

**AN ORDER ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS
OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-018, OR THE AMENDED SECURITY GUARD
REGULATION ORDINANCE OF BACOR**

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. No. 7160 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare...xxx;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod enacted and passed City Ordinance No. 2013-018, otherwise known as the "Amended Security Guard Regulation Ordinance of Bacoor" to strengthen the policy in regulating the operations of security agencies and security guards operating or working in various business establishments and privately-owned lots in the City of Bacoor;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor recognizes the need to issue an Implementing Rules and Regulations pertinent to the above-mentioned Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor of Bacoor, in coordination with the concerned city government offices, issued the above-mentioned Implementing Rules and Regulations that shall govern the "Amended Security Guard Regulation Ordinance of Bacoor";

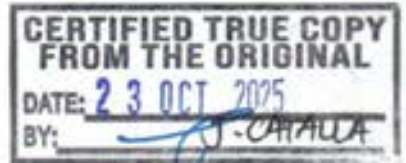
NOW, THEREFORE, I, STRIKE B. REVILLA, City Mayor of Bacoor, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order for the adoption and implementation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 2013-018 herein attached.

Section 1. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

Attached herein is the Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 2013-018 which shall form part of this Executive Order. This shall be known as the **"Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 2013-018."**

All affected offices and departments are hereby ordered to adopt the said implementing rules and regulations and be guided accordingly.

Strict compliance and observance of all city government officials and employees to this IRR is hereby ordered.



Section 2. Repealing Clause.

All previously issued orders and directives inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

Section 3. Separability Clause.

In the event that any provision found herein shall be judicially or administratively declared illegal or infirm, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing and remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

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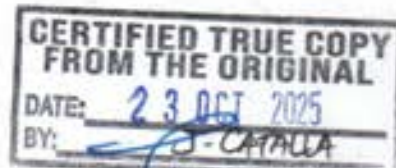

IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF
CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-018



CITY ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 19, SERIES OF
2011, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL
SECURITY AGENCIES AND SECURITY GUARDS DOING BUSINESS OR
WORKING IN BACOR, CAVITE"

RULE I
GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. Title.

These Rules shall be known and cited as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 2013-018, or the Amended Security Guard Regulation Ordinance of Bacoor".

Section 2. Purpose

These Rules and Regulations are promulgated to prescribe for the procedures and guidelines for the implementation of Bacoor City Ordinance No. 2013-018 in order to rationalize and strengthen the policy in regulating the operations of security agencies and security guards operating or working in various business establishments and privately-owned lots in the City of Bacoor to protect the people from armed individuals committing crimes under the mantle of legality.

Section 3. Coverage

The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all security agencies and security guards operating or working in all business establishments or privately-owned properties within the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

Section 4. Construction

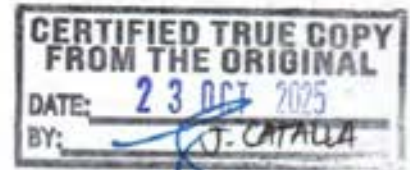
These Rules shall be construed and applied in accordance with and in furtherance of the policies and objectives of the City Ordinance No. 2013-018.

Section 5. Implementing Agencies.

The Office of the City Mayor, in conjunction with the Bacoor PNP, shall be the lead implementing agencies for the implementation of this IRR. Other city government departments, units or offices, as may be directed by the City Mayor, shall assist in the effective implementation of this IRR.



**RULE II
IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS**



Section 6. Prior Registration

All security agencies and security guards must first secure a Barangay Clearance from their respective barangays prior to their registration in the Office of the City Mayor and PNP Bacoor. All security agencies and security guards are hereby required to register with the Office of the Mayor and the Chief of Police of the Bacoor-PNP and obtain a Mayor's Permit before they can be allowed to operate or work in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

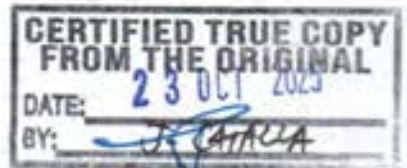
Section 7. Registration Fee.

A registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) per security agency and Two Hundred (P200.00) per security guard covered by this ordinance shall be paid at the Office of the City Treasurer.

Section 8. Prohibited Acts - The following acts shall be prohibited under this ordinance:

- A. Carrying high-powered firearms by security guards in violation of the regulations of the Philippine National Police. Provided, that an inventory of all firearms to be used by the security agencies covered by this Ordinance shall be submitted to the Office of the City Mayor and the Bacoor PNP.
- B. Preventing government employees or contractors from entering privately owned business and lots while in the performance of their official functions. Provided, that such government employees should wear the proper identification cards upon entering and while within such privately-owned businesses or properties.
- C. Harassing, threatening, or preventing private lot owners or farmers from entering their properties or harvesting their produce without a proper court order. Provided, that security guards deployed to guard vacant lots must bring certified true copies of the land title of the purported land owners at all times. Provided, further, that a copy of the said land title shall be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor prior such deployment for proper verification.
- D. Operating a security agency or taking on the assignment of a security guard within the City of Bacoor, Cavite without the registering with the Office of the Mayor. Provided, that in case of emergency deployment of security guards, the security agency concerned shall submit a written notice of such emergency deployment to the office of the City Mayor and/or the Bacoor Philippine National Police (PNP) together with a list of the names, addresses and their PNP-Supervisory Office for Security and Investigation Agency (SOSIA) registration identification numbers.





Section 9. Annual Inspection.

The PNP Bacoar must conduct a yearly inspection of the firearms to be used by the securities agencies.

RULE III PENALTIES

Section 10. Penalties.

After trial in proper court of law, the following penalties shall be imposed against any security guard and/or of the general manager/owner/president/ or supervisor of any security agency that violates any provision of the City Ordinance No. 2013-018:

First offense: Fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) plus imprisonment of not more than two (2) months.

Second offense: Fine of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) plus imprisonment of not more than four (4) months.

Third offense: Fine of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) plus imprisonment of not more than six (6) months.

RULE IV MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 11. Repeal Clause

All other rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are in conflict, inconsistent or contravene any of the provisions of this Implementing Rules and Regulations are hereby considered repealed, amended and/or modified, accordingly.

Section 12. Separability Clause

In case a court of laws or court of competent jurisdiction declares any provision of this Implementing Rules and Regulations void, contrary to law or unconstitutional, the validity or enforceability of any other provisions hereof not affected by such declaration shall not be affected and remain in full force and effect.

Section 13. Effectivity

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
