AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, MODIFYING AND REPEALING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 242-2022, ALSO KNOWN AS THE "CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY INCENTIVE ORDINANCE OF BACOR".

WHEREAS, on 07 December 2022, City Ordinance 242-2022 (CO 242-2022), Series of 2022 or AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SPECIAL INCENTIVES TO BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, PROFESSIONALS, AND INSTITUTIONS THAT WILL CONDUCT CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ACTIVITIES IN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY INCENTIVE ORDINANCE OF BACOR" was approved by the Fifth (5th) Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, during the 18 February 2024 meeting, it was agreed there is a need to harmonize the Ordinance and the actual implementation of CO 242-2022.

WHEREAS, the concerned departments and heads presented their respective recommendations and are incorporated in the proposed amendments.

WHEREAS, on 14 March 2024, through the Office of the City Administrator, with the approval of the City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to amend certain provisions of the City Ordinance No. 242-2022, Series of 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, THAT:

SECTION 1. SECTION 2 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 242-2022 SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 2. Definition of Terms. The following terms as used in this Ordinance are defined as:

2.1 Business Establishments — any natural or juridical person not engaged in the practice of profession that is duly registered as a business with the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) of the City of Bacoor and is engaged in the trade or delivery of goods and services to any member of the public.

2.2. Corporate Social Responsibility or Citizen's Social Responsibility (CSR) Activities -any activity conducted within the City of Bacoor by any business establishment, professional, or institution that aims to improve society, the environment, the lives of the poor, the sick, the victims of injustice, or the underprivileged.

For purposes of this Ordinance, only those projects proposed by the LEDIPO, CSWDO, BPLO, PESO and BCCHATO shall be considered as the City Government's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).

2.3. Institutions -any school, hospital, or charitable organization operating within the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

2.4. Professionals -any resident of the City of Bacoor duly registered with the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) or the Supreme Court of the Philippines as a professional who are practicing their profession within the City."

SECTION 2. SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE 242-2022 SHALL BE READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 3. Grant of Incentives. All business establishments, professionals, and institutions that will conduct CSR activities in the City of Bacoor in coordination with the Local Economic Development and Investments Promotion Office (LEDIPO), City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO), Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO), Public Employment Service Office (PESO), and Bacoor City Culture, History, Arts and Tourism Office (BCCHATO) or any other department under the Office of the City Mayor prior to the holding of such activities shall be entitled to the following incentives:

a. Free advertising of their products or services to all free cable television channels airing in the City of Bacoor for a period of thirty (30) calendar days.

b. Public recognition of the business establishments, professionals, and institutions that will conduct CSR activities in all social media accounts owned by the city government.

c. Free use of selected advertising spaces owned by the city government for not more than ten- (10) calendar days.

d. 10% discount in their Mayor's Permit and Sanitation Permit fee for the year following the conduct of the CSR activity lies.

e. Use of an express lane at Business One-Stop Shop facility at the Bacoor City Hall for their transactions with the city government; and

f. Assistance to be provided by the **LEDIPO** in the processing of their applications of various permits to be issued by the city government."

SECTION 3. SECTION 4 OF CITY ORDINANCE 242-2022 SHALL BE READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 4. Conditions for the Grant of Incentives. The incentives mentioned above shall only be granted if the business establishment, professional, or institution applying for the same complies with the following conditions:

4.1. It has no unpaid taxes or other accountabilities to the city government;

4.2. It is consistently complying with all city ordinances and has not filed suit against the city government or is not the subject of a legal action filed against it by the city government;

4.3. **The proposed CSR activity/activities was duly coordinated with the LEDIPO, CSWDO, BPLO, PESO and BCCHATO or with any department/unit under the Mayor's Office or with the Office of the Vice Mayor before the CSR activities was/were conducted:**

4.4. **It employs Senior Citizens, Persons with Disability (PWDs), and former Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDLs); and**

4.5. The business establishment, institution, or professional applied for the grant of the said

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 4 was passed by the defunct Sangguniang Bayan of Bacoor, Cavite on February 6, 2012 and it mandated corporations, partnerships, and businesses operating within the City to conduct CSR activities without providing any form of incentive or recognition to said private entities in exchange for the commendable work they were supposed to do for the community.

WHEREAS, very few companies have been compelled to comply with Municipal Ordinance No. 4 which means that a new strategy must be employed by the City Government in order to enhance its partnership with the private sector.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Hon. Reynaldo M. Fabian, **BE IT ORDAINED** by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite THAT:

Section 1. Application. This Ordinance shall apply to all business establishments, professionals, and institutions (such as schools and hospitals) doing business, working, or operating within the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

4.4. The business establishment, institution, or professional applied for the grant of the said incentive in the manner to be provided in the implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance.

Section 5. ^{Penalty} Penalty. Any city government employee that refuses ^{without} justifiable cause to grant the incentives mentioned above to qualified business establishments, professionals, or institutions shall be deemed to have violated this Ordinance and shall be required — upon conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction — to pay a fine of P5,000.00.

Section 6. Implementing Rules and Regulations. The BPLO, LEIPO, and the City Legal Services Office shall work together under the supervision of the City Administrator and submit to the City Mayor the proposed implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance not later than thirty (30) working days after the date of effectivity hereof.

Section 7. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared void by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining portions, provisions, sections, or parts hereof which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 8. Repealing Clause. Municipal Ordinance No. 4-S-2012 is hereby repealed. All other ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby considered repealed, amended or modified, accordingly.

Section 9. Date of Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite.
