Subject: *A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN AND ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY REGION IV-A AND THE BACOOR LIVELIHOOD PRODUCERS' COOPERATIVE PERTAINING TO THE COLLABORATIVE ESTABLISHMENT AND COOPERATION ON THE DISPLAY AND PROMOTION OF LIVELIHOOD PRODUCTS CRAFTED BY PERSONS DEPRIVED OF LIBERTY (PDLs). (PCR 421-2026 dated April 6, 2026)*

A letter from Hon. Strike B. Revilla with an attached draft of the Memorandum of Agreement among the City Government of Bacoor, the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology-Region IV-A, and the Bacoor Livelihood Producers' Cooperative pertaining to the cooperative establishment and promotion of livelihood goods made by Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL).

FINDINGS:

The BJMP, through its Male and Female Dormitories, has continuously pursued programs that promote the rehabilitation, skills development, and livelihood opportunities of Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDLs).

The LGU Bacoor recognizes the importance of supporting PDL livelihood initiatives as a means of fostering dignity, productivity, and reintegration into society, in line with national policies on restorative justice and inclusive development.

A Philippine government initiative called One Town, One Product (OTOP) supports locally produced goods and services to support micro, small, and medium-sized businesses (MSMEs), preserve cultural heritage, and boost economic growth. By promoting unique products from different towns across the country, OTOP aims to create sustainable livelihood opportunities for local communities and improve overall competitiveness in the global market.

This initiative also encourages entrepreneurship and innovation, ultimately contributing to the development of a more inclusive and resilient economy.

The following are the goals of the agreement:

- A. Provide PDLs with a dignified and sustainable platform to showcase their skills, creativity, and productivity through livelihood products;
- B. Support rehabilitation and reintegration programs by creating opportunities for PDLs to contribute meaningfully to local economic and social development;
- C. Strengthen institutional cooperation among LGU Bacoor, its operator the BJMP, and the Department of Industry's OTOP Program in advancing restorative justice, social responsibility, and inclusive entrepreneurship; and
- D. Ensure transparency, accountability, and adherence to applicable laws, rules, and ethical standards in the management, display, and promotion of PDL-made livelihood products.

RECOMMENDATION:

After careful consideration, the Committee recommends that the proposed resolution be **APPROVED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod during its 38th regular session.




