

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 28 - 2023 SERIES OF 2023

AN ORDER ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 256-2023 OR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FARE MATRICES OF VARIOUS TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATIONS (TODAS) IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE, IN COMPLIANCE WITH CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO 11-2019 (ALSO KNOWN AS THE "BACOOR TRAFFIC CODE") AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code authorized the Sangguniang Panlungsod to regulate the operation of tricycles and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the City;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor is empowered to enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the city and in the exercise of the appropriate corporate powers provided for under Section 22 of the Local Government Code, implement all approved policies, programs, projects, services, and activities of the city;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, passed City Ordinance No. 256-2023 Series of 2023 or the "2023 Tricycle Fare Adjustment Ordinance of Bacoor";

WHEREAS, the City Mayor is authorized to Issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, STRIKE B. REVILLA, City Mayor of Bacoor, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order for the adoption and implementation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations for the City Ordinance No. 256-2023 herein attached.

Section 1. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

Attached herein in the Implementing Rules Regulation of the City Ordinance No. 25-2023 which shall form part of this Executive Order. This shall be known as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 25-2023".

All affected offices and departments are hereby ordered to adopt the said implementing rules and regulations and be guided accordingly.

Strict compliance and observance of all city government officials and employees to this IRR is hereby ordered.





Section 2. Repealing Clause.

All previously issued orders and directives inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 3. Separability Clause.

In the event that any provision found herein be judicially or administratively declared illegal or infirm, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATION OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 256-2023 OR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FARE MATRICES OF VARIOUS TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATIONS (TODAS) IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE IN COMPLIANCE WITH CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO 11-2019 (ALSO KNOWN AS THE "BACOOR TRAFFIC CODE") AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

RULE 1 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. TITLE.

These Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be known and cited as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 256-2023 or the 2023 Tricycle Fare Adjustment Ordinance of Bacoor."

SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

These Implementing Rules and Regulations are promulgated for the effective implementation and enforcement of City Ordinance No. 256-2023.

SECTION 3. CONSTRUCTION.

The Implementing Rules and Regulations are promulgated for the effective Implementation and enforcement of City Ordinance No. 256-2023.

RULE 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.


SECTION 4. It shall be the policy of the City of Bacoor:

- To ensure that the needs of the riding public of the City of Bacoor be catered to;
- To recognize the needs of the public utility transport sector in the City of Bacoor are keeping with the times;
- To regulate the reasonable fares of local public utility transportation;
- To ensure that public utility tricycles, electric tricycles and pedicabs used as a public utility be given their fair profit for their work;

RULE 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

SECTION 5. The following terms shall be defined as follows:

 Public Utility Tricycle - a tricycle granted with a valid franchise to operate as a public utility vehicle by the City Government of Bacoor.



- Special Permit a permit issued in favor of operators of tricycles or E-STRIKEs not residing within the City of Bacoor who holds a valid franchise from another local government unit adjoining the City of Bacoor. A holder of a special permit validly issued under the 2021 Revised Traffic Code may ferry passengers from outside of the City without being made criminally liable for violation of the pertinent provisions of the said Code.
- Franchise the legitimate document of entitlement of a tricycle or
 pedicab operator to operate as a public utility vehicle/s within a specific
 route of road networks and directions within the City of Bacoor issued
 by the Sangguniang Panlungsod as duly approved by the City Mayor.

RULE 4. MANDATORY GUIDELINES.

SECTION 6. Maximum Number of Passengers.

All public utility tricycles operating with a valid franchise within the City of Bacoor, including those granted special permits by the city government with franchises granted by other local government units, shall be allowed to carry not more than three (3) passengers per trip. Provided that: two (2) passengers will be allowed to sit inside the sidecar and only one passenger shall be allowed to sit behind the driver. Provided further that: a clear plastic sheet shall be placed between the driver and the passenger sitting behind him and the passenger sitting in the sidecar in such a way as to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Provided lastly that: a PUT that has not been properly equipped with the plastic sheets mentioned above shall NOT be allowed to carry any passenger.

SECTION7. Fares for Tricycles.

All PUTs covered by this Ordinance shall charge the fares based on the prevailing price of gasoline.

Moreover, in special instances, the following are the additional fares, to wit:

- a) additional P2.00 for every succeeding kilometer on REGULAR TRIP;
- b) additional P5.00 for every succeeding kilometer on SPECIAL TRIP;
- c) 20% Discount on SENIOR CITIZENS, PWDs and STUDENTS; and
- d) additional of P 5.00 for trips occurring between 10:00 PM to 4:00 AM.

SECTION 8. Determination of Prevailing Price of Gasoline.

The determination of the prevailing price of gasoline shall be made by the recommendation of the BTMD and approval of the City Mayor. The recommendation of the BTMD shall be based on the published Prevailing Retail Prices of Petroleum Products in Southern Luzon - Cavite by the Department of Energy.

SECTION 11. Fare Matrix.

The Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) shall post the adjusted fare matrix on the official website of the City of Bacoor, inside PUT's covered by this Ordinance, and in conspicuous places within all accredited transportation

terminals within the City of Bacoor. The removal, defacement, or unauthorized revision of the said fare matrices shall be considered a violation of this Ordinance.

RULE 5. PENALTIES.

SECTION 12. PENALTIES.

The franchise or special permit of any PUT covered by the Ordinance that violates any provision hereof shall be suspended for sixty (60) days. The driver of any PUT who violates this Ordinance shall pay a fine of Three Thousand Pesos (Php 3,000.00).

RULE 6. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

SECTION. 13. SEPARABILITY.

In case certain provisions of this IRR are declared void by a court of law, the provisions hereof not affected by the said judicial declaration shall continue to have legal force and effect.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY.

This IRR shall take effect immediately.
