**CITY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH VARIOUS PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOR REGARDING THE "STRIKE SA KARUNUNGAN SCHOLARSHIP PROJECT".**

**WHEREAS**, Section 22 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") provides that the local chief executive of a local government such as the City of Bacoor possesses the power to engage in contracts, subject to prior authorization from the concerned Sanggunian.

**WHEREAS**, a letter dated October 18, 2024 from the Office of the City Mayor Hon. Strike B. Revilla, was received by the Sangguniang Panlungsod with regard to the intention of various private educational institutions to partner with the City Government of Bacoor in providing educational grants and/or assistance to qualified students residing in the City of Bacoor.

**WHEREAS**, the following various private educational institutions provide quality education and recognize the need to establish partnership and cooperation in giving scholastic opportunities and educational grants to eligible scholars who are residents of Bacoor under the "STRIKE Sa Karunungan Scholarship Project", to wit:

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:**

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into and executed this \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_ (the "Effective Date") at the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR**, a local government unit duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented in this Agreement by its City Mayor, **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, and hereinafter referred to as "**LGU BACOOR**"

and

The \_\_\_\_\_, an educational institution established under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal address at \_\_\_\_\_, Bacoor, Cavite, represented in this Agreement by its President, \_\_\_\_\_, and hereinafter referred to as "**SCHOOL**".

"**PARTY**" shall mean either **LGU BACOOR** or **SCHOOL**, if applicable, while the term "**PARTIES**" shall mean **LGU BACOOR** and **SCHOOL**, collectively.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS, LGU BACOOR** is one of the component cities of the Province of Cavite, authorized to partner with public and private educational institutions in the upliftment of the lives of its youth through the provision of educational grants and/or assistance to qualified students;

**WHEREAS, the SCHOOL** is an educational institution that provides quality education among students and sought the assistance of the **LGU BACOOR** to provide educational grants and/or assistance to its students;

**WHEREAS, LGU BACOOR** and the **SCHOOL** recognize the need to establish a partnership and cooperation in giving educational grants and/or assistance (the "**S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project**" or the "**Project**" for brevity) to qualified students who are residents of the City of Bacoor;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the **PARTIES** hereto agree as follows:

- I. PROJECT COVERAGE.** The **S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project** shall apply only to qualified Junior High School (JHS), Senior

High School (SHS), and College students who are residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite.

II. **OBJECTIVE.** This Project aims to encourage and support qualified Junior High Schools (JHS) and Senior High Schools (SHS) who are residents of the City of Bacoor to pursue education by providing financial assistance to augment the students' educational needs. Committed to promoting diverse and inclusive access to education, this initiative of the LGU BACCOOR intends to alleviate the economic burden on the student's families, ensuring that financial constraints do not hinder their education. Consequently, it aims to reduce dropout rates, encourage academic excellence, and contribute to the development of skilled and educated individuals essential for overall societal development.

III. **POLICIES.** To implement the Project, the following policies are hereby enumerated:

**A. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. **PROJECT BENEFITS AND BENEFICIARIES.** The LGU Bacoor will provide educational grants and/or assistance to eligible students administered through the SCHOOL. Each student-beneficiary shall receive a scholarship grant in the amount of Three Thousand Pesos (Php3,000.00) only. The allocation of scholarship slots for each participating school will be proportionate to its student population, ensuring equitable project implementation.

The qualified beneficiaries under this Project shall be exclusively for:

- Junior High School Students
- Senior High School Students

2. **PROJECT QUALIFICATIONS.** To qualify for the benefits of this project, the students shall meet all of the following qualifications as indicated:

- a. Residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite;
- b. His or her parents/guardian must be a registered voter of the City of Bacoor;
- c. Must be from low-income families or those whose income is not enough to support the educational needs of their children, as may be determined or defined by LGU BACCOOR;
- d. Must have no failing grades and
- e. Must undergo assessment and evaluation by the concerned Mayor's Socialized Benefits for Bacoor Residents (MSBR) or Special Program Unit that covers the students' respective Barangay or Schools.

**B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES**

**1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARENTS.**

- a. Attend all meetings concerning the Project;
- b. Provide needed documents as requirements for the proper implementation of the Project;
- c. Monitor and supervise their children and ensure compliance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement;
- d. Consult, advise, or inform the SCHOOL of any concerns or queries that may arise during the implementation of the Project;
- e. Perform and participate in any and all other functions and responsibilities concerning the Project;
- f. Inform the school and the LGU if the student needs to transfer to another place or school.

**2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE STUDENT**

- a. Provide needed documents as requirements for the proper implementation of the Project;
- b. Maintain a GPA ranging from eighty to eighty-five percent (80%-85%), with 80% being the lowest grade-in-all academic and non-academic subjects during the period of this agreement.
- c. Perform and participate in any and all other functions and responsibilities concerning the Project.

**3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF LGU BACDOR.**

- a. Coordinate with the SCHOOL to schedule the application and assessment of qualified students, to be conducted within the premises of the SCHOOL;
- b. Conduct an assessment of the student beneficiaries recommended by the SCHOOL;
- c. Thoroughly evaluate and validate any and all documents submitted by the student beneficiaries;
- d. Provide feedback to the SCHOOL regarding the evaluation and approval of scholarship candidates;
- e. Closely coordinate with the SCHOOL on matters regarding the Project;
- f. Facilitate meetings with the Parents and the SCHOOL as needed;
- g. Disburse financial assistance to the approved student beneficiaries through the SCHOOL, ensuring direct application towards the students' tuition fees;
- h. Gather and prepare all necessary documentation for the distribution and liquidation of the Project fund;
- i. Prepare an Accomplishment Report highlighting the project's distribution and proper utilization of project funds;
- j. When resources permit, provide employment opportunities to the student beneficiaries who wish

to contribute their knowledge, services, and skills to the LGU BACCOOR.

**4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOOL.**

- a. Recommend deserving and qualified students for the Project;
- b. Coordinate with LGU BACCOOR to schedule the application and assessment of qualified students, to be conducted within the premises of the SCHOOL;
- c. Inform the students to prepare two (2) sets of documentary requirements; the original copy will be submitted to the LGU through Mayor's Socialized Benefits for Bacoor Residents (MSBR) or Special Program Unit on Scholarship Program, and a duplicate copy for the SCHOOL;
- d. Monitor and supervise the student's academic performance;
- e. Provide and submit the status report of the students' subject of the Project;
- f. Attend consultation meetings concerning the implementation of the Project;
- g. Provide a counterpart of the financial assistance provided by LGU Bacoor and ensure prompt application of the same for the student beneficiary's tuition;
- h. Submit two original copies of the individual Statement of Account (SOA) indicating that the financial grant under the *STRIKE sa Karunungan* Scholarship Project has been applied to the student's tuition fees within three weeks after the release of the assistance;
- i. Inform and advise the Mayor's Socialized Benefits for Bacoor Residents (MSBR) or Special Program Unit on Scholarship Program on any concerns or queries regarding the Project.
- j. Encourage the student beneficiaries to contribute to the LGU BACCOOR through employment or engagement in work with the city government upon graduation.

**C. GROUND FOR TERMINATION/FORFEITURE OF EDUCATIONAL GRANT AND/OR ASSISTANCE**

1. If any of the PARTY have violated any of the provisions as stipulated in the Agreement,
2. Withdrawal or expulsion from the course/program of the student;
3. Grave violation of existing rules and regulations and/or policies of the LGU BACCOOR and/or SCHOOL;
4. Failure of the student to maintain the required grades and/or
5. Other analogous circumstances.

**D. PROCEDURE.** The LGU Bacoor, in coordination with the participating Schools, shall formulate implementing guidelines within 30 days after the execution of this Agreement.

**IV. CONTINUITY.** All existing responsibilities between the parties, as detailed in any preceding agreements, shall remain and continue to be valid in this present agreement. The LGU BACCOOR affirms its commitment to providing financial assistance to scholars for their remaining scholarship period, subject to their continued compliance with the obligations specified herein. This agreement supersedes previous agreements executed by the parties.

**V. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION.** This Agreement governing the *S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project* shall immediately take effect upon signing by both parties. It shall continue to be effective until 30 June 2025 unless sooner terminated, revoked, or canceled by either party. The period shall cover all student beneficiaries who the school shall recommend until the following school year.

**VI.** The Parties shall have the right to pre-terminate this Agreement by serving a written notice to the other party at least thirty (30) days before the intended date of termination and based on the following grounds:

1. Upon mutual agreement of the Parties.
2. There is any material violation of the foregoing covenants that will warrant the cancellation of this Agreement. Provided that the terminating party shall formally inform the other of the grievance before any decision to terminate is made and finalized.

**VII. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes all prior agreements, discussions, proposals, representations, or warranties, whether written or oral, on this subject matter.

**VIII. AUTHORITY.** Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.

**IX. GOOD FAITH.** In complying with and implementing the terms of this Agreement, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.

**X. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** The Parties' relationship under and in relation to this Agreement shall be limited to the matters contained herein. Nothing herein provided shall be considered or interpreted as



constituting the relationship of the Parties or any of them as a partnership in which any one or more of the Parties may be liable for the acts or omissions of any other Party or Parties, nor shall anything herein contained be considered or interpreted as constituting any Party as the general agent of any other Party.

**XI. WAIVER.** The failure of either party to enforce any rights arising under this Agreement or to take action against the other party in the event of any breach shall not be deemed a waiver of such rights, nor shall it preclude the enforcement of such rights at any later time. No waiver by either party of any provision of this Agreement shall be considered a waiver of any other provision or of the waiving party's right to require strict observance of each of the terms herein. Any waiver must be in writing and signed by the party granting the waiver.

**XII. AMENDMENTS AND MODIFICATIONS.** This Agreement may not be amended, modified, or supplemented in any manner, whether by course of conduct or otherwise, except by an instrument in writing specifically designated as an amendment hereto, signed on behalf of each party.

**XIII. GOVERNING LAW.** This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines. Execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement shall not violate any provision of applicable laws or constitute a breach of any contracts it has entered into.

**XIV. SEPARABILITY.** If any clause, sentence, or provision of this Agreement shall be declared void or unenforceable by the competent authority, the provision/s unaffected by such declaration shall remain valid and binding among the parties, their successors, and assigns.
