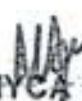

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. MSBR-098-2025
Series of 2025

AN ORDER ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 346-2024 SERIES OF 2024 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DEFAACEMENT, DESTRUCTION, OR DESPOILING OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF."

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. No. 7160 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare including the promotion of safety of its constituents and provision of adequate transportation facilities;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod enacted and passed City Ordinance No. 346-2024, entitled "An Ordinance Prohibiting the Defacement, Destruction, Or Despoiling of Public and Private Properties Within the City of Bacoor, Cavite and Providing Penalties for Violations Hereof.";

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor recognizes the need to issue the Implementing Rules and Regulations pertinent to the above-mentioned Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor of Bacoor, in coordination with the concerned city government offices, issued the above-mentioned Implementing Rules and Regulations that shall govern City Ordinance No. 346-2024 Series of 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STRIKE B. REVILLA, City Mayor of Bacoor, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the adoption and implementation of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 346-2024 Series of 2024, herein attached.

Section 1. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). Attached herein are the Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 346-2024 Series of 2024, which shall form part of this Executive Order. This shall be known as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations of City Ordinance No. 346-2024 Series of 2024." All affected offices and departments are hereby ordered to adopt the said implementing rules and regulations and be guided accordingly. Strict compliance and observance by all city government officials and employees with these Implementing Rules and Regulations is hereby ordered.

Section 2. Repealing Clause. All previously issued orders and directives inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 3. Separability Clause. In the event that any provision found herein shall be judicially or administratively declared illegal or infirm, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effectivity Clause. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing and remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

**THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF
CITY ORDINANCE NO. 346-2024**

OR

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE
DEFACEMENT, DESTRUCTION, OR DESPOILING OF
PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY
OF BACOR, CAVITE
AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS
HEREOF.**

**RULE I
GENERAL PROVISIONS**

Section 1. Title. This shall be known as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations to City Ordinance No. 346-2024 or the 2024 ANTI VANDALISM ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE".

Section 2. Purpose. This IRR is promulgated to prescribe the procedure and guidelines for the effective implementation of City Ordinance No. 346-2024 Series of 2024.

Section 3. Scope and Application. This Implementing Rules and Regulations shall apply to any act of vandalism as may be defined in City Ordinance No. 346-2024 and this Implementing Rules and Regulations on any public or private property.

Section 4. Implementing Offices. The Office of the City Engineer, the General Services Office, shall assume primary responsibility for enforcing the aforementioned City Ordinance and this Implementing Rules and Regulations. Other city government departments, units, or offices may be called upon by the directive of the City Mayor to provide auxiliary support in the effective implementation of both the Ordinance and This IRR.

Section 5. Rules of Construction. In construing the provisions of This IRR, the following rules of construction shall be observed unless inconsistent with the manifest intent of the provision or when applied. They would lead to absurd or highly improbable results.

- 1. General Interpretation.** – All words and phrases used in This IRR should be understood according to their usual meaning, but technical terms or those with specific meanings in This IRR should be interpreted accordingly.





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2. **Gender and Number.** – Words indicating gender or number should be interpreted inclusively, acknowledging all gender identities and expressions and all numerical interpretations.
3. **Calculation of Time.** – When determining timeframes for actions as outlined in This IRR or related regulations, the first day is excluded, and the last day is included unless it falls on a Sunday or a holiday, in which case the following business day is considered the final day.
4. **References.** – Any mention of chapters, articles, or sections refers to those within This IRR unless otherwise specified.
5. **Resolution of Conflicts.** – In the event of conflicting provisions within different sections, each section's specific details should prevail.

RULE II
DECLARATION OF POLICY AND DEFINITIONS

Section 6. Declaration of Policy. It shall be the policy of the City Government of Bacoor to prevent the defacement and destruction of any property owned by the government or by any public utility and to punish the same.

Section 7. Definition Of Terms. The following terms shall be defined as follows:

1. **Community Service** – community service shall consist of any actual physical activity that inculcates civic consciousness and is intended for the improvement of public work or promotion of public service.
2. **Guardian** – in case of absence or death of the parent/s of the offending minor, any person exercising parental authority over the offending minor. In the absence of a judicially appointed guardian, the person who exercises substitute parental authority over the offending minor as indicated in the Family Code in the following order: the surviving grandparent, the oldest brother or sister over twenty-one years of age, unless unfit or disqualified, and the child's actual custodian, over twenty-one years of age, unless unfit or disqualified.
3. **Private Properties** - any movable or immovable property as defined in Book II, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Civil Code of the Philippines that was constructed or purchased with the use of private funds.
4. **Public Properties** - any movable or immovable property as defined in Book II, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Civil Code of the Philippines that was constructed or purchased with the use of public funds or that was donated, sold, conveyed, or turned over to the city government by the national government or by the private sector.





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5. **Vandalism** - any willful act that fully or partially defaces; destroys; or despoils a private or public property situated within the City of Bacoor, Cavite, done by means of:
- Writing, pasting, drawing, painting, marking, or inscribing on any public or private property any word, insignia, symbol, image, caricature, mark, initials, numbers, or a combination thereof without the express written authority of the owner/s of the said private properties or of the City Mayor in the case of public properties;
 - the pasting, attaching, posting, affixing, or installation of any placard, billboard, notice, poster, advertisement, or streamer on any private or public property within the City of Bacoor without the express written authority of the owner/s of the said private properties or of the City Mayor in the case of public properties;
 - the theft, smashing, breaking, or cutting of any private or public property without the consent of the owner/s of the said private properties or of the City Mayor in the case of public properties; or
 - defecating, spitting, or urinating on any public or private property without the consent of the owner/s of the said private properties or of the City Mayor in the case of public properties by way of an Ordinance.

RULE III
GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 8. Prohibitions. Any act of vandalism as defined in City Ordinance No. 346-2024 and Section 6 of this IRR willfully done on any public or private property situated within the City of Bacoor, Cavite, is expressly and strictly prohibited.

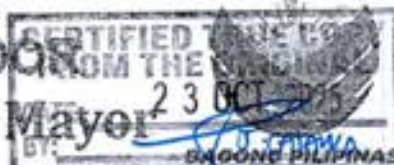
Section 9. Penalties. Any person of legal age who commits any act of vandalism as defined in Section 2 shall be required to pay a fine of Php 5,000.00 and to render community service for not more than thirty (30) but not less than ten (10) calendar days upon conviction by a court of law. In addition, the offender may also be ordered by the presiding judge to pay for the cost of repairing the damage he/she inflicted on the private or public property he/she vandalized.

If the offender is a minor, the said fine and community service shall be paid and done by his/her parent/s or guardian/s. The cost of repairing the damage that the minor offender inflicted on the private or public property he/she vandalized shall also be paid by his/her parent/s or guardian/s.





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Section 10. Community Service. As provided for under City Ordinance No. 228-2022 or the *Uniform Implementation Procedure Ordinance of the City of Bacoor*, in relation to City Ordinance No. 346 -2024, the parent or guardian of the offending minor may be required to render community service for a minimum period of **TWENTY (20) HOURS**.

The head of the City Government Department/Unit implementing City Ordinance No. 346-2024 in close and strict coordination with the City Social Welfare Development Office shall determine the kind of community service that will be required of the parent/guardian.

After the completion of the community service, the City Government Department/Unit head, with the express and written conformity of the City Social Welfare Development Office, shall render a report to the City Inspection and Compliance Unit, which shall consider the case closed.

The non- completion of the community service as certified by the department/unit head concerned shall be deemed a waiver on the part of the parent/guardian of the offending minor, and the appropriate legal action may be instituted against the parent/guardian or the offender.

In the performance of the community service, the city department/ unit head and the City Social Welfare Development Office shall strictly ensure that the parent/guardian rendering the community service shall not be made to perform any task that exposes him/her to public ridicule, bodily injury, or anything or act which requires him/her to do that may be characterized as cruel, or unusual, or inhuman punishment.

RULE IV FINAL PROVISIONS

Section 11. Budget Appropriations. – The City Government of Bacoor shall allocate the necessary funds in its annual budget or any subsequent supplemental budget to implement the provisions outlined in the Ordinance.

Section 12. Changes or Modifications of the Implementing Rules and Regulations. – In order to ensure the efficient and effective implementation of the Ordinance, the Office of the City Mayor, in consultation with relevant offices, may propose amendments to said Ordinance and, consequently, to This IRR, as deemed necessary.

Section 13. Separability. – Should any section or provision of This IRR be deemed unconstitutional or invalid, the unaffected sections or provisions shall continue in full force and effect.





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Section 14. Repeal. – All local rules or regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of This IRR are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.

Section 15. Effectivity. – This IRR shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
