized the project as contributory to the development and promotion of Philippine culture and the arts and has deemed it fit and proper for support under its program "Filipino Creativity and Innovativeness Harnessed."
- The financial assistance in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php250,000.00) is chargeable to the appropriate program funds of the NCCA and shall be utilized in accordance with applicable laws, accounting, auditing, and government regulations.
