**AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE CORPORATE SEAL OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE.**

**WHEREAS**, on 28 September 2012, the 1<sup>st</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite approved City Ordinance No. 29A, Series of 2012 approving the revised corporate seal of the then newly minted City of Bacoor, Cavite.

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") provides that local government units cannot revise its official seal more than once every ten (10) years.

**WHEREAS**, Section 3, paragraph (c) of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Bacoor, Cavite") empowered the City Government to have its own corporate seal.

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the City Mayor requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to revise the existing corporate seal of the City Government to "strengthen the City's identity, unity, and public image".

**WHEREAS**, the new design of the corporate seal of the City Government embodies the rich cultural heritage and revolutionary history of the City of Bacoor while representing its dynamic growth as a modern, progressive, and people-centered city. It provides a unified and meaningful visual identity that reflects both Bacoor's proud past and its aspirations for the future.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the 6<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite that:

**Section 1. Title.** This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as the **"2025 Revised Corporate Seal Ordinance of the City of Bacoor"**.

**Section 2. Design of the Revised Corporate Seal.** The revised corporate seal shall have the following design features with the corresponding symbols for each:

CIRCLE	Represents the timeless customs, traditions, and culture that are ingrained in the residents of the City of Bacoor.

SUN WITH SIXTEEN RAYS	While the sun represents the significance of Bacoor as General Emilio Aguinaldo's first capital of the Revolutionary Government which played an important role in our country's path to nationhood, its sixteen rays represent the sixteen provinces of origin of the 198 Bacoor Assembly gobernadorcillos who took their oath of office and signed the Act of Independence in Bacoor as authored by Apolinario Mabini. ### Section 3. Use of the Corporate Seal of the City of Bacoor. -

The corporate seal of the City of Bacoor shall be affixed to or placed upon all official communications of the city government. It shall also be prominently displayed on the walls of all edifices owned and operated by the city government.

### Section 4. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall become effective

immediately after it has been posted in at least three, conspicuous places within the City of Bacoor and after it has been approved by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines.

### Section 5. Separability clause. - If any provision or part hereof

is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this ordinance not otherwise affected shall be valid and subsisting.

### Section 6. Repealing clause. - Any ordinance, resolution,

executive order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule or regulation contrary to or inconsistent with, the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

### Section 7. Dissemination. Let copies of this Ordinance be

furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, and other government offices concerned.
