Subject: *PCR 367-2026 - A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR WITH INFORMATICS PHILIPPINES THROUGH THE INFORMATICS COLLEGE CAVITE REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CAPACITY BUILDING AND DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION INITIATIVES FOR TEACHERS, CIVIL SERVANTS AND CONSTITUENTS OF BACOOR CITY. (dated 11 February 2026)*

The aforementioned proposed city resolution was endorsed by the Office of the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod on February 03, 2026. The draft of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was subsequently attached and made an integral part of this report, along with the minutes of the hearing, attendance sheets, and photos taken during the February 26, 2026 hearing.

FINDINGS :

- Informatics Philippines, an independently owned and operated local educational institution helping Filipinos acquire I.T. knowledge and skills that are vital for their personal and professional growth proposes to implement free short training bootcamps for beginners, designed to help teachers, civil servants, and constituents of the City of Bacoor develop foundational digital skills and build confidence in the use of technology.
- The City Government of Bacoor, with its mandate to continuously provide public services such as digital educational trainings and programs to its constituents recognize the need to establish a partnership to promote training opportunities that provides capacity-building, digital awareness, and lifelong learning.
- The collaboration between the City Government of Bacoor and Informatics Philippines would brought Teachers, Civil Servants, and qualified constituents closer to equitable access to digital education and skills development. This also bridges youth to employment.
- It was revealed that the mentioned partnership includes free training AI Bootcamps, an initiative necessary to advanced technological knowledge of civil servants in providing better public services.





RECOMMENDATION :

Following careful analysis and deliberation, the Committee Chairperson, Hon. Adrielito G. Gawaran recommends the **approval** of the abovesaid proposed city resolution regarding the implementation of capacity building and digital transformation initiatives for teachers, civil servants and constituents of the City of Bacoor.
