SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND FOOD TERMINAL INCORPORATED REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PHP20 RICE PROJECT THROUGH KADIWA CENTERS TO BE ESTABLISHED IN THE CITY OF BACOOR. (PCR-386-2026 dated February 26, 2026)

The above-mentioned resolution underwent its first reading on February 26, 2026 during the 7th Special Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said resolution was referred by the Presiding Officer, Hon. City Vice Mayor Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Agriculture and Food

FINDINGS:

The Food and Terminal Incorporated (FTI) is a government-owned and controlled corporation tasked with running and maintaining a general market for producers, manufacturers, and farmers. This market includes, but is not limited to, the wholesale buying, selling, trading, and dealing of a wide range of goods such as groceries, provisions, foodstuffs, wares, vegetables, fruits, cereals, grains, and other agricultural products. It also covers all other items related to the operation of a general market, including meat, poultry, fish bakery products, and other similar mercantile items.

As directed by the Department of Agriculture's (DA) instruction letter dated April 24, 2025, the DA has envolved the FTI in executing the PHP20 Rice Project. This initiative is a part of the Rice-for-All (RFA) program and seeks to further ease the financial strain of rice purchases for consumers.

Under the PHP20 Rice Project, the National Food Authority (NFA) or other approved suppliers will provide rice to the FTI. Subsequently, the FTI will sell this rice at a reduced price of Php20.00 per kilogram through KADIWA Centers and participating local government units (LGUs).
