AN ORDINANCE REGULATING COMMUNITY-BASED, VOLUNTARY CARPOOLING ARRANGEMENTS IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, PROMOTING EFFICIENT USE OF PRIVATE AND CITY GOVERNMENT OWNED MOTOR VEHICLES, REDUCING TRAFFIC CONGESTION, REQUIRING PASSENGER INSURANCE COVERAGE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Government recognizes the increasing burden brought about by rising fuel prices caused by the military conflict in the Middle East between Iran, the United States, and Israel that began on 28 February 2026 which significantly increased the daily transportation expenses of Bacoor City residents as well as the fuel expenses of motorists and of the City Government.

WHEREAS, the growing number of privately owned motor vehicles contributes to traffic congestion on major roads within the City of Bacoor, resulting in longer travel times, increased fuel consumption, and adverse environmental impacts.

WHEREAS, encouraging shared transportation or carpooling among residents, co-workers, and neighbors can maximize the use of existing private vehicles, reduce the number of vehicles on the road, and contribute to more efficient mobility within the city.

WHEREAS, requiring City Government employees and officials to engage in carpooling activities using City Government owned motor vehicles will not only result in fuel cost savings but will serve as clear indicia of the

determination of the local government to spearhead fuel conservation efforts.

WHEREAS, carpooling provides an opportunity for individuals belonging to the same neighborhood, barangay, workplace, or nearby locations to share rides for common destinations such as offices, schools, and commercial centers.

WHEREAS, the City Government seeks to ensure that voluntary carpooling arrangements are not for profit, safe, organized, and with adequate protection for passengers in case of accidents.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted to local government units under the Local Government Code of 1991 to enact measures promoting public welfare, safety, and convenience, the City of Bacoor deems it necessary to establish guidelines governing carpooling activities within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor, Cavite, in session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Bacoor Carpooling Regulation and Safety Ordinance.**"

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. It is the policy of the City Government of Bacoor to promote efficient and sustainable transportation solutions that reduce traffic congestion, lessen fuel consumption, and maximize the utilization of privately owned and City Government owned motor vehicles while ensuring the safety and protection of passengers participating in voluntary carpooling arrangements.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as:

- a) **Bacoor Carpooling Regulation Unit** – a unit to be created by virtue of this Ordinance that will be placed under the Administrative and Operations Division of the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) which will be primarily tasked to implement this legislative measure.

- b) **Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD)** – the department under the direct supervision and control of the City Mayor that is vested with the power to enforce and implement the Revised Traffic Code, ordinances related to road use, and various laws and regulations of the Republic of the Philippines related to traffic management and road safety, and such traffic management plans and programs that may hereafter be drawn or prepared.
- c) **Carpooling** – A voluntary arrangement where a private motor vehicle owner or driver, or the authorized driver of a City Government owned motor vehicle, shares a ride without the need to pay any fare, fee, or any other form of consideration with other individuals traveling to a similar destination, primarily for purposes of convenience, fuel sharing, and traffic reduction, and not for the purpose of operating a public transportation service.
- d) **Carpool Identification Card (CID)** – An identification card (ID) issued by the City of Bacoor through the BTMD, indicating the: (a) name, plate number and driver of the carpool vehicle and origin and destination, or (b) the name, address, and emergency contact number of the passenger/s of an accredited carpool vehicle.
- e) **Carpool Sticker** – A special sticker issued by the BTMD to properly identify a participating carpool vehicle, to be installed at the upper left side of the windshield.
- f) **Carpool Vehicle** – A privately owned or City Government owned motor vehicle with four or more wheels used to transport a limited group of passengers under a car pooling arrangement as defined in this Ordinance.
- g) **Carpool Group** – A group of individuals who regularly share transportation and who belong to any of the following identifiable communities:

1. Residents of the same barangay, subdivision, or neighborhood;
2. Employees of the same office, company, or workplace;

3. Students or personnel of the same school or institution; or
4. Individuals residing or working within close geographic proximity from one another who regularly travel along the same route.

Provided that: all persons belonging to a carpool group must have a Carpool Identification Card (CID) duly issued by the City Government of Bacoor through the BTMD that must be presented to the driver before boarding the carpool vehicle.
Provided further that: relatives, dependents, or persons residing in the same house as the carpooling driver are exempted from securing a CID.

h) **Electric Vehicles** – are four-wheeled motor vehicles propelled by one or more electric motors, using energy stored in rechargeable batteries rather than burning fossil fuels.

Section 4. Limitations of Carpooling. All carpooling activities covered by this Ordinance shall be subject to the following limitations:

- a) Carpooling under this Ordinance shall be voluntary and no fare, fee, or any other type of consideration shall be collected by the carpool vehicle driver from any of his/her carpooling passengers.
- b) The driver shall not operate the vehicle as a public utility vehicle or common carrier.
- c) Participation shall be limited to members of a defined carpool group, as described in Section 3 of this Ordinance.
- d) Carpooling shall not be offered indiscriminately to the general public.
- e) Only motor vehicles or electric vehicles with four or more wheels shall be allowed to be used as a carpooling vehicle; and
- f) Carpooling vehicles enrolled in the program shall only be limited to operate during working days, or may be allowed during weekends if the passengers and driver have work on weekends.

Section 5. Passenger Insurance Requirement. To ensure the protection of passengers, any privately-owned or City Government owned motor vehicle used for regular carpooling shall secure passenger accident insurance coverage from a duly authorized insurance provider covering:

1. Death or bodily injury of passengers resulting from vehicular accidents; and
2. Medical expenses arising from such accidents.

Provided that: Proof of valid insurance coverage shall be kept inside the vehicle and presented upon request by authorized personnel of the City Government. **Provided further that:** upon the agreement of the driver and passengers of a registered carpooling vehicle and if a reputable insurance company will allow it, the insurance premium may be divided among all registered occupants of the registered carpooling vehicle.

Section 6. Responsibilities of the Driver. The driver participating in a carpool arrangement shall:

1. Possess a valid driver's license issued by the Land Transportation Office;
2. Ensure that the vehicle is duly registered and roadworthy;
3. Observe all traffic laws, regulations, and city ordinances;
4. Maintain safe driving practices at all times;
5. Ensure that only passengers with a valid Carpooling ID shall be allowed to ride a carpool vehicle; and
6. Ensure that the number of passengers does not exceed the authorized seating capacity of the vehicle.

Section 7. Prohibited Acts. The following acts shall be prohibited:

1. Using carpooling as a means to operate an unregistered or unauthorized public transportation service;

2. Soliciting or accepting passengers from the general public in a manner similar to public utility vehicles;
3. Operating a carpool vehicle without the required passenger insurance coverage;
4. Allowing passengers without a valid Carpooling ID to ride the carpooling vehicle. **Provided that:** relatives, dependents, or persons residing in the same house as the carpooling driver are exempted from securing a CID.

Section 8. Implementing Office. The Bacoor Carpooling Regulation Unit of the BTMD shall be the primary office responsible for the implementation and monitoring of this Ordinance and may issue guidelines necessary for its proper enforcement.

Section 9. Creation and Powers of the Bacoor Carpooling Regulation Unit. The Bacoor Carpooling Regulation Unit (BCRU) is hereby created and shall be endowed with the following powers and responsibilities:

- 9.1. Accredited all drivers who may wish to operate as a carpooling driver.
- 9.2. Register and issue CIDs to all carpooling drivers and carpooling passengers who may wish to be covered by this Ordinance.
- 9.3. Coordinate with the Human Resources Development and Management Department (HRDMD) of the City of Bacoor, homeowners'/neighborhood associations and barangays who may wish to form carpooling groups and maintain a master list of all persons who shall belong to a particular carpooling group.
- 9.4. Provide alternative carpooling options to accredited carpooling passengers whenever the carpooling driver of a certain group is indisposed or unavailable.
- 9.5. Maintain a hotline or a Complaints Action Center that will receive, record, and act on all complaints related to the implementation of this ordinance.
- 9.6. Maintain a database of all data points relevant to the implementation of this Ordinance such as, but not limited to, the number of carpooling vehicles and carpooling

passengers that participated in the implementation of this ordinance as well as the number of persons who violated this ordinance; and

9.7. Perform such duties and responsibilities directed by the head of the BTMD or by the City Mayor.

Section 10. Hiring of Job Order Employees to be Assigned at the BCRU. Given the possibility that the Middle East crisis will end after a few months and considering the lack of available manpower at the BTMD, the City Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint two (2) job order employees who shall be required to work at the BCRU under the supervision of the Head of the BTMD pursuant to relevant civil service regulations.

Section 11. Fuel Cost-Sharing Arrangement. Participation in a car pooling arrangement may include the sharing of reasonable transportation expenses among members of the carpool group, such as fuel, toll fees, and parking charges. Provided, however, that such contributions shall be strictly limited to the proportional sharing of actual trip expenses and shall not be treated as a fare, profit, or compensation to the driver. Any arrangement that results in the driver earning profit from transporting passengers shall be considered a violation of this Ordinance and may be treated as unauthorized public transport activity subject to applicable national transportation laws and regulations.

Section 12. Maximum Passenger Capacity. A carpool vehicle shall carry only the number of passengers within the authorized seating capacity of the vehicle as indicated in its certificate of registration. Under no circumstance shall passengers be allowed to occupy unsafe positions inside or outside the vehicle. Standing passengers shall likewise be strictly prohibited.

Section 13. Non-Classification as Public Transport or Common Carrier. Carpooling arrangements conducted in accordance with this Ordinance shall be considered voluntary ride-sharing among members of a defined carpool group and shall not be deemed as operating a public utility vehicle or engaging in the business of transporting passengers for hire. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to classify the driver or owner of a carpool vehicle as a common carrier, provided that the carpool arrangement remains non-commercial in nature and is limited to members of the carpool group as defined herein.

Section 14. Incentives and Support Measures. To encourage participation in carpooling, the City Government may introduce programs or incentives, which may include:

1. Priority access to designated pick-up and drop-off areas;
2. Coordination with major employers, institutions, and barangays to organize carpool groups;
3. Free car charging at charging station situated within the Bacoor Government Center for privately owned electric vehicle duly registered with the BCRU/BTMD on a first-come, first-charge basis;
4. Company owned cars and other four-wheeled vehicles used to carpool employees in accordance with this Ordinance and the corporate social responsibility programs of the said businesses shall be exempted from any traffic volume reduction program to be implemented by the City Government within the City of Bacoor; and
5. Public awareness campaigns promoting responsible ride-sharing and traffic reduction.

Section 15. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Ordinance, the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD), in coordination with other concerned offices of the City Government, shall formulate and issue the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations to effectively carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 16. Traffic Demand Management Measure. The carpooling program established under this Ordinance shall form part of the City Government's Traffic Demand Management (TDM) strategies, intended to reduce the number of single-occupancy vehicles on city roads, improve traffic flow, promote efficient utilization of private motor vehicles, and mitigate the impact of rising fuel costs on residents.

This Ordinance shall therefore be implemented as a local traffic management and mobility measure designed to complement existing national transportation policies and

shall not be construed as authorizing the operation of public transportation services.

Section 17. Designated Pick-Up and Drop-Off Areas.

The Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD), in coordination with concerned barangays and establishments, may designate specific carpool pick-up and drop-off areas along major roads, commercial centers, workplaces, and residential zones to facilitate the safe and orderly loading and unloading of passengers participating in carpool arrangements. Such areas shall be clearly marked and may be prioritized for vehicles participating in registered carpool groups.

Section 18. Prohibition on Public Solicitation of Passengers.

Drivers participating in carpooling arrangements under this Ordinance shall be strictly prohibited from:

1. Soliciting passengers from the general public along roads, streets, terminals, or other public places;
2. Advertising or offering transportation services for hire to the public; and/or
3. Operating in a manner similar to public utility vehicles, transport network vehicle services, or other for-hire transport services.

Carpool participation shall remain limited only to members of the defined carpool group as provided under this Ordinance.

Section 19. Coordination with Barangays and Workplaces.

The City Government, through the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD), may coordinate with Human Resources Development and Management Department (HRDMD) of the City of Bacoor, HOAs, neighborhood associations, barangays, companies, schools, and institutions within the City to facilitate the organization of carpool groups among residents, employees, and students who share common travel routes and destinations. Barangays and institutions may assist in identifying potential participants and promoting safe and responsible carpooling practices within their respective communities.

Section 20. Monitoring and Evaluation.

The Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) shall conduct periodic monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of

this Ordinance to determine its effectiveness in reducing traffic congestion, encouraging ride-sharing, and improving overall mobility within the City.

A report on the implementation of the carpooling program may be submitted annually to the Office of the City Mayor and the Sangguniang Panlungsod for possible policy improvements.

Section 21. Development of Carpooling Application.

The BTMD and the E-Governance Department are hereby empowered to develop a carpooling application using city government employees or in partnership with the private sector to give registered carpooling participants in case the carpool driver they are accustomed to ride with is unavailable or indisposed or if a carpooling vehicle is in need to repair or maintenance work. **Provided that:** the said app shall be downloaded and used for free and shall be operated and maintained by the BTMD and by the E-Governance Department respectively.

Section 22. Penalties.

Any person found violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon due notice and hearing, be subject to the following penalties:

- First Offense: payment of P3,000.00 fine
- Second Offense: payment of P4,000 fine
- Third Offense: payment of P5,000.00 fine.

Section 23. Separability Clause.

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 24. Effectivity.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.
