A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH "I WANT TO SHARE FOUNDATION INC." FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CANCER HELPLINE PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Bacoor") authorized the City Mayor to represent the City of Bacoor in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law of ordinance.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") empowered local governments to exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and to promote public health.

WHEREAS, the I WANT TO SHARE FOUNDATION INC. (IWTS) is a non-stock, non-profit organization duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine law committed to providing children afflicted with various types of cancer timely and convenient access to pediatric oncology referral centers so as to achieve at least a 60% survival rate for all Filipino children with cancer through early detection.

WHEREAS, IWTS proposed to establish a Cancer Helpline Program in the City of Bacoor, Cavite in partnership with the City Government.

WHEREAS, a draft Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government and IWTS regarding the establishment of a Cancer Helpline Program was submitted by the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for its review and consideration.

- Appoint and designate at least 2 coordinators to oversee the implementation of the project in the entire municipality;
- Appoint and designate three (3) Barangay Health Workers for each Barangay to actively participate in the project;
- 4. Provide allowances and meals for participants; and
- Provide the necessary telephone system (landline and mobile phones), equipment and other gadgets necessary to maintain an effective correspondence and support for the implementation of the Cancer Helpline Program.

C. RESPONSIBILITIES OF IWIS 2

- Provide training services with technical assistance from the Philippine General Hospital (PGH) and other partner hospitals;
- 2. Hire and Maintain a Project Manager who shall oversee the planning, implementation, coordination, and monitoring for early detection and referral project through a cancer helpline for childhood cancer in Sta. Rosa, Laguna, including close collaboration with the BHW, coordinators, and other local healthcare providers, and capacity-building, smooth patient referral systems, and regular performance tracking of the Cancer Helpline program; and
- After training and upon execution of the program, deploy navigators to assist in the Cancer Helpline operations, within the Municipality.

D. MUTUAL PROVISIONS

- Both parties shall work in close coordination to ensure the efficient implementation of the Cancer Helpline Program;
- This Memorandom of Agreement may be modified or amended upon written agreement of both parties; 84.
- This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall
 remain valid and subsisting unless earlier terminated by mutual consent of the parties,
 or for justifiable cause upon written notice.

E. EFFECTIVITY

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon signing of both parties and shall remain in force until the completion of the project, unless otherwise extended or terminated in writing.
