



EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 03- 2024 Series of 2024

AN ORDER ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 226-2022, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "RIVER DRIVE USE ACCESS ORDINANCE"

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. No. 7160 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare including the promotion of safety of its constituents and provision of adequate transportation facilities;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod enacted and passed City Ordinance No. 226-2022, otherwise known as the "River Drive Use Access Ordinance" which aim to provide procedures that will govern the regulated use of access roads as an alternative route from Barangay San Nicolas III to Barangay Molino III and vice versa to avoid traffic in city main thoroughfares;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor recognizes the need to issue an Implementing Rules and Regulations pertinent to the above-mentioned Ordinance;


WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor of Bacoor, in coordination with the concerned city government offices, issued the above-mentioned Implementing Rules and Regulations that shall govern the "River Drive Use Access Ordinance";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STRIKE B. REVILLA, City Mayor of Bacoor, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order for the adoption and implementation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 226-2022 herein attached.


Section 1. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

Attached herein is the Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 226-2022 which shall form part of this Executive Order. This shall be known as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations for the "River Drive Use Access Ordinance".

All affected offices and departments are hereby ordered to adopt the said implementing rules and regulations and be guided accordingly.







Strict compliance and observance of all city government officials and employees to this IRR is hereby ordered.

Section 2. Repealing Clause.

All previously issued orders and directives inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

Section 3. Separability Clause.

In the event that any provision found herein shall be judicially or administratively declared illegal or infirm, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing and remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.



IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 226-2022

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF, AND ACCESS TO, THE RIVER DRIVE ROAD WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF

RULE I GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. TITLE.

These Rules shall be known and cited as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations of the River Drive Use Access Ordinance."

Section 2. PURPOSE.

These Rules and Regulations are promulgated to prescribe the procedures and guidelines for the effective implementation of Bacoor City Ordinance No. 226-2022 to govern the regulated use of access roads as an alternative route from Barangay San Nicolas III to Barangay Molino III and vice versa to avoid traffic in city main thoroughfares.

Section 3. COVERAGE.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to persons affected by the implementation and enforcement of the City of Bacoor River Drive Use Access Ordinance.

Section 4. CONSTRUCTION.

These Rules shall be construed and applied in accordance with and in furtherance of the policies and objectives of the City Ordinance No. 226-2023.


Section 5. IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES.

The Office of the City Mayor, in conjunction with the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD), shall be the lead implementing agency for

implementing this IRR. As may be directed by the City Mayor, other city government departments, units, or offices shall assist in effectively implementing this IRR.

RULE II IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS

Section 6. THE RIVER DRIVE ROAD.

The River Drive Road shall refer to the 1.61-kilometer-long road stretching from Barangay Molino III to Barangay San Nicolas II within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

Section 7. LIMITATION TO ACCESS.

The use of the River Drive Road shall be guided by the following conditions:

A. Type of Vehicle.

- Only privately-owned vehicles are allowed to use the River Drive Road.
- No public utility vehicle, bus, or truck, regardless of engine displacement, shall be allowed to use the said road.
- Only those vehicles with a valid Solidarity Route sticker shall be allowed to use the road.
- Properly marked government vehicles used in official government business.

B. Time of Access.

- 1. The road shall be passable only from 4:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily.
- The City Government may declare the road closed whenever there are official city events or gathering that may involve using the road or any portion of it.


Section 8. APPLICATION OF THE SOLIDARITY ROUTE ORDINANCE.

The provisions under City Ordinance No. 255-2023 ("2023 Expanded Solidarity Route Ordinance of the City of Bacoor") pertaining to securing a solidarity route sticker, fees, validity, and use thereof shall apply in suppletory in the implementation of the River Drive Use Access Ordinance.

Section 9. ROADBLOCKS AND CHECKPOINTS.

The City Government, through the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) and the Bacoor-PNP, shall maintain roadblocks and checkpoints in various areas along the River Drive Road to ensure the implementation of this Ordinance.

Section 10. APPLICATION OF THE SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE.

The provisions of City Ordinance 227-2022 ("Speed Limit Reduction Ordinance of the City of Bacoor") shall be observed in implementing the River Drive Use Access Ordinance. Specifically, the allowable speed limit on River Drive Road shall be 40 KPH to 60 KPH, the River Drive being classified under through streets.


Section 11. INSTALLATION OF SCANNERS AND CCTV CAMERAS.


In conjunction with Section 12 of the CO 255-2023, the BTMD, City Engineering Office, and E-Governance Department are hereby authorized to install closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras at strategic locations along the River Drive Road to validate the authenticity of Solidarity Route Stickers. The said CCTV cameras shall be maintained, operated, and monitored by the BDRRMO and the E-Governance Department.

Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) readers shall also be installed in the entry/exit roads of the River Drive. This is to allow the users of Bacoor Solidarity Route Sticker, which has RFID features, to enjoy the privilege to access the River Drive as part of the Solidarity Route system of the City of Bacoor.

Section 12. CONSTRUCTION OF GUARDHOUSE AND DETAIL OF SECURITY PERSONNEL. The City Engineering Office is hereby authorized to construct a guardhouse in key areas along the River Drive. The Bacoor Traffic Management Department, with the assistance of the Barangay concerned, shall designate a security personnel to ensure the 24-hour patrolling on the River Drive, monitoring traffic, guarding entry/exit points, and verifying vehicles with Solidarity Route Stickers.

Section 13. ROAD MAINTENANCE. The City Engineering Office (CEO) shall be in charge in the overall maintenance of the River Drive Road to ensure that it is functional, passable, and safety for the use of the public. The CEO shall likewise maintain the sidewalks, streetlights, and markings on the pavements, and shall conduct road repairs when necessary.





RULE III PENALTIES

Section 14. PENALTY.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall pay a fine of Two Thousand and Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00). Any appointed employee of the city government or the various barangays of the City who violates this Ordinance shall be suspended for three (3) days without pay aside from paying the fine mentioned above.

RULE IV MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 15. CHANGES IN MODIFICATIONS TO THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.

To appropriately manage the orderly administration of the implementation of the City Ordinance No. 226-2022, the Office of the City Mayor, after consultation with the BTMD, may recommend to the Sangguniang Panlungsod amendments to the said ordinance and, consequently, this IRR.

Section 16. AUTOMATIC REVIEW.

The Sangguniang Panlungsod shall cause the automatic review of the River Drive Use Access once every three (3) years.

Section 17, SEPARABILITY.

In case any provision of these implementing Rules and Regulations is declared void by a court of law, the remaining provision of this IRR not affected by the said judicial declaration shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 18. EFFECTIVITY.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
