Subject: **BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES OF 2026 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSURE OF ALL SARI-SARI STORES AT 12:00 AM WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF BARANGAY NIOG. (PCR-443-2026 dated April 20, 2026)**

The joint committee hearing was held on April 23, 2026, at 2:15 PM at the Session Hall, 6th floor, Bacoor Legislative & Disaster Resilience Building, Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Brgy. Bayanan, City of Bacoor, Cavite. It was presided over by Chairman Hon. Randy C. Francisco, Committee on Barangay Affairs.

FINDINGS:

1. The local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) is the foundational law that empowers the Barangay to enact ordinances and resolutions. It establishes the barangay as the primary planning and implementing unit for government policies. It grants the police power to ensure community safety and order, including the authority to conduct barangay conciliation proceedings.
2. Section 91 of City Ordinance No. 171-2021 (the "Child Protection and Development Code of the City of Bacoor") provides that the period from 10:00 in the morning is hereby declared as "curfew hours" for minors all over the City of Bacoor. Minors apprehended for violating this provision shall be returned to their parents and/or guardians, and the latter shall be required to pay a fine of P2,500.00.
3. Despite the implementation of curfew for minors, they're still roaming on the streets, pretending to buy necessities.

4. The Committee on Barangay Affairs is awaiting the result of the public hearing of Barangay Niog regarding the resolution for Barangay Ordinance No. 1, Series of 2026, entitled: An Ordinance Providing for the Closure of All Sari-Sari Stores at 12:00 AM within the Jurisdiction of Barangay Niog

This regulation of business hours is a valid exercise of police power aimed at promoting public welfare and maintaining peace and order.

RECOMMENDATION:

After thorough review and deliberation, the members of Barangay Affairs hereby recommend the **TEMPORARY ARCHIVED** of the Barangay Ordinance No.1, Series of 2026, providing for the closure of all Sari-Sari Stores at 12:00 AM within the Jurisdiction of Barangay Niog.

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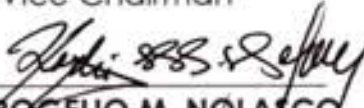

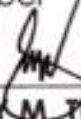
