A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR AND UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STRIKE B. REVILLA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the City Government to enter into partnerships with educational institutions for the purpose of providing assistance to qualified students.

WHEREAS, on 06 August 2025, the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Office of the City Mayor requesting authority to sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the University of Perpetual Help System Dalta for the Strike B. Revilla Scholarship Program. This proposed MOA is incorporated and made a part of this Resolution as **Annex "A"**.

WHEREAS, the proposed Memorandum of Agreement stipulates that grantees of the scholarship program shall receive a 100% scholarship on their tuition fees. Additionally, the program places priority on certain courses at the University, such as Architecture, Business Administration, Computer Studies, Mass Communication, Education, and Criminology.

WHEREAS, the Strike B. Revilla Scholarship Program represents an investment in the future of Bacoor, as it supports the education of the city's promising young citizens, preparing them to contribute significantly to local industries and

governance, and further strengthening the social and economic fabric of our city.

WHEREAS, the creation of scholarships is a critical element of social justice. Education, though enjoyed privately, serves as a public good. It fosters social mobility, decreases income inequality, and promotes civic participation.

WHEREAS, the establishment of scholarships aligns with the mandate given under Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 to exercise all powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental to the promotion of the general welfare. The provision of educational opportunities not only benefits the individual recipient, but also has a profound effect on the community at large. It fosters a well-educated populace, capable of contributing to the economic growth, social cohesion, and general welfare of the City of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. Moreover, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive without the Sangguniang Panlungsod's prior authorization.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Manolo S. Galvez, Jr., unanimously seconded by the rest of the Body in special session duly assembled, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign the proposed MOA between the City Government of Bacoor and the University of Perpetual Help System Delta for the implementation of the Strike B. Revilla Scholarship Program.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Office of the City Mayor, the University of Perpetual Help System Delta, and other government agencies concerned with copies of this Resolution.

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
(STRIKE B. REVILLA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM)**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (the Agreement) is made entered into this ____ day of ____ 2025, (the "Effective date") at the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

The **UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA**, a private educational institution of higher learning established under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, represented herein by its President, **DR. ANTHONY JOSE M. TAMAYO**, and hereinafter referred to as "**UPHSD**"

and

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOD**, a local government unit duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Brgy. Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **Hon. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. ____, Series of 2025, and hereinafter referred to as "**LGU BACOOD**"

The term "Party" shall mean UPHSD or LGU BACOOD, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall mean UPHSD and LGU BACOOD, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, LGU BACOOD is one component cities in the Province of Cavite, authorized to partner with private educational institutions to uplift and empower the lives of its youth sector through the provision of scholarship programs to qualified scholarship grantees;

WHEREAS, UPHSD is a private educational institution of higher learning and is requesting the LGU BACOOD for partnership on the implementation of **LGU BACOOD-UPHSD SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** (the "Program")

WHEREAS, LGU BACOOD and UPHSD recognize the need to establish a partnership and cooperation in giving educational and scholastic

opportunities to qualified scholar grantees who are residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

I. PROGRAM COVERAGE

This Agreement contains the **LGU BACOR-UPHSD SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** applicable to qualified scholar grantees who are constituents of the City of Bacoor, including the mechanics and procedures for its availment.

II. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This Agreement prescribes the policies and procedures governing the implementation of the Program for SY 2025-2028, and the succeeding years thereafter

- a. Management and organization of the educational benefits program;
- b. Selection and administration of qualified scholar grantees; and
- c. Statement of requirements and responsibilities of those availing the educational benefits.

III. SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS

This Agreement prescribes the rules and regulations governing the implementation of the **LGU BACOR-UPHSD SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**, and applies only to qualified scholar grantees who are residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite.

IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For the purpose of this Agreement, the following terms shall mean and be understood as indicated:

- a. **Grantee** - Qualified scholar who is the recipient of the scholarship grant.
- b. **Educational Benefits Grant** - Educational undertaking provided by the City of Bacoor and UPHSD to support the education of the grantee.

- c. **Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees** - Fees collected by the UPHSD to be used in paying for the grantee's processing, registration, enrollment and other related fees.

V. POLICIES

For the purposes of implementing the Program, the following policies and procedures are hereby enumerated:

A. GENERAL

1. **Program Coverage:** This Scholarship Program shall apply only on priority courses of UPHSD-Molino Campus under the following Colleges:

- a. **Architecture**
- b. **Business Administration**
- c. **Computer Studies**
- d. **Mass Communication**
- e. **Education**
- f. **Criminology**

2. **Program Beneficiaries and Benefits.**

This Program shall cover the scholar's tuition fees every semester for an undergraduate priority course of UPHSD under any of the above-enumerated Colleges, and in particular as follows:

- **UPHSD - 100% Scholarship on Tuition Fees**
- **Student Account- Miscellaneous Fees**

3. **Program Priority.** This Scholarship Program gives priority to individuals with the following basic qualifications:

3.1 **Twenty (20) residents of City of Bacoor;**

3.2 **Must pass the screening of the scholarship Coordinator of the City of Bacoor;**

3.3 **Must have no failing grades;**

- 3.4 Must submit the requirements set by LGU BACO and UPHSD, and
- 3.5 Must have completed duty hours from previous gr (for old grantees)

4. Education Benefit Grant Administration

- 4.1 Applicants for this Program shall be accepted at start of every semester of the applicable school year.
- 4.2 Applicants for this Program must satisfy all admission requirements set by the UPHSD the school year applied.
- 4.3 The LGU BACOR shall process and thereafter, recommend to UPHSD all approved applicants for scholarship program to undertake admission examinations and other admission procedures.
- 4.4 Thereafter, the applicants must satisfy the admission requirements set by UPHSD, as follows:
 - 4.4.1 Must have a GWA of 95% belonging to a class of 30;
 - 4.4.2 Certificate of Good Moral endorsed by the school certifying the GWA and class size; and
 - 4.4.3 Endorsement Letter from the Baco Mayor's Office
- 4.5 The UPHSD shall submit to LGU BACOR the list of the successful applicants who have passed the admission requirements and thereafter, admitted to the Program.
- 4.6 A grantee is entitled to an educational benefit grant leading to one baccalaureate degree from UPHSD
- 4.7 Grantees shall not be allowed to shift to another course during the duration of the scholarship grant unless approved by both the LGU BACOR and UPHSD. In case the grantee shifts to another course, the basis for

the term of the grant will be on the number of years specified in the curriculum of the originally chosen course.

- 4.8 The Program obligation shall commence immediately on the year the grantee enrolls his/her course.
- 4.9 The grantees are required to render one hundred (100) duty hours for 1st and 2nd year and fifty (50) hours for 3rd/4th year of clerical works to be performed in any assigned offices. Duty hours should be rendered during the semester where the scholarship is granted.
- 4.10 The grantees admitted in the Program shall abide the rules and regulations set by the City of Bacoor and UPHSD as well as the course requirements.
- 4.11 The grantees shall be governed by the policies and educational standards of the UPHSD. Breach of the same shall mean forfeiture of the scholarship program.
- 4.12 At no instance shall a grantee be allowed to go on leave of absence (LOA) from course/ program without prior approval from LGU BACCOOR. If approved, the LGU BACCOOR will communicate the approved LOA to UPHSD for consideration. Scholarship for approved LOA will be suspended and subject for reconsideration of the LGU BACCOOR if they will still be considered as scholars when he/she returned.
- 4.13 The educational benefits grant shall be terminated if:
(a) the grantee fails to meet all requirements - academic, behavioral, and economic - set by the UPHSD and LGU BACCOOR (b) is expelled from the UPHSD or (c) is convicted by any crime involving moral turpitude.

5. Continuance of the Educational Benefit Grant

- 5.1 All grantees are required to submit Certification of Grades to LGU BACCOOR at the end of every semester.
- 5.2 City of Bacoor shall then issue a continuance letter to be submitted by the grantee to UPHSD for the continuance of the scholarship grant.

- 5.3 For the continuance of the scholarship grant, no violations of the provisions stipulated in this Agreement shall be committed by the grantees.

B. APPLICANT REQUISITES AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. Only qualified students who are residents of the City of Bacoor shall be entitled to the scholarship grant under this Program subject to the admission examinations and other admission procedures to be conducted by UPHSD.
2. Applicants must possess the educational qualifications and aptitude necessary to sustain the course/program.
3. Applicants must submit the following document requirements to LGU BACOOOR on or before the scheduled date of submission:
 - 3.1 Duly accomplished City of Bacoor Scholarship Application Form attached with two (2) copies of latest 2 x 2 pictures of the applicant;
 - 3.2 One (1) copy or photocopy of voter's identification of parent;
 - 3.3 One (1) copy or authenticated machine copy of Certificate of Good Moral Character of the applicant from the last educational institution attended;
 - 3.4 Barangay Certificate of Residency signed by the Barangay Captain (original);
 - 3.5 One (1) copy or authenticated machine copy of grades from previous school year/semester;
 - 3.6 One (1) Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) copy of Birth Certificate.

C. GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION / FORFEITURE OF EDUCATIONAL BENEFIT

1. If the grantee is discovered to have violated any of the provisions as stipulated in this Agreement.

2. Voluntary withdrawal from the course/program by the grantee.
3. Conviction by final judgement of an offense involving moral turpitude. For the purpose of this Agreement, an offense involving moral turpitude shall mean any act which is done contrary to justice, honesty modesty or good moral, including but not limited to shameful or any act of wickedness and depravity.
4. Grave violation of existing rules and regulations and/or policies of the LGU BACOR and/or UPHSD.
5. Grantee shall maintain a GPA of 2.50 (82-85) without any failing grades both in academic and non-academic subjects during the semester

VI. PROCEDURES

- A. The LGU BACOR shall immediately disseminate the availability of the scholarship program slot allocation.
- B. The LGU BACOR shall prepare a shortlist of the best qualified candidates and submit it to UPHSD.
- C. Thereafter, the UPHSD shall submit to the LGU BACOR the names of candidates who have successfully passed the admission examinations.
- D. Both Parties shall come up with a list of approved grantees at the start of every semester.
- E. Upon submission of Certification of Grades, the LGU BACOR shall issue a continuance letter to the grantee to be presented to UPHSD upon enrollment.
- F. The UPHSD shall continue the provision of the scholarship grant provided that the grantees present the continuance letter issued by the City of Bacor upon enrollment.
- G. Upon completion of the course, all grantees under this educational benefit program are required to submit to LGU BACOR a certified true copy of all grantees' diploma/certificate of completion of records.

VII. EFFECTIVITY

These rules and regulations governing the City of Bacoor - UPHSD Scholarship Program shall be implemented after signing this Agreement.

This Agreement supersedes and repeals any other agreements, contracts and/or understandings containing the same and/or similar subject matter, unless said existing agreement, contract and/or understanding, if there be any, is expressly mentioned in this Agreement or in any other writing, to still exist vis-a-vis this Agreement.
