**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 62
SERIES OF 2022**

AN ORDER MANDATING STRICT COMPLIANCE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF ARTICLE 24 OF CITY RESOLUTION NO. 217-2022 OR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-060 (THE 2013 REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOR) AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (2) (ii) of Republic Act No. 7160 provides that the City Mayor shall issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor passed through local legislation City Ordinance No. 217-2022 Series of 2022 to provide for the enabling ordinance for levying taxes, fees, and charges, prescribing the rates thereof for general and specific purposes and granting tax exemptions;

WHEREAS, there is a need to ensure the faithful implementation of the said Ordinance and to mandate the cognizant local city government offices to execute the same in view of the need of the City of Bacoor of sufficient funding for its programs and projects;

WHEREAS, temporary business permits may be subject to abuse and misuse if left unaccounted for and may pose a risk to the fiscal health of the City Government of Bacoor;

WHEREAS, Section 134.3 of City Ordinance No. 217-2022 provides for the Temporary Permit for Businesses with pending Office of the Building Official, Zoning, City Health Office Clearances, while Section 134.4. provides for the Temporary Permit for Events/Amusements;

WHEREAS, Section 134.3 of City Ordinance No. 217-2022 provides that a temporary permit to operate is valid only for thirty (30) to ninety (90) calendar days and may only be renewed with the written approval of the City Mayor.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STRIKE B. REVILLA, City Mayor of Bacoor, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) is directed to render a full account and audit of all persons, business and entities issued with a Temporary Business Permit and submit the same to the Office of the City Mayor within 30 days upon effectivity of this EO and every month thereafter. The BPLO is directed to inspect persons, entities and businesses whose Temporary Business Permits have already been expired and those who are determined by the BPLO as operating with an expired Temporary Business Permit shall be ordered closed down permanently;

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Person, businesses and entities found by the BPLO violating the provisions on Temporary Business Permit shall be prosecuted under Section 339 of the said Code.

Section 2. Repealing Clause.

All previously issued orders and directives inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

Section 3. Separability Clause.

In the event that any provision found herein shall be judicially or administratively declared illegal or infirm, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.
