Subject: *A resolution authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the City Government of Bacoor and the Department of Health – Drug Abuse Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (DOH-DATRC) Calabarzon.*

(Date referred: August 10, 2026)

The above-mentioned proposed resolution underwent its first reading on August 10, 2026 during the 55th Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed resolution was referred by the Presiding Officer, City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Baustista Mendiola to the Committee on Health and Sanitation.

FINDINGS:

A letter dated August 05, 2026 from the Office of the City Mayor was received by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, endorsing a letter from the Office of the Provincial Governor of the Province of Cavite regarding the Letter of Intent from the Department of Health – Drug Abuse Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (DOH-DATRC) Calabarzon to establish potential partnership through a Memorandum of Agreement with the City Government of Bacoor.



The Department of Health – Drug Abuse Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (DOH-DATRC) is a government facility committed to providing comprehensive, evidence-based treatment and rehabilitation services for individuals affected by substance use disorders. The center offers holistic approach to recovery through medical, psychological, and social interventions aimed at restoring the well-being of its patients.

Pursuant to Section 51 of R.A. No. 9165 of the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 mandates that the Local Government Units to appropriate a substantial portion of their annual budgets to assist in or enhance the enforcement of the said law giving priority to preventive or educational programs and the rehabilitation or treatment of drug dependents.

This proposed partnership aims to strengthen the collaborative efforts in providing accessible, comprehensive, and quality treatment and rehabilitation services. This MOA will facilitate the proper referral of patients from the City Government of Bacoor to DOH-DATRC Calabarzon, ensuring they receive appropriate care, intervention, and support throughout their recovery journey.

Through this proposed agreement, both parties will be able to clearly define roles, responsibilities, and processes in handling patients' referrals, coordination of services, and continuity of care, in alignment with existing policies and standards set by the Department of Health.

RECOMMENDATION:

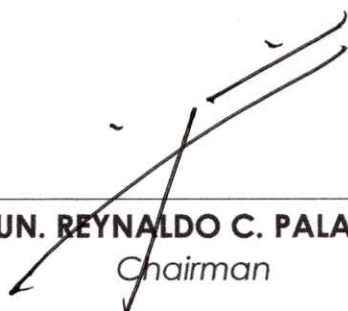

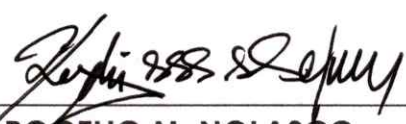
