Subject: (PCR 537-2026) A RESOLUTION OPENING AN OFFICIAL INQUIRY ON THE NATURE AND STATUS OF VARIOUS FLOOD CONTROL PROJECTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) AFFECTING THE CITY OF BACOR. (Date referred August 3, 2026).

FINDINGS:

The inquiry stems from a privilege speech delivered by Councilor Noly Galvez regarding the severe and recurring flooding experienced in Barangay Mambog and adjacent barangays in the City of Bacoor.

During the committee hearing, Engr. Abbygail Anselmo presented updates on the ongoing Drainage Master Plan for the City of Bacoor, which is currently undergoing review and revision by the DPWH Central Office. The proposed plan includes, among others, two (2) pumping stations, Reinforced Concrete Box Culverts (RCBC) along Aguinaldo Highway, and revetment improvements along the Bacoor, Zapote, and Maliksi Rivers.

It was likewise discussed that the implementation of the structural components of the Drainage Master Plan would require funding from the National Government upon approval by the DPWH Central Office. Drainage and flood control projects are also proposed annually through the Regional Budget Proposal (RBP), subject to funding and approval under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) and the corresponding legislative budget deliberations.

Furthermore, the representatives of the DPWH District Engineering Office clarified that they were not in a position to provide detailed technical explanations regarding the design, operation, and implementation of the Imus Retarding Basin, as the project is under the jurisdiction and implementation of the Unified Project Management Office (UPMO) of the DPWH Central Office.

On motion duly seconded, the Resolution opening an official inquiry on the nature and status of various DPWH flood control projects affecting the City of Bacoor was referred to the City Engineering Office for technical evaluation and appropriate action.

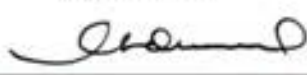

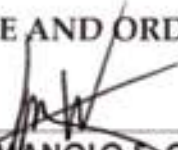

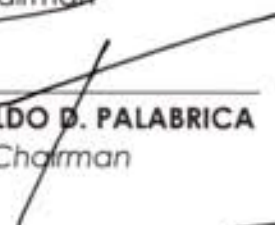
