CITY ORDINANCE NO. 281-2023  
Series of 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND ALL BARANGAYS AND SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN IN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE TO USE A PORTION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT FUNDS TO FINANCE THE HOLDING OF TRAINING SEMINARS ON DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AS MANDATED BY CITY ORDINANCE NO. 248-2022 (THE "BACOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING ORDINANCE") UNTIL THE LAST WORKING DAY OF DECEMBER 2023 SUBJECT TO THEIR COMPLIANCE TO PERTINENT LAWS AND GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS.

**WHEREAS**, City Ordinance No. 248-2022 was approved by the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor on 28 November 2022 pursuant to Section 14 of Republic Act No. 10121 (the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010") which requires various national government agencies to integrate disaster risk reduction and management education in the school curricula of secondary and tertiary level of education, including the National Service Training Program (NSTP), whether private or public, including formal and nonformal, technical-vocational, indigenous learning, and out-of-school youth courses and programs.

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of City Ordinance No. 248-2022 provides that the cost of the training seminars to be conducted by the BDRRMO shall be shouldered by the City Government and no fee shall be charged from any of the persons required to attend them.

**WHEREAS**, Section 21 of RA 10121 provides that:

"The present Local Calamity Fund shall henceforth be known as the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF). Not less than five percent (5%) of the estimated revenue from regular sources shall be set aside as the LDRRMF to support disaster risk management activities such as, but not limited to, pre-disaster preparedness programs including **training**, purchasing life-saving rescue equipment, supplies and medicines, for post-disaster activities, and for the payment of

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premiums on calamity insurance. The LDRRMC shall monitor and evaluate the use and disbursement of the LDRRMF based on the LDRRMP as incorporated in the local development plans and annual work and financial plan. Upon the recommendation of the LDRRMO and approval of the sanggunian concerned, the LDRRMC may transfer the said fund to support disaster risk reduction work of other LDRRMCs which are declared under state of calamity.

Of the amount appropriated for LDRRMF, thirty percent (30%) shall be allocated as Quick Response Fund (QRF) or stand-by fund for relief and recovery programs in order that situation and living conditions of people in communities or areas stricken by disasters, calamities, epidemics, or complex emergencies, may be normalized as quickly as possible.

Unexpended LDRRMF shall accrue to a special trust fund solely for the purpose of supporting disaster risk reduction and management activities of the LDRRMCs within the next five (5) years. Any such amount still not fully utilized after five (5) years shall revert back to the general fund and will be available for other social services to be identified by the local sanggunian. (Emphasis and underscoring supplied)"

**WHEREAS**, the various barangays and sangguniang kabataan of the City of Bacoor, Cavite also has a duty to actively participate in disaster preparedness programs and to implement all laws and city ordinances.

**WHEREAS**, by authorizing the said barangays and sangguniang kabataan to use a portion of their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Funds (LDRRMF) to finance disaster preparedness training activities in their respective jurisdictions, the objectives of City Ordinance No. 248-2022 shall be achieved more quickly and effectively.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** by the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite that:

**Section 1. Authority To Use Portion of LDRRMF.** Pursuant to Section 7 of City Ordinance No. 248-2022 (the "**Bacoor Emergency Response Training Ordinance**"), all barangay and sangguniang kabataan in the City of Bacoor, Cavite are hereby authorized to use a portion of their Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Funds (LDRRMF) to finance disaster preparedness training activities in their respective jurisdictions until the last working day of December 2023 subject to their compliance to existing pertinent laws and government regulations with regard the use of the said fund.

**Section 2. BDRRMO to Review Training Program.** The Bacoor Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office is mandated to review the training program/s to be used by the barangay and sangguniang kabataan that will use the authority granted to them in the immediately preceding section to ensure that they comply with the provisions of City

Ordinance No. 248-2022 and with other pertinent city ordinances, laws, and government regulations.

**SECTION 3. Repealing Clause.** All Ordinances, orders, and rules inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

**SECTION 4. Separability Clause.** Any provision of this Ordinance not declared void or unconstitutional by the proper court of law shall remain valid.

**SECTION 5. Effectivity Clause.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.


