Subject: VERIFIED COMPLAINT OF MS. JANET SALDO AGAINST BARANGAY TANOD ALEX POLANCOS OF BARANGAY QUEEN'S ROW EAST, BACOOR CITY, CAVITE IN RELATION TO A PHYSICAL ALTERCATION BETWEEN THE SAID RESPONDENT AND THE COMPLAINANT'S SON, MR. RJ ALONZO . (PCR 384-2026 dated 23 February 2026).

The said complaint was referred to this Committee by the Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola, during the 31st Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod on February 23, 2026 for appropriate action.

During the Committee Hearing held on 26 February 2026 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the parties were present and placed under oath. Ms. Janet Saldo narrated that an alleged physical altercation occurred on 01 January 2026 at around 3:00 A.M. involving her son, Mr. RJ Alonzo, and Barangay Tanod Alex Polancos of Barangay Queens Row East.

It was disclosed during the proceedings that:

1. The incident was previously brought before the Barangay for conciliation but no amicable settlement was reached;
2. The matter has reportedly been elevated before the Office of the City Prosecutor for appropriate legal action; and
3. Mr. RJ Alonzo, the alleged injured party, is already twenty (20) years and should be the proper complainant and not his mother.

FINDINGS

After due deliberation, the Committee finds that:

1. Under the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has disciplinary authority over elective barangay officials.
2. A Barangay Tanod is an appointive barangay personnel, not an elective official.
3. The disciplinary authority over appointive barangay personnel does not fall within the jurisdiction of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.
4. The alleged acts complained of are already subject to proper legal remedies before the appropriate prosecutorial authorities.
