ORDINANCE NO.- 5- S-98

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AND/OR REGULATING THE PARKING OF ANY KIND OR TYPE OF MOTOR VEHICLES ALONG THE DESIGNATED PORTION OF MAIN THOROUGHFARES AND SEVERAL BARANGAY ROADS/STREETS OF THIS MUNICIPALITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the traffic situation in Bacoor, Cavite has gone from bad to worse;

WHEREAS, the rampant illegal and indiscriminate parking of motor vehicles, especially the ten-wheeler type truck and public utility vehicles, along public roads, sidewalks and main thoroughfares or portion thereof in this municipality has greatly contributed to traffic congestion and hazards to pedestrians;

WHEREAS, there is also a need to regulate parking along several barangays streets/roads since these necessarily become alternate routes to motorists, especially during rush hours, and, therefore, must be cleared from illegal and irresponsible parking;

WHEREAS, it has become imperative to reduce to a great extent traffic accidents and congestion's in the municipality to promote the welfare of its inhabitants by prohibiting concerned drivers and owners/operators from illegally parking their trucks, public utility vehicles and other motor vehicles, as the case may be, in any public road, barangay streets, or main thoroughfares in Bacoor, Cavite;

WHEREAS, the Clean and Green Program of the National Government cannot be implemented properly, and worse, trees already planted along roadsides become casualties of drivers' irresponsible parking habits;

NOW THEREFORE:

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bacoor, Province of Cavite in a regular session assembled that:

Section 1. - Parking of any kind or type of motor vehicle shall be prohibited from 5:00 AM to 12MN except for loading and unloading purposes (within a reasonable period of time and without obstructing the flow of traffic), along the designated portion of main thoroughfares, to wit:

- a). along Aguinaldo Highway up to Coastal Road
- b). the whole Evangelista Street
- c). the whole Tirona Highway
- d). along Aniban Road up to Dasmariñas Boundary ✓
- e). along Bayanan up to Mambog
- f). from Zapote Bridge on to Aguinaldo Highway up to Imus boundary ✓

Section 2. - The term "cargo trucks" as used in this Ordinance shall be understood to mean motor vehicles, principally intended for carrying cargo and having license plates of the following classification: "S", "TH", "TRLB", "HLB", and "TRJ", to include other vehicles such as lorries, vans, tankers or other delivery vehicles, whether loaded or empty, having a gross capacity weight of more than four thousand (4,000) kilos.

Section 3. - Flow of traffic and parking along barangay streets/roads of any kind or type of motor vehicles shall be prohibited and/or regulated in the following barangays, to wit :

Section 3.A - NIOG-1 One side parking of four (4) wheeler vehicles. No cargo trucks are allowed to park along this barangay road at all times. A van can only be exempted if its loading/unloading merchandise and if it will not hamper the free flow of traffic. The flow of traffic shall be two-way, from Aguinaldo Highway to Niog-1 Boundary. The concerned Barangay Council, headed by its Barangay Chairman, shall designate the one-side parking area through a resolution to be submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval.

Section 3.A (1) NIOG-1 ROAD EXTENSION shall be a one-way traffic from 5 AM - 10AM and 4 PM to 9 PM, its traffic flow towards main Barangay Niog-1. ✓

Section 3.A (2) In the interest of clarification in this Ordinance, NIOG-1 Road Extension is the extended stretch of NIOG-1 Road that separates Maliksi -1 from Talaba-1, right after St. Joseph and St. Michael Subdivisions.

Section 3.A (3) Vehicles from NIOG-1 Road Extension going Poblacion shall use St. Joseph Subdivision alternate route leading to Panapaan Road, those going to Coastal Road shall use St. Michael Subdivision leading to Aguinaldo Highway.

Section 3.B - NIOG 2 & 3 UP TO THE BOUNDARY OF BAYANAN ROAD. No parking at all times of all types of motor vehicles and shall be a two-way traffic flow.

Section 3.C - PANAPAAAN ROAD - One side parking for four (4) wheel vehicles. No big vans and cargo trucks shall be allowed to park along this barangay road at all times. A van can only be exempted if it's loading and unloading merchandises and if it will not obstruct traffic flow. Traffic for this barangay road shall be a two-way flow. The Barangay Council, headed by its Barangay Chairman, shall designate the one-side parking area through a resolution to be submitted to Sangguniang Bayan for approval.

Section 3.D - SALINAS-REAL ROAD - No parking of all types of motor vehicles at all times and shall be a two-way traffic flow.

Section 3.E - DAAN BUKID AND HABAY - No parking of all types of motor vehicles at all times and shall be a two-way traffic.

Section 4. - Main thoroughfares, barangay roads and streets which are specified above in Section 1, Section 3.B, 3.D and 3.E as definitely a non-parking zone, can be permitted to have a one-side parking with time limit if the concerned Barangay Council, headed by its Barangay Chairman, can justify it through a resolution, in coordination with the SB Chairman of Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety.

Section 5. - No motor vehicle is allowed to park, terminal (of tricycles/pedicabs) be maintained, or sidewalk vendors be permitted along concerned barangay roads ten (10) meters immediately from main thoroughfares of this municipality.

Section 6. - Penalty for Violators:

6.1 Summons or citation tickets with penalty shall be issued on illegally parked vehicles to be redeemed at the Municipal Motorpool within twenty-four hours, upon payment of the appropriate penalty prescribed.

6.2 Penalty for jeeps, passenger jeepneys, cars and other four (4) wheelers shall be Three Hundred Pesos (P 300.00) and impounding of vehicles with One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per day for storage fee.

6.3 Penalty for six (6) wheelers shall be Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00) and impounding of vehicles with Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) per day for storage fee.

6.4 Penalty for ten (10) wheelers shall be One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) and impounding of vehicles with Three Hundred Pesos (P 300.00) per day for storage fee.

Section 7. - It is hereby ordered to tow stalled and illegally parked vehicles at the expense of the owner and that said owner pay the required penalty for violation thereof:

7.1 Towing Charges or Fees:

(a) For cars and four (4) wheelers P 800.00

- (b) For six (6) wheelers 1,500.00
- (c) For ten (10) wheelers 2,000.00

Section 8. EXEMPTION - Parking of four (4) wheel vehicle is temporarily allowed on specific places where there are wakes, school and religious activities, wedding and birthday celebrations, provided however, that a permit has been secured first from concerned Barangay Captain.

Section 9. - Such fees and charges shall accrue exclusively to the Local Government Unit of Bacoor as mandated by Section 129 under the title Local Taxation and Fiscal Matters.

Section 10. - That a reasonable amount of money be appropriated from whatever funds available for the expense of signages and notices arising from the implementation thereof.

Section 11. - Any ordinance or any part thereof which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 12. - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after the required publication or notice.
