ORDINANCE NO. 12- S-98

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE B(Q) AND J. OF THE REVISED REVENUE TAX CODE OF BACOOR (1993) CONCERNING FIRING RANGE RULES AND REGULATIONS AND THE RATE OF CHARGES/FEES.

WHEREAS, the increase of population of the Municipality of Bacoor in the last five (5) years brought about the influx of gun and firing aficionados;

WHEREAS, the ~~above~~ said people have been approaching the Municipality for purposes of Applying for a permit to operate and maintain firing ranges;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to regulate the activities of the said people and at the same time increasing the revenues of the Municipality.

SECTION 1. Imposition of Fees. – Every person or entity who shall establish, operate and maintain gun club within Municipality of Bacoor shall first secure a permit from the Municipal Mayor through the Department of Public Order and Safety and pay the corresponding annual fees:

6-10 firing range -----	1,000.00
more than 10 firing ranges -----	2,000.00

SECTION 2. Administrative Provisions. - a) The prerequisites of law relative to the establishment, operation, and maintenance of firing ranges should be strictly complied with before a permit shall be issued. b) Upon the order of the Municipal Mayor, the Department of Public Order and Safety or any government agency shall have the authority to inspect firing ranges to ensure that the standard specifications relative to public safety are strictly complied with.

SECTION 3. Time of Payment. - The annual fees imposed shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer upon order of payment given by the department of Public Order and Safety and renewable on or before the prescribed period.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen days (15) after its publication in a Newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite.
