A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR REGARDING THE USE OF OFFICE SPACE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT FOR PNP-MARITIME GROUP PERSONNEL.

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine National Police – Maritime Group (PNP-MG) provides active and sustained enforcement support to the City Government of Bacoor in the implementation of its peace and order and anti-criminality programs, particularly in coastal, riverine and maritime areas;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Bacoor is – subject to availability of funds and available office space — willing to provide the PNP-MG with office space within the City of Bacoor for its official, lawful and operational purposes particularly the conduct of maritime law enforcement, administrative functions, coordination activities and related official undertaking for the benefit of its employees, clients and the general public including the constituents of the City of Bacoor.

**WHEREAS** a draft Memorandum of Agreement was submitted by the Office of the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for review and consideration. The proposed agreement is incorporated hereto and will be made a part of this Resolution as **Annex "A"**.

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE AGREEMENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is made and entered into by and between:

The **CITY OF BACOOR**, a Local Government Unit of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Boulevard, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, hereinafter referred to as the "**CITY**";

-and-

The **PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE** through the **PNP-MARITIME GROUP (PNP-MG)**, a National Operational Support Unit of the Philippine National Police, created and existing under Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, with principal office at Camp BGen Rafael T. Crame, Quezon City, represented herein by **POLICE BRIGADIER GENERAL LOU F. EVANGELISTA**, hereinafter referred to as the "**PNP-MG**";

### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, the CITY is mandated under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to promote the general welfare, ensure public safety, and maintain peace and order within its territorial jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP, through the PNP-MG, is mandated to enforce laws, ensure public safety, conduct maritime law enforcement, environmental protection, and search and rescue operations;

**WHEREAS**, both parties recognize the necessity of strengthening cooperation to effectively address criminality, enforce environmental laws, and enhance disaster response within Bacoor City and its adjacent municipalities;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

### ARTICLE I OBJECTIVES

This Agreement is hereby entered into for the purpose of establishing a framework of cooperation and coordination between the parties, and specifically aims to:

- a. Enhance institutional coordination, information sharing, and operational synergy between the CITY and the PNP-MG in the maintenance of

peace and order, and in ensuring the effective delivery of public safety services within Bacoor City;

- b. Provide sustained operational, strategic, and technical support to the CITY's anti-criminality campaign, particularly in coastal, riverine, and maritime areas, through intensified police visibility, joint operations, and coordinated law enforcement actions;
- c. Ensure the strict, consistent, and effective enforcement of applicable environmental, fisheries, and maritime laws, rules, and regulations, through coordinated monitoring, enforcement operations, and inter-agency collaboration;
- d. Strengthen the capability of the parties to respond promptly and effectively to emergencies, disasters, and calamities through the conduct of timely Search and Rescue (SAR) operations, and the integration of disaster risk reduction and management strategies;
- e. Develop and enhance the competencies of personnel of the CITY, barangay officials, and community stakeholders through the conduct of training programs, seminars, technical assistance, and other capability-building initiatives in maritime safety, law enforcement, environmental protection, and disaster response.

## **ARTICLE II DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE PARTIES**

### **A. UNDERTAKINGS OF THE CITY:**

The CITY shall:

- a. Provide available office space within Bacoor City for the use of the PNP-MG 3rd SOU personnel, subject to applicable laws, rules, and availability;
- b. Facilitate, subject to existing government accounting and auditing rules, the provision of basic utilities such as electricity and water, and other essential services necessary for the effective discharge of the PNP-MG's functions;
- c. Assist in coordinating with barangays, local government offices, and other stakeholders to ensure the effective implementation of joint operations, programs, and activities;
- d. Extend such reasonable logistical, administrative, and operational assistance as may be necessary and mutually agreed upon, particularly during emergencies, disasters, and special operations;

- e. Support programs and initiatives that strengthen collaboration between the LGU and national law enforcement agencies in advancing public safety and environmental protection.

**B. UNDERTAKINGS OF THE PNP-MG:**

The PNP-MG shall:

- a. Provide active and sustained law enforcement support to the CITY in the implementation of its peace and order and anti-criminality programs, particularly in coastal, riverine, and maritime areas;
- b. Undertake enforcement operations against violations of environmental, fisheries, and maritime laws, in coordination with the CITY and other concerned government agencies;
- c. Lead and/or assist in Search and Rescue (SAR) operations during emergencies, disasters, and calamities affecting Bacoor City and its adjoining areas;
- d. Conduct training programs, seminars, and capacity-building activities for LGU personnel, barangay officials, and community volunteers on maritime safety, disaster preparedness, law enforcement, and environmental protection;
- e. Maintain close coordination with the Bacoor City Police Office, disaster risk reduction and management offices, and other stakeholders to ensure unified, efficient, and effective operations;
- f. Assist in community engagement and information campaigns aimed at promoting safety, environmental awareness, and law compliance.

**ARTICLE III  
USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE OFFICE**

- a. The office space provided by the CITY shall be utilized exclusively for official, lawful, and operational purposes of the PNP-MG, particularly for the conduct of maritime law enforcement, administrative functions, coordination activities, and related official undertakings;
- b. The PNP-MG shall exercise due diligence in the use, care, and maintenance of the premises, and shall ensure that the same is kept in a clean, orderly, and serviceable condition at all times. It shall likewise be responsible for the security and safeguarding of the office, including all equipment, documents, and properties therein, and shall adopt appropriate measures to prevent damage, loss, or unauthorized access;

- c. Any improvement, modification, or installation to be introduced within the premises by the PNP-MG shall be subject to prior written coordination and approval of the CITY. Unless otherwise expressly agreed upon in writing, all permanent improvements shall, upon termination of this Agreement, accrue to and become the property of the CITY without obligation for reimbursement.

#### **ARTICLE IV UTILITIES AND LOGISTICAL SUPPORT**

- a. The CITY may, subject to availability of resources and compliance with existing government rules and regulations, provide basic utilities such as electricity, water, and other essential services necessary for the effective functioning of the PNP-MG within the premises;
- b. The PNP-MG shall ensure the economical, efficient, and judicious use of all utilities and resources provided, and shall adopt measures to prevent wastage, misuse, or unauthorized consumption;
- c. Additional logistical support, including but not limited to office equipment, communication facilities, or operational assistance, may be extended by the CITY upon mutual agreement of the parties, subject to existing laws, rules, and availability of funds;
- d. The PNP-MG shall be accountable for the proper use of all utilities, equipment, and logistical support provided, and shall ensure that the same are utilized strictly for official purposes in furtherance of this Agreement.

#### **ARTICLE V EFFECTIVITY, AMENDMENT, VALIDITY, AND TERMINATION**

1. This MOA shall be interpreted in harmony with pertinent laws, jurisprudence, and decisions of the courts involving the rights and obligations of government officials and/or employees.
2. This MOA shall take effect on the date of the signing of all contracting parties to this agreement.
3. Any amendment to or revision of the provisions of the MOA shall be made by mutual consent of the contracting parties.
4. This MOA shall remain in force until otherwise terminated by consent of all the contracting parties and only on just and sufficient cause to be determined between and among the contracting parties. The termination shall become effective three (3) months thereafter.
5. The termination of this MOA shall not adversely affect any valid or subsisting undertaking concluded or entered into pursuant to the same.
