#### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 120 - 2023 SERIES OF 2023

AN ORDER PROVIDING SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 46A-2023 OR AN ORDER ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 270-2023, OR THE "STRIKE GATE ORDINANCE"

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor recognizes the importance of government visibility and the capacity of closed-circuit television cameras in deterring criminal activities and the improvement of the sense of security of its constituents;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor as the chief executive is empowered by Republic Act No. 10160 or the Charter of the City of Bacoor to exercise powers expressly granted to him by law and those necessarily implied therefrom and essential to the promotion of the general welfare

WHEREAS, the City Mayor is further empowered by the same Act to enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the City and to issue executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 270-2023, or the "Strike Gate Ordinance", mandates the construction of security gates equipped with closed-circuit television cameras and manned by barangay personnel or those deputized by the City Mayor;

WHEREAS, there is a need to issue supplemental guidelines to EO No. 46A-2023 to improve the implementation of City Ordinance No.270-2023 and for the more efficient delivery of the required services contained therein;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, STRIKE B. REVILLA, Mayor of the City of Bacoor, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Scope.

This Executive Order is limited to implementing City Ordinance No. 270-2023.

Section 2. Suspended Implementation of Section 6 of City Ordinance No. 270-2023.

The implementation of Section 6 of City Ordinance No. 270-2023 is herebysuspended until otherwise declared.



The suspension is in consideration of and in compliance with the Circular issued by the National Privacy Commission, Circular No. 2022-03, a copy of which is made an integral part of this Executive Order.

As such, the following shall be the guidelines for the implementation of City Ordinance No. 270-2023:

- The personnel manning the Strike Gate <u>shall not</u> list down personal information and sensitive personal information of motorists in consideration of National Privacy Commission Circular No. 2022-03.
- Instead, the personnel manning the Strike Gates shall politely ask the motorists who wish to enter the Strike Gates to show their driver's license.
- The personnel shall then ask the motorist if he can temporarily hold the driver's license for verification. If the motorist refuses, the personnel shall ask the motorist to hold the driver's license so that the personnel can still verify the driver's license.
- 4. The personnel may check if the motorist and the picture appearing on the driver's license presented are the same person. The personnel may also ask the motorist to dictate his name and other details to check if they are the same as those on the driver's license.
- Once the personnel is satisfied with the verification, the driver's license shall be immediately returned to the motorist. The motorist shall then be allowed to enter through the Strike Gate.
- Retention and access to the recordings made by the CCTVs covered by this
  Executive Order and City Ordinance No. 270-2023 shall follow the
  guidelines provided in National Privacy Commission Advisory No. 202004.


### Section 3. Strict and Full Implementation of City Ordinance No. 270-2023.

The Barangays in the City of Bacoor are hereby ordered to strictly implement the provisions of City Ordinance No. 270-2023 in coordination with the City Engineering Office, except those provisions that are explicitly suspended.

The City Engineering Office is hereby ordered to strictly implement the provisions of City Ordinance No. CO 270-2023, particularly Section 4 on the installation of CCTV cameras.

## Section 4. Creation of the Strike Gate Technical Working Group.

The Strike Gate Technical Working Group is hereby created. The Strike Gate TWG shall be composed of the following officials or their representatives:



- Atty. Aimee Torrefranca-Neri City Administrator;
- 2. Atty. Paul Michael Sangalang Office of the City Mayor;
- 3. Engr. Jicky Jutba City Engineer,
- 4. Atty. Kim Nyca R. Lofranco City Legal Officer,
- Ms. Elvinia Guerrero City Budget Officer,
- The Department Head or the Assistant Department Head of the Bacoor Traffic Management Department;
- The President of the Liga ng Barangay;

The Strike Gate TWG shall oversee the overall implementation of City Ordinance No. 270-2023 with the Office of the City Engineer as the secretariat.

Membership in the TWG is a function of the office which the member occupies. As such, the resignation, removal, transfer, termination, grave illness, severe incapacity, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance shall entitle the successor to assume membership without the need to issue another executive order.

Further, each member of the TWG shall appoint a permanent and alternate representative of their office/department/agency or organization. The respective representatives shall act as focal persons of their respective agencies or organizations to ensure the effective and efficient delivery of programs, projects, or assistance based on their agencies' mandates.


# Section 5. Reportorial Requirements.


Each Punong Barangay shall submit to the Office of the City Mayor an Action Plan for the Implementation of City Ordinance No. 270-2023. The Action Plan shall contain the following information:

- The exact location of the strategic places where the Strike Gates shall be constructed;
- A timetable for the expected construction of the Strike Gates;
- The list of Barangay Officials and employees who will be designated to man the Strike Gates:

The Action Plan shall then be transmitted to the Office of the City Engineer as secretariat of the Strike Gate TWG.

Upon construction of a Strike Gate, the City Engineer shall then install the CCTV as required by City Ordinance No. 270-2023 on the Strike Gate or within its vicinity.





### Section 5. Separability Clause.

If any provisions of this Order will be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions hereof not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

### Section 6. Repealing Clause.

All Executive Orders and relevant issuances under the office of the local chief executive are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

#### Section 7. Effectivity.

This order shall take effect immediately.
