A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR STRIKE B. REVILLA TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE MOONTON TECHNOLOGIES PHILIPPINES, INC. ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR FOR THE HOLDING OF THE MOBILE LEGENDS BANG BANG (MLBB) TOURNAMENT IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod on 24 February 2025 to pass a resolution authorizing Mayor Strike B. Revilla to sign a Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government and Moonton Technologies Philippines, Incorporated ("Moonton") regarding the holding of a Mobile Legends Bang Bang (MLBB) tournament in the City of Bacoor, in cooperation with the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation. A draft memorandum of agreement was submitted by the Office of the City Legal Services and reviewed by the members of the council was made an integral part of this resolution.

WHEREAS, the city government of Bacoor constantly provides programs and activities for the youth that can promote camaraderie and healthy competition in order to detract them from vices and other illegal activities.

WHEREAS, Moonton is an international mobile gaming company established in 2014 that had successfully launched several high-profile mobile games globally. It offered to conduct Mobile Legends Bang Bang (MLBB) tournament in the City of Bacoor, in cooperation with the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation.

WHEREAS, the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod reviewed the said MOA and found that its provisions are not contrary to law and — if the MLBB is implemented properly with due regard to its potential impact on the education of the youth — may benefit the persons who will participate in the said competition.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this ____ day of _____ 2025 ("Effective Date"), in the City of Baccor, Cavite, Philippines, by and between:

MOONTON TECHNOLOGIES PHILIPPINES, INC., a corporation duly recognized and existing under Philippine Laws with principal office at 23rd Floor, The Curve, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig, Philippines, herein represented by its Community Manager, Ken Ryari Lee, and hereinafter referred to as "MOONTON PHILIPPINES" or the "FIRST PARTY";

-and-

CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, a local government unit created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, Hon, STRIKE B. REVILLA, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution No. _______, Series of 2025, hereinafter referred to as the "LGU BACOOR" or "SECOND PARTY".

"Party" shall mean MOONTON PHILIPPINES or LGU BACOOR, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall mean MOONTON and LGU BACOOR, collectively.

WITNESSETH: That

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY, established in 2014, is an international mobile gaming company dedicated to gaming development, publication, and exports;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY has successfully faunched several high-profile mobile games globally and has built long-term relationships with governments and esports organizations in more than 30 countries worldwide;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY is mandated to exercise the powers expressly granted to local government units, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the SECOND PARTY to constantly provide programs and activities for the youth of Bacoor that will promote camaraderie and healthy competition in order to detrect them from vices and other tilegal activities;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY offers to conduct city-wide Mobile Legends: Bang Bang (MLBB) tournament in the City of Bacoor, Cavite, by establishing a partnership through the City Government of Bacoor in cooperation with the Sangguniang Kabalaan Federation:

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY has sufficient facilities to support the proposed project of the FIRST PARTY for the benefit of the Baccor youth;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY accepts the proposal of the FIRST PARTY in order to achieve its goal of promoting the interests and betterment of Baccor's youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, with the parties remaining committed to the agreements made and entered into, and in addition thereto, the same parties hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

I. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES.

- The FIRST PARTY shall:
 - A. Provide funding assistance in terms of In-Game Rewards to the SECOND PARTY in the amount stated below, depending on the number of teams on the day of the tournament, for the tournament prizes and production learn purposes, and;

B. Provide a cash prize for tournament winners in the implementation of the BACOOR LGU-MOONTON Partnership Program provided there are more than 300 participants, and the amount will depend on the number of teams on the day of the event, to be released in full in compliance with the required submission of necessary documents;

C. After signing this Agreement, provide merchandise as additional rewards for standaione MLBB events made by the SECOND PARTY as stipulated under this Agreement.

- Provide a maximum of NINE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE PESOS or P999.00 to the SECOND PARTY for creative fund purposes;
- E. During the effectivity of this Agreement, provide a one-time MLBB caster visit. The on-ground tournament participating teams must meet the requirements of 32 teams or more, and the event with a total of 300 participants or more.
- F. Through its Monitoring and Evaluation Team, see to it that funds provided for the SECOND PARTY shall be used properly and for the intended purposes specified.
- 2. The SECOND PARTY, through the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation, shall:
 - A. Submit an event and budget proposal two (2) weeks before the event to the FIRST PARTY's Marketing Consultant;
 - B. Warrant that the events should not involve any other online or computer games aside from MLBB;
 - C. Hold at least one (1) MLBB Event every (2) two months for the duration of this Agreement;
 - Ensure that the event is free of violence and any type of bad behavior, any
 political activities, any forms of gambling, and other brand promotions are
 prohibited;
 - E. Progrem must include MLBB tournaments and Non-MLBB stage activities. The Marketing Consultant of the FIRST PARTY will recommend allowable Non-MLBB stage activities;
 - F. Commit to organizing a minimum of 16 teams for the FIRST PARTY to hold the onsite MLBS fournament;
 - G. Ensure there is no registration fee involved;
 - H. Lead the registration process, collecting the personal details and ML88 account details of the players participating in the tournament and contests;
 - Abide the MLBB PH tournament structure and rules;
 - Might request all materials for public usage either online & offline for approval of Moonton;
 - K. Encourage to facilitate a live stream of the event on their official Facebook Page;
 - Include the MLBB PH logo in all social media posts/live stream and posters and MLBB event advertising materials;
 - M. Tag or mention the MLBB PH Official Page on the announcement post, during Livestream, and posting of winners;
 - N. Submit a 2-3minute video of the event for highlights to be shared on the MLBB PH Officiat Page;

- O. Submit at least 20 photos of the event proper that can be posted on the MLBB PH Official Page;
- P. Submit a Printing Shop Billing or Quotation if requesting financial assistance for event posters and tarpaulins;
- Q. Properly utilize the funds provided by the FIRST PARTY and shall see to it that these are used for the purpose of MLSB Tournaments or Contest, events materials, and Production Team rewards; and
- R. Secure an Official Receipt for every event material's expenditure;

IF, CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE

- A. The PARTIES hereby undertake to perform the following obligations in accordance with the provisions of R.A. No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012) and its implementing rules and regulations:
- 8. SURVIVAL OF CONFIDENTIALITY. This Section on Confidentiality and Non-disclosure shall survive the expiration or termination, for whatever cause, of this Agreement. The duties and obligations of confidentiality as required by law shall remain in effect, in perpetuity, upon termination or expiration of this Agreement. Any violation of this duty of non-disclosure and confidentiality shall be pursued and prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

III. EFFECTIVITY OF THE AGREEMENT

A. This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon signing hereto by the parties and/or their authorized representatives and shall remain valid and effective for a period of six months (6) months unless sooner terminated by the parties for a valid cause or causes. This Agreement may be modified, amended, and/or renewed under terms and conditions mutually acceptable to both parties and duly executed in writing. The renewal period shall be for six (6) months each time.

IV. BASIS FOR TERMINATION

A. A grant may be terminated by the FIRST PARTY for cause. Cause for termination of the FIRST PARTY includes failure of the SECOND PARTY to make satisfactory progress toward achieving the level of participation or other evidence satisfactory to the FIRST PARTY that the SECOND PARTY has failed or is unable to perform in accordance with the provisions of the funding agreement.

VI. LONGEVITY CLAUSE

A. Once signed as an official partner of Moonton Philippines, the SECOND PARTY acknowledges allowing and prioritizing MLBB and Moonton events to be held in the City. Also, the SECOND PARTY recognizes that they have unlimited rights and opportunities to make requests and proposals in accordance with the budget and timeframe allotted by the FIRST PARTY with expedited approvals if resources are available.

VIL OTHER PROVISIONS

- In the event that any term or provision in this Agreement is found to be invalid or unemforceable under Philippine laws or regulations, such term or provision shall be deemed stricken from this Agreement, but the provisions unaffected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.
- In case of conflict between the parties arising from this Agreement, they
 agree to freely and voluntarily submit themselves to necessary consultation
 and negotiation for purposes of amicable settlement and find a mutually
 acceptable solution to their dispute.
- 3. This Agreement is the complete and exclusive statement of agreement concerning the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes all prior understandings, oral communications, and writings in respect of the subject matter of this Agreement. This Agreement may be amended or modified only in writing and signed by the Parties.
- 4. In complying with and implementing the terms of this Agreement, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.
- 5. The relationship of the Parties under and in relation to this Agreement shall be limited to the matters herein contained. Nothing herein provided shall be considered or interpreted as constituting the relationship of the Parties or any of them as a partnership in which any one or more of the Parties may be liable for the acts or omissions of any other Party or Parties, nor shall anything herein contained be considered or interpreted as constituting any Party as the general agent of any other Party.

VIII. INDEMNIFICATION AND LIMITED LIABILITY

A. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Agreement, neither of the Parties shall be liable to the other Party or Parties, by reason of any representation or express or implied warranty, condition or other term or any duty under law, for any indirect, incidental, special, or lost profits, however, caused and on any theory of liability arising out of or relating to this Agreement.

IX. BEPARABILITY CLAUSE

A. In the event that one or more provisions contained herein shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect and for any reason, the remaining provisions shall remain valid, legal, and enforceable.
