CITY ORDINANCE NO. 270-2023

AN ORDINANCE EMPOWERING BARANGAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR TO CONSTRUCT GATES THAT WILL BE CALLED "STRIKE GATES" AT STRATEGIC PLACES WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE BARANGAYS AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the installation of gates within the territorial jurisdiction of various barangays that are equipped with closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras, has been proven to deter criminal activities, safeguard residents' privacy, and provide a sense of security for the community.

WHEREAS, the presence of 24/7 manned gates can efficiently regulate the entry and exit of vehicles, deter the entry of criminals into a community, and provide quick response to emergencies within the barangay.

WHEREAS, requiring motorists to remove their helmets and surrender their driver's license at the said security gates can aid law enforcement personnel in identifying potential threats and prevent criminal activities from taking place within the barangay.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) empowers the City Government to enact measures that will promote the general welfare of their constituents, including the establishment of gates within their jurisdiction to enhance security and protect the lives and property of their residents.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code, the city or municipality, through the city or municipal Mayor concerned, shall exercise general supervision over component Barangays to ensure that said Barangays act within the scope of their prescribed powers and functions.

WHEREAS, Barangay governments are required to discharge the responsibilities conferred upon them by ordinance and to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants therein.

NOW THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite that:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "**STRIKE Gate Ordinance.**"

Section 2. Scope. This Ordinance shall apply to all Barangays within the City of Bacoor.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. The following terms as used in this Ordinance shall be defined as:

3.1. **"STRIKE GATES"** shall refer to the security gates installed and maintained by the barangays within their jurisdiction, manned 24/7 by barangay personnel or by persons deputized by the City Mayor to enforce this Ordinance, and equipped with closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras and other necessary security features.

3.2. **"Closed Circuit Television (CCTV)"** shall refer to the use of video cameras to transmit a signal to a specific place, on a limited set of monitors.

Section 4. Construction and maintenance. The barangays shall be empowered to construct and maintain "STRIKE GATES" at strategic places within their jurisdiction. The City Engineering Office shall install CCTV cameras in the vicinity of the gates to monitor and record the activities within the area. The design of the said gates shall be subject to the approval of the City Mayor.

Section 5. Regulation of Motorists. All motorists passing through the "STRIKE GATES" shall:

- temporarily surrender their driver's license at the gate,
- remove their helmets, if they are riding motorcycles, and
- look at the CCTV without any obstruction to their face

Section 6. Duty of Personnel Manning the Gate. The personnel manning the gate shall list down the driver's name, plate number, address, and driver's license number. Afterward, they are required to return the driver's license to the motorist. No fees shall be collected from any person who shall enter or exit the said gate/s.

Section 7. Penalties. Any barangay personnel or person deputized by the Mayor to implement this Ordinance who fails or refuses to comply with the requirement of listing down the driver's name, plate number, address, and license number or who collects any fee or consideration from any person in exchange for the right to enter or exit the said gate/s shall be fined not less than P1,000.00 and not more than P2,000.00.

Any motorist who fails or refuses to comply with the requirement of removing their helmets and looking at the camera or surrendering their license at the gate shall be fined P2,500.00 or shall be imprisoned for 20 to 30 days, or both as may be determined by a court of law.

Section 8. Community Service. A person who violates this Ordinance who is unable to pay the required fine shall be allowed to render community service not exceeding 16 hours. The Head of the BDRRMO or the City Mayor shall determine the nature of the community service to be performed by the violator.

Section 9. Implementing Rules and Regulations. The City Legal Services Office is mandated to formulate the implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance in consultation with the relevant Barangay officials.

The City Legal Services Office shall submit the draft implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance to the City Mayor for his approval not later than sixty (60) days after the effectivity date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. All Ordinances, orders, and rules inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 11. Separability Clause. Any provision of this Ordinance not declared void or unconstitutional by the proper court of law shall remain valid.

SECTION 12. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.
