

CITY RESOLUTION NO. 2025 -850 Series of 2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEEMENT BETWEEN GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND MULTILATERAL FRATERNITIES TO STRENGTHEN THE PEACEFUL ENVIRONMENT OF THE CITY OF BACOOR.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (the 'Agreement") is made and entere
this day of 2025 (the "Effective Date") in the City of
Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, by and between:
The CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOR,
a local government unit duly created and
existing under the laws of the Republic of the
Philippines, with its principal office address at
Baccor Government Center, Baccor
Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City,
Province of Cavite, represented herein by its
City Mayor, Hon, STRIKE B. REVILLA,
pursuant to his authority conferred and
embodied in City Resolution No,
Series of of the
City Council of Baccor City, Province of
Cavite, and hereinafter referred to as the
"LGU BACOOR"
and
, a social
organization created and existing under the
laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with its
principal office address at
represented herein
by i ts
duly authorized for
this purpose, and hereinafter referred to as
the "ORGANIZATION"

The term "Party" shall mean LGU BACOOR or the ORGANIZATION, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall mean LGU BACOOR and the ORGANIZATION, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under the 1987 Philippine Constitution, the State is vested with Police Power, which authorizes it to promote public welfare by regulating the use of liberty and property. As an inherent attribute of sovereignty, police power extends to all public needs and enables the State, as parens patriae, to exercise a broad range of regulatory functions in the interest of public safety, order, and general welfare;

WHEREAS, the LGU BACOOR, as a political subdivision of the State, is likewise delegated with police power, which it may exercise within its territorial jurisdiction to safeguard the welfare of its constituents. This includes the duty to protect the youth and provide safe spaces free from threats of criminality and violence:

WHEREAS, in light of the increasing reports of hazing incidents, gangrelated violence, and fratemity conflicts across the country, the LGU BACOOR expresses grave concern and reaffirms its role as guardian and protector of its residents, particularly the vulnerable sectors;

WHEREAS, the LGU BACOOR endeavors to foster a harmonious, peaceful, and inclusive environment for all residents by promoting dialogue, cooperation, and coordination among and between various fraternities and similar groups operating within the City;

WHEREAS, as part of its deputization efforts to implement City Ordinances, rules, and regulations, the LGU BACOOR recognizes the potential of the ORGANIZATION to serve as a proactive partner in local governance by providing a platform for meaningful participation in the City's plans, programs, projects, and activities;

WHEREAS, through this Agreement, the ORGANIZATION is empowered to become more involved, responsive, and productive members of the community, actively promoting the values of solidarity, bravery, and resilience in support of LGU BACOOR's overarching goals and objectives:

WHEREAS, the ORGANIZATION voluntarily agrees to cooperate with LGU BACOOR in initiatives aimed at promoting peace, unity, and responsible fraternity engagement, and commits to upholding the shared values of non-violence, mutual respect, and community solidarity within the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and covenants, hereinafter stated, the parties hereto have agreed and do hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT. This Agreement is entered into by and between the LGU BACOOR and the ORGANIZATION operating within the City of Bacoor, for the purpose of fostering peace, unity, and responsible civic engagement among youth and community-based organizations.

In light of increasing concerns over fraternity-related violence, hazing, and gang conflicts, this Agreement seeks to:

- A. Promote collaborative efforts between LGU BACOOR and the ORGANIZATION in maintaining public order and safety, especially among the youth;
- B. Establish a framework for dialogue, coordination, and mutual respect between the Parties to prevent violence and promote peaceful coexistence;
- C. Encourage the ORGANIZATION to participate in community-building initiatives, values formation programs, and anti-violence campaigns spearheaded by LGU BACOOR;
- D. As part of its deputization efforts to implement City Ordinances, rules, and regulations, the LGU BACOOR recognizes the valuable potential of the ORGANIZATION to serve as a proactive and engaged partner in local governance.

- E. LGU BACOOR seeks to provide the ORGANIZATION with a structured platform for meaningful participation in the City's plans, programs, projects, and activities, thereby empowering its members to become responsible, productive, and community-oriented residents who actively promote the values of solidarity, courage, and resilience in support of the City's development goals and public welfare objectives; and
- F. Reinforce the LGU BACOOR's commitment to creating a safe, inclusive, and harmonious environment for all residents, in line with its delegated police powers and mandate to protect public welfare.

This Agreement serves as a formal expression of shared responsibility and partnership in apholding the rule of law, youth protection, and community solidarity within the City of Baccor.

- SECTION 2. MUTUAL AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES. In pursuit of fostering peace, unity, and responsible civic engagement within the City of Baccor, the Parties hereby agree to the following commitments:
 - A. The ORGANIZATION shall register its member groups with LGU BACCOR to facilitate proper monitoring, coordination, and recognition of fraternities operating within the City;
 - B. The ORGANIZATION shall actively coordinate among its member fraternities and affiliated groups to ensure the timely and peaceful resolution of internal conflicts, thereby preventing violent confrontations and promoting harmonious relationships;
 - C. The ORGANIZATION shall initiate and implement programs and projects in collaboration with fratemities and youth groups, aimed at promoting the well-being, development, and positive engagement of the youth sector;
 - D. LGU BACOOR undertakes to provide financial support, subject to the availability of funds and upon submission and evaluation of formal proposals by the ORGANIZATION, for programs and projects deemed reasonable and beneficial to the community;
 - E. The ORGANIZATION shall submit a quarterly progress report to LGU BACOOR, through its Local Youth and Development Office (LYDO), detailing the status, outcomes, and challenges of the programs and projects undertaken;
 - F. Both LGU BACOOR and the ORGANIZATION commit to collaborating in the prevention of illegal drug use among members and to promote active participation in the City's anti-drug advocacy and campaigns;

- G. The ORGANIZATION shall take proactive measures to discourage and prevent involvement of its members in crimes, vices, and other unlawful activities, and shall mobilize its members in support of the City's crime prevention efforts;
- H. The ORGANIZATION shall undertake initiatives to eliminate unsightly graffiti and vandalism within the City of Baccor, contributing to the preservation of public spaces and community aesthetics.
- The ORGANIZATION agrees to cooperate with LGU BACOOR in building harmonious relationships among fraternities and in serving the community, therebycontributing to the maintenance of peace and order within the city; and
- J. As part of the LGU BACOOR's deputization efforts to implement City Ordinances, rules, and regulations, the LGU BACOOR recognizes the valuable potential of the ORGANIZATION, to serve as a proactive, engaged, and community-priented partner in local governance.
- SECTION 3. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES. The Parties hereby represent and warrant the following:

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- A. LGU BACOOR The LGU BACOOR represents and warrants that
 - a. It is a duly constituted local government unit under Philippine law, vested with the authority to enter into this Agreement and implement programs, policies, and ordinances within its territorial jurisdiction.
 - b. It has the legal mandate and capacity to deputize community organizations, including fraternity groups, for purposes aligned with public welfare, peace and gorder, and youth development; and
 - c. It shall exercise reasonable diligence in providing support, coordination, and oversight in accordance with the terms of this Agreement and applicable laws.
- B. ORGANIZATION. The ORGANIZATION represents and warrants that:
 - a. It is a tegitimate and duly recognized organization, with leadership and membership capable of fulfilling the obligations set forth in this Agreement;
 - Its officers and members shall abide by all applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations, including those governing public safety, anti-violence, and anti-illegal drug campaigns;

- It shall not engage in, condone, or tolerate any form of hazing, gang-related violence, or unlawful activity, and shall actively promote peace, discipline, and civic responsibility among its members;
- d. It shall cooperate fully with LGU BACOOR in implementing programs and initiatives under this Agreement, and shall submit timely reports and documentation as required; and
- Its representatives executing this Agreement are duly authorized to bind the organization and ensure compliance with its terms.

SECTION 4. TERM AND TERMINATION. This Agreement shall take effect on the Effective Date and shall remain in force unless earlier terminated in accordance with the provisions herein. The LGU BACOOR reserves the right to terminate this Agreement at any time, at its sole discretion, by providing written notice to the ORGANIZATION, without prejudice to any rights or obligations accrued prior to termination.

This Agreement may be renewed by LGU BACOOR upon formal written notice to the ORGANIZATION, at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the intended termination date, subject to mutual agreement and continued alignment with the City's programs and priorities.

In the event that either Party commits a material breach of this Agreement or any of its terms and conditions; or unjustifiably refuses or fails to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement, the aggrieved Party may terminate this Agreement:

(i) effective immediately, if the breach is incurable or results in irreparable harm to the interests of the aggrieved Party or the public; or (ii) within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of written notice of breach, if the breach is remediable and the breaching Party fails to cure the breach or fulfill its obligations within the prescribed period. Termination under this Section shall be without prejudice to any other remedies available under law, equity, or this Agreement.

SECTION 5. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

- A. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes any prior understanding or representation of any kind preceding the date of this Agreement. There are no other promises, conditions, understandings, or other agreements, whether oral or written, relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.
- B. AUTHORITY. Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement on its behalf is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.

- C. GOOD FAITH. In complying with and implementing the terms of this Agreement, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.
- D. NON-EXCLUSIVITY. Both Parties agree that nothing in this Agreement shall, in any way, preclude other entities of similar business establishments from entering into an agreement with the other Party that offers similar or analogous engagements.
- E. ASSIGNMENT. Either Party is strictly prohibited from assigning this Agreement, as well as the performance of any obligation, or undertaking made herein, to any third party without obtaining the prior written consent of the other Party. Either Party cannot assign this Agreement without the written consent of the other Party to any successor by way of any merger, consolidation, or other corporate reorganization of such Party, or sale of all or substantially all of the assets of such Party, provided that such successor assumes, or is otherwise fully bound by all of the obligations of the assigning Party under this Agreement. No assignment, with or without such consent, will relieve either Party from its obligations, under this Agreement.
- F. BINDING EFFECT. The covenants and conditions contained in this Agreement shall apply to and bind the Parties, as well as their successors and permitted assigns.
- G. GOVERNING LAW and VENUE OF SUITS. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, without regard to the choice or conflicts of law provisions of any jurisdiction, and any disputes, actions, claims, or causes of action arising out of or inconnection with this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Baccor City, Province of Cavite, to the exclusion of all other venues.
- H. CUMULATIVE RIGHTS. The Parties' rights under this Agreement are cumulative and shall not be construed as exclusive of each other unless otherwise provided by law.
- I. WAIVER. The failure of either Party to enforce any gravisions of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver or limitation of that Party's right to subsequently enforce and compel strict compliance with every provision of this Agreement.
- J. HEADINGS. The titles to the provisions in this Agreement are for convenience or reference only and shall not in any way affect the interpretation thereof.
- K. SEVERABILITY. If any part or parts of this Agreement shall be held unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. If any provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid or

unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, and if limiting such provision would make the provision valid, then such provision shall be deemed to be construed as so limited.

- L. AMENDMENTS. This Agreement shall not be altered, changed, supplanted, or amended except by a written instrument signed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties. All amendments to this Agreement shall be deemed valid and binding upon the contracted Parties only if made by the mutual consent in writing of the Party and signed by the original signatories of both Parties to this Agreement. This Agreement shall be legally acceptable after being signed by the authorized representatives of the contracted Parties with full corporate power vested in them by their respective Parties. After signing this Agreement, all previous verbal and/or written arrangements about the subject of this Agreement shall be considered null and void.
- M. NOTICE. Except as may be otherwise specifically provided in this Agreement, all notices required or permitted shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the postal office mail postage prepaid, certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the Parties at their respective address outlined in this Agreement or at such other addresses as may be subsequently specified by written notice.
- N. COUNTERPARTS SIGNING. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties, through their duly authorized representatives, have executed this Agreement as of the date and at the place set forth above.
