Subject: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT FIELD OFFICE REGION IV-A FOR THE 16TH CYCLE OF SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAM. (PCR 422-2026 dated April 6, 2026)

This committee report pertains to the committee hearing conducted via Zoom Meeting on April 16, 2026 relative to the above-stated subject matter. The hearing was presided over by the Chairperson of the Committee on Social Services, Hon. Horacio M. Brillantes Jr. and was held at the MSBR Conference Room situated on the 4th Floor of the BLDR Building, Bacoor Government Center, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite. The minutes, attendance sheets, and pictures taken during the said hearing are attached hereto and shall be made integral parts of this report.

FINDINGS:

After careful evaluation of the documents and deliberation during the Committee's review, the following findings are hereby presented:

- The proposed Memorandum of Agreement is necessary to formalize the partnership between the DSWD Field Office IV-A and the City Government of Bacoor for the implementation of the 16th Cycle of the Supplementary Feeding Program.
- The Supplementary Feeding Program is a vital intervention that addresses undernutrition among children enrolled in Child Development Centers (CDCs) and Supervised Neighborhood Playgroups (SNPs), thereby promoting their health and overall development.





- The program is supported by existing laws, particularly Republic Act No. 11037, and aligns with the mandate of the local government to deliver basic social services, including nutrition programs.
- The approval of the MOA together with the passage of corresponding Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution are prerequisites for the approval and timely implementation of the Supplementary Feeding Program.
- Failure to approve and execute the MOA within the prescribed period may result in delays or non-implementation of the program, which may adversely affect the intended beneficiaries.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Honorable Members of the Joint Committee hereby recommends the **APPROVAL** of the Proposed City Resolution authorizing the City Mayor to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Field Office IV-A for the implementation of the 16th Cycle of the Supplementary Feeding Program.

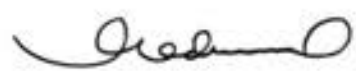

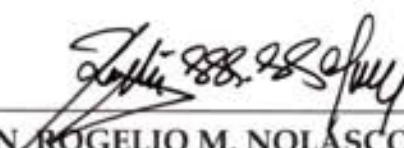
