A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH "I WANT TO SHARE FOUNDATION INC." FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CANCER HELPLINE PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Bacoor") authorized the City Mayor to represent the City of Bacoor in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law of ordinance.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") empowered local governments to exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and to promote public health.

WHEREAS, the **I WANT TO SHARE FOUNDATION INC. (IWTS)** is a non-stock, non-profit organization duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine law committed to providing children afflicted with various types of cancer timely and convenient access to pediatric oncology referral centers so as to achieve at least a 60% survival rate for all Filipino children with cancer through early detection.

WHEREAS, IWTS proposed to establish a Cancer Helpline Program in the City of Bacoor, Cavite in partnership with the City Government.

WHEREAS, a draft Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government and IWTS regarding the establishment of a Cancer Helpline Program was submitted by the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for its review and consideration.

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
(CANCER HELPLINE PROGRAM)**

ANNEX "A"

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into this ____ day of _____, 2025, at _____, Philippines, by and between:

The **I WANT TO SHARE FOUNDATION, INC.**, a non-stock, non-profit organization, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, with office address at **The Oracle Hotel and Residences, 317 Katipunan Ave., Loyola Heights, Quezon City**, represented by its **PRESIDENT, SHEILA MARIE B. ROMERO**, and hereinafter referred to as **"IWTS"**;

- AND -

The **MUNICIPALITY OF STA. ROSA, LAGUNA**, a local government unit, organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at **The City Hall, Sta. Rosa, Laguna**, represented herein by its Municipal Mayor, **HONORABLE ARLENE ARCILLAS**, and hereinafter referred to as the **"MUNICIPALITY"**;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **MUNICIPALITY** and the **IWTS** have agreed to organize, establish, and operate a **CANCER HELPLINE**, envisioned to strengthen cancer awareness, early detection, patient navigation, and timely access to medical care;

WHEREAS, it is the aim of the parties to provide a system of correspondence and an accessibility platform, linking individuals with the **PHILIPPINE GENERAL HOSPITAL (PGH)** and other partner hospitals/institutions for immediate and appropriate medical consultation, diagnosis, and treatment;

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING PREMISES, the parties have agreed to pool their respective resources, expertise, and networks for the successful implementation of the **CANCER HELPLINE PROGRAM** with the following:

A. PURPOSE

The primary goal or purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement is to organize, establish and operate a **CANCER HELPLINE** which shall serve as:

1. A telephone system (landline and mobile phones) that can be accessed for immediate referral and patient navigation for children with symptoms, at risk or already diagnosed with cancer;
2. A streamlined referral pathway for suspected childhood cancer cases from barangays;
3. A support mechanism for Barangay Health Workers, Nurses, and Cancer Coordinators to act as **"NAVIGATORS"** to ensure timely feedback and support, assist in information dissemination, case identification, and patient monitoring; and
4. A platform for linking patients with the **Philippine General Hospital (PGH)** and other partner institutions for appropriate medical consultation, diagnosis, and treatment.

B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY

The Municipality of Sta. Rosa undertakes to:

1. Conduct trainings in their facilities for Barangay Health Workers (BHWs), nurses, and trained participants relative to the Cancer Helpline Project;
2. Appoint and designate at least 2 coordinators to oversee the implementation of the project in the entire municipality;
3. Appoint and designate three (3) Barangay Health Workers for each Barangay to actively participate in the project;
4. Provide allowances and meals for participants; and
5. Provide the necessary telephone system (landline and mobile phones), equipment and other gadgets necessary to maintain an effective correspondence and support for the implementation of the Cancer Helpline Program.

C. RESPONSIBILITIES OF IWTS

The IWTS shall:

1. Provide training services with technical assistance from the Philippine General Hospital (PGH) and other partner hospitals;
2. Hire and Maintain a Project Manager who shall oversee the planning, implementation, coordination, and monitoring for early detection and referral project through a cancer helpline for childhood cancer in Sta. Rosa, Laguna, including close collaboration with the BHW, coordinators, and other local healthcare providers, and capacity-building, smooth patient referral systems, and regular performance tracking of the Cancer Helpline program; and
3. After training and upon execution of the program, deploy navigators to assist in the Cancer Helpline operations within the Municipality.

D. MUTUAL PROVISIONS

1. Both parties shall work in close coordination to ensure the efficient implementation of the Cancer Helpline Program;
2. This Memorandum of Agreement may be modified or amended upon written agreement of both parties;
3. This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall remain valid and subsisting unless earlier terminated by mutual consent of the parties, or for justifiable cause upon written notice.

E. EFFECTIVITY

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon signing of both parties and shall remain in force until the completion of the project, unless otherwise extended or terminated in writing.
